

PIG CROP REPORT

JUNE 1965

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The December 1964-May 1965 pig crop totaled 43.2 million head, down 10 percent from the 47.9 million head for the same period a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. A total of 6.0 million sows farrowed during the period, 10 percent less than the 6.6 million for the same period last year. The number of pigs per litter averaged 7.22 compared with 7.23 a year earlier.

Breeding intentions reports indicate 5.2 million sows to farrow during June-November 1965, 7 percent less than the 5.6 million sows that farrowed during the same period last year. If these intentions are carried out and the number of pigs per litter will equal the average plus an allowance for trend, the June-November 1965 pig crop will total 37.5 million head, 8 percent less than a year earlier. The 1965 annual pig crop (December 1964 through November 1965) would then be 80.7 million head, 9 percent less than in 1964.

The June 1, 1965 inventory of hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 42.5 million head, 11 percent less than the 47.7 million head on June 1, 1964.

HOGS ON FARMS JUNE 1, 1965 - 10 CORN BELT STATES

On June 1, 1965 there were 42,480,000 hogs and pigs of all ages on farms in 10 Corn Belt States, 11 percent less than the 47,668,000 a year earlier, and 14 percent below the June 1, 1963 inventory. These 10 States normally produce three-fourths of the United States pig crop.

Hog numbers were down from a year earlier in all 10 of these States. In Iowa, the leading hog producing State, numbers were off 6 percent, and in Illinois, second ranking State, 14 percent. Among the other States, decreases ranged from 4 percent in Kansas to 18 percent in Minnesota. June 1 inventories this year were up 12 percent from March 1, compared with an increase of 17 percent during this quarter in 1964.

The number of hogs and pigs being kept for breeding in the 10 States was 6,275,000 head on June 1, 1965, down 12 percent from a year earlier. Other hog and pig numbers totaled 36,205,000 head, 11 percent less than the 40,512,000 on June 1 last year. By weight classes the number of other hogs and pigs on farms June 1, 1965 and the percentage change from a year earlier are: less than 60 pounds, 19,297,000 head, down 13 percent; 60-119 pounds, 8,058,000 head, down 9 percent; 120-179 pounds, 5,191,000 head, down 4 percent; 180-219 pounds, 2,757,000 head, down 9 percent; 220 pounds and over, 902,000 head, down 17 percent.

DECEMBER 1964-MAY 1965 PIG CROP DOWN 10 PERCENT

The pig crop for the 6 months December 1964 through May 1965 totaled 43,227,000 head, 10 percent less than the 47,912,000 head a year earlier. Reductions of 13 percent were reported for the East North Central and Western regions. The West North Central region was down 10 percent; the North Atlantic, 9 percent; the South Central, 6 percent; and the South Atlantic, 2 percent.

The number of sows farrowing during the December 1964-May 1965 period was 5,986,000 head, 10 percent less than the 6,629,000 sows farrowed during the same period a year earlier. December-May 1965 farrowings were 3 percentage points less than indicated by farmers' intentions as of December 1, 1964. December-May farrowings and intentions reported last December as a percentage of a year earlier by regions are: North Atlantic, 87 percent now and 89 percent in December; East North Central 87 and 93; West North Central 91 and 93; South Atlantic 98 and 94; South Central 94 and 91; West 85 and 88.

The number of pigs per litter during December-May period averaged 7.22, slightly less than the 7.23 a year earlier. Average litter size increased from last year in all but the West North Central region where severe late winter and early spring weather in some areas held down the average litter size.

Farrowings were down from a year earlier in each month of the December-May period. December farrowings were down 2 percent; January, 9 percent; February, 8 percent; March, 9 percent; April, 12 percent; and May, 13 percent.

The December 1964-February 1965 pig crop in the 10 States totaled 11,524,000 head, 8 percent less than the December-February 1964 crop of 12,467,000 head. Sows farrowing in the 10 States during this period totaled 1,594,000 head, 8 percent less than the 1,724,000 sows farrowed in the same period a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.23, unchanged from the previous year.

The March-May 1965 pig crop in the 10 States totaled 22,393,000 head, 12 percent less than the 25,470,000 head for the same period in 1964. Sows farrowing in the 10 States during this period totaled 3,096,000 head, 12 percent less than the 3,507,000 head farrowed a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.23 compared with 7.26 in 1964.

JUNE-NOVEMBER INTENTIONS DOWN 7 PERCENT

June 1 reports from farmers on breeding intentions indicate that 5,238,000 sows will farrow in the United States during June-November 1965. This is 7 percent less than the 5,630,000 sows farrowing during the corresponding period of 1964 and 13 percent below the 1959-63 average of 6,037,000. Decreases in sow farrowings from June-November last year are indicated in all regions except the West, which shows no change. Decreases by regions are as follows: North Atlantic, 6 percent; East North Central, 11 percent; West North Central, 6 percent; South Central, 4 percent; and South Atlantic down slightly.

If intentions for June-November farrowings materialize and the number of pigs saved per litter equals the average plus an allowance for trend, the pig crop for the period will total 37,500,000 head, 8 percent less than a year earlier and the smallest since 1957. The combined pig crop for 1965 would be 80,727,000 head, 9 percent less than the 1964 pig crop, and the smallest since 1953.

Sows bred and intended for farrowing in 10 Corn Belt States in June, July and August in 1965 total 2,083,000 head, 8 percent less than a year earlier. All of these States show declines ranging from 1 percent in Kansas to 16 percent in Minnesota. Expected farrowings by months in those 10 States are: June, 757,000 sows, down 3 percent from June 1964; July, 589,000 sows, down 11 percent; and August, 737,000 sows, down 11 percent.

Reported breeding intentions indicate 1,907,000 sows to farrow in the September-November quarter in the 10 States. This would be 8 percent less than a year earlier. Decreases are indicated in all of these States, ranging from 2 percent in Iowa to 16 percent in South Dakota.
