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ACREAGE, YIELD, PRODUCTION & VALUE

FRESH MARKET VEGETABLE PRODUCTION UP 5 PERCENT

Production of the 9 principal fresh market vegetables and melons estimated in 1984 totaled 211 million hundredweight (9.59 million metric tons), 5 percent more than in 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The crop was harvested from 962 thousand acres (398 thousand hectares), 2 percent more than the area harvested in 1983.

The 9 principal vegetables and melons harvested during 1984 had a total value of 3.00 billion dollars, a 3 percent increase over the previous year.

PROCESSING VEGETABLE PRODUCTION UP 11 PERCENT

Processing vegetable production totaled 12.1 million tons (10.9 million metric tons) in 1984, up 11 percent from last year. Total value at \$1.04 million was 16 percent more than in 1983.

Harvested area for the 4 principal crops was up 6 percent, at 1.27 million acres (513 thousand hectares).

VEGETABLES - 1984

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FRESH MARKET VEGETABLES

Harvested acreage increased in 1984 for all crops except lettuce and honeydew melons. Broccoli and onions showed the largest acreage increases at 8300 and 4460 acres, respectively. The 11 percent increase in celery acreage was the largest percentage increase.

Carrots and tomatoes were the only crops to have decreased production. Broccoli, cauliflower and celery were up 24, 18 and 13 percent, respectively. Onion production was up 8 percent or 3.25 million cwt.

The increased production did not cause all crops to have increased value. Even though production was up, the value of lettuce and onions decreased from the previous year.

LEADING FRESH MARKET STATES

The five leading States in production of fresh vegetables and melons during 1984 in order of total output were California, Florida, Arizona, Texas, and Oregon accounting for 78 percent of the production. California, Florida, Texas, Arizona, and New York accounted for 76 percent of the harvested area, and 83 percent of the value of the 9 fresh market vegetables and melons estimated in the United States.

PROCESSING VEGETABLES

Processing vegetable production totaled 12.1 million tons (10.9 million metric tons) in 1984 from 7 major crops used for processing. This is up 11 percent from last year and 2 percent above 1982.

Increased production came from 5 of the crops (snap beans, sweet corn, green peas, tomatoes and broccoli); while 2 were down (carrots and cauliflower). Broccoli was up 33 percent; corn and peas were up 16 percent each; snap beans gained 14 percent; and tomatoes were up 9 percent from last year. Carrot production for processing declined 6 percent and cauliflower lost 1 percent to last year's level.

Total value for processing crops jumped 16 percent from last year. Each of the 7 crops were worth more than last year.

The 5 leading processing States are California, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Oregon, and Washington. Together, these States accounted for 82 percent of production, 74 percent of the acreage and 78 percent of the value of the 4 principal crops.
