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FRESH MARKET VEGETABLES - 1977 ANNUAL SUMMARY

Production of 22 principal fresh market vegetables and melons for 1977 is estimated at 248 million hundredweight (11.3 million metric tons), 1 percent more than in 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The total crop was harvested from 1.57 million acres (634 thousand hectares), virtually the same as in 1976.

The 22 principal vegetables and melons harvested during 1977 had a total value of 2.35 billion dollars, 4 percent more than a year ago.

This summary provides estimates for the 22 principal fresh market vegetable and melon crops grown commercially in the more important producing States. These estimates provide basic statistics for over 80 percent of the national output of all vegetables and melons grown primarily for fresh market sales.

Also included in this report are the 1978 estimated area and production of onions and strawberries. Revised 1977 estimates of acreage, yield, production, value and the January 1 stocks of summer storage onions are included.

The last section of this report presents price estimates of principal fresh market vegetables by months, commodities, seasonal groups, and States, from January 1976 through December 1977.

SPRING ONIONS: Harvest is virtually complete in the Lower Rio Grande Valley of Texas except for some fields of late maturing varieties. Harvest is active in the San Antonio-Winter Garden area. Some fields were lost because of locally heavy rains in late May. Also, some acreage was plowed under because of heavy seed stem activity and poor market condition.

Harvesting is later than normal in Arizona. A few growers are just starting. Seeders have been a problem in early maturing fields, but late planted fields are not affected.

Harvest of California's spring onions is at it's peak in the Desert areas and will continue through June. Digging is beginning in southern San Joaquin Valley. The crop was delayed because of rains and cool weather. In the Stockton area, digging is expected to begin in early June, a couple of weeks later than normal.

STRAWBERRIES: Michigan's cool spring has delayed the expected start of harvest by up to 2 weeks. Timely May rains lessened reliance on irrigation. High temperatures in late May are expected to speed ripening.

In Oregon, cool, moist weather during the spring has helped berry development. The blooming period was a little longer than last year. Harvest is expected to get off to an earlier start and perhaps a little longer picking season will result. First year fields generally look good but many older fields are experiencing heavy virus damage. Yield and production are expected to surpass last year's crop even though acreage is down in 1978. Harvest should peak around June 20th.

In Washington, strawberries are in good condition; however, spring frosts have injured some fields. Rains and cool weather have caused some root problems and virus infections. Plants began to bloom during the last week of April. Picking should become general by June 16.

This section presents final estimates of prices of principal fresh market vegetables by months, commodities, seasonal groups, and States, from January 1976 through December 1977.

These prices refer to that portion of the crop sold for fresh consumption. They do not include value per unit for any portion of the crop sold for canning, freezing, or other forms of processing. Estimates are based on information supplied by growers, shippers, wholesale markets, auction markets, and quotations from the USDA Market News Service. They represent sales for the entire month, f.o.b. shipping point, except for garlic for which prices are reported annually on a field run basis at the packing-house door.

The U. S. (excluding Alaska and Hawaii) monthly average prices were computed by weighting individual State average prices by volume of sales during the month. For some crops season average prices pertain to a crop year and are not necessarily the same as calendar year averages. For example, the price series published in this supplement begins with January 1976. Although monthly prices for sales of the 1976 crop that occurred in late 1975 are not shown, these 1975 monthly prices were included in the computations of the 1976 season average prices. Monthly prices for late marketings from the 1975 crop which extended into 1976 are shown but are included in the 1975 season average prices published previously.

SEASONAL GROUPS AND MARKETING PERIOD

The seasonal nature of production and the perishability of vegetables and melons creates a need for information on supplies available during specific periods of the year to facilitate orderly marketing. Therefore, vegetable, strawberry and melon estimates, by States, for the 23 principal crops are classified according to the season when the bulk of each crop is usually harvested. Estimates of acreage and production provide a measure of supplies available in specific seasonal periods. The seasonal groupings are defined as follows:

WINTER: JANUARY, FEBRUARY, MARCH

SPRING: APRIL, MAY, JUNE

SUMMER: JULY, AUGUST, SEPTEMBER

FALL : OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, DECEMBER

The 1977 seasonal prices reflect revisions in the monthly prices due to production and price changes for some States. These changes result in minor revisions from the preliminary monthly and season average prices.
