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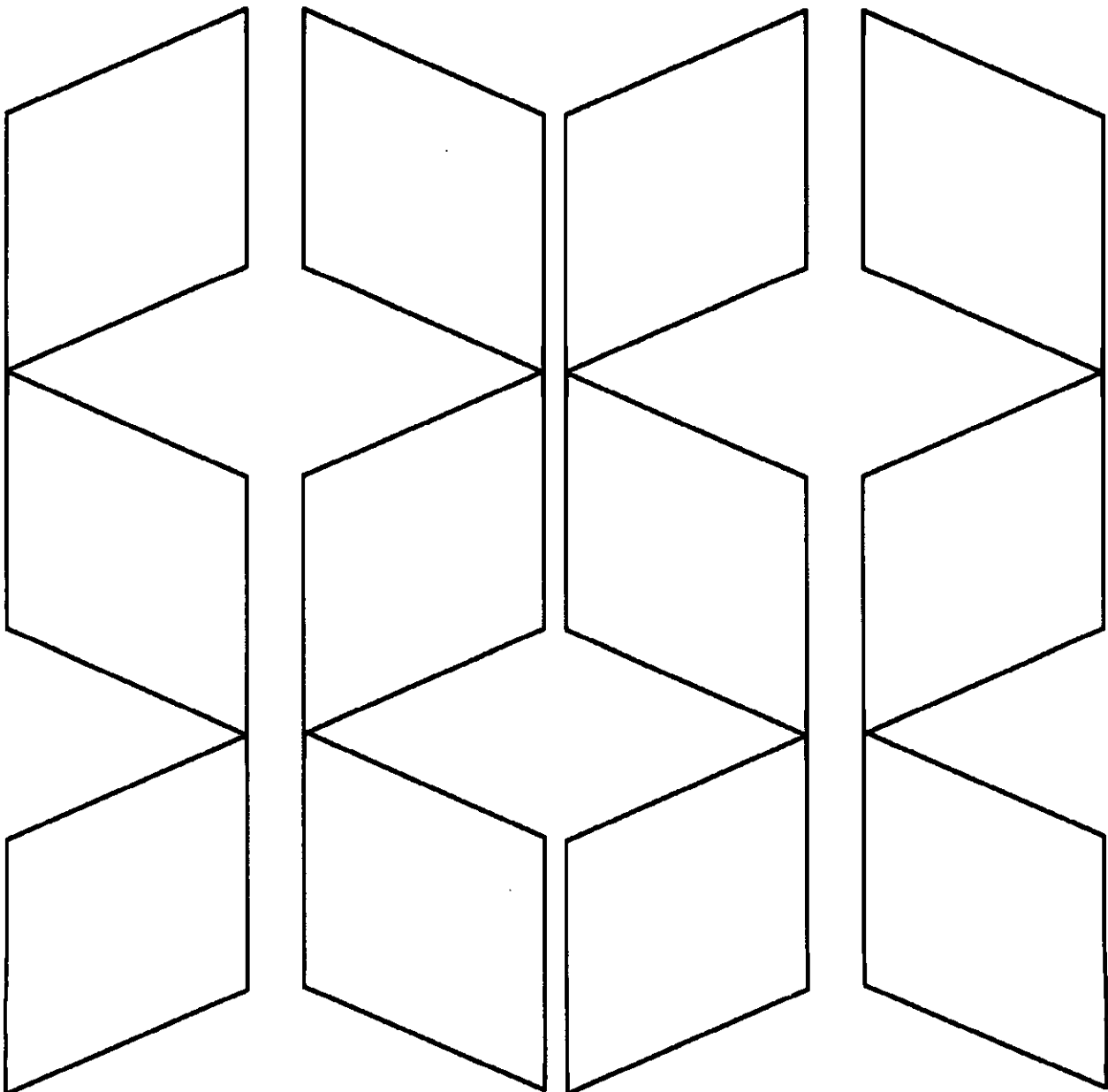

1993 Summary



Fresh Market Production Down 1 Percent from 1992

Fresh market vegetable production in 1993 of 25 selected vegetables and melons totaled 380 million hundredweight, down 1 percent from 1992. Value of the 1993 fresh market vegetable crop was estimated at 6.7 billion dollars, up 6 percent from 1992. Acres harvested of 1.81 million acres was off 1 percent from 1992. California was the leading fresh market state, accounting for 40 percent of the harvested acreage, 48 percent of the production and 48 percent of the total value. Head lettuce, sweet corn, and watermelons were the top 3 crops in terms of acres harvested and accounted for 33 percent of the total.

Processing Production Up 1 Percent

Processing vegetable production of 9 selected vegetables in 1993 was estimated at 14.4 million tons, up 1 percent from 1992. Area harvested at 1.38 million acres was down 5 percent from 1992. Value, at 1.14 billion dollars, was up 1 percent from a year ago. California was the leading processing state, with 22 percent of the acreage, 63 percent of the production, and 47 percent of the value.
