ANNUAL SUMMARY 1980

Revisions for the years 1974-78 were shown in SEED CROPS, Final Estimates by State, 1974-78 (Statistical Bulletin No. 658) published in March of 1981. This publication contains revised data for 1979, where warranted by new check data, and the latest data for 1980. The 1980 data will not be subject to revision again until May of 1982. The 1978 data shown in this publication is carried forward from Statistical Bulletin No. 658.

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SEED CROPS

Production of alfalfa seed in 1980 is estimated at 102 million pounds (46.3 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent from a year earlier. Seed production turned out better than expected earlier in the Central Plains, Mountain States, California and Washington. Farm value at \$115 million increased 1 percent even though prices per 100 pounds were down a dollar.

Red clover seed production totaled 25.2 million pounds (11.4 thousand metric tons) in 1980, down 6 percent from 1979. Acreage declines in the Pacific Northwest, Michigan, and Wisconsin contributed to the smaller crop.

Production of Kentucky bluegrass seed is estimated at 50.0 million pounds (22.7 thousand metric tons), up 37 percent from the 1979 output. Heavy production in Idaho, Oregon, and Washington more than offset near crop failures in Minnesota, Iowa, and South Dakota. In the Northwest, proprietary production jumped 90 percent, while public and common varieties gained 43 percent.

Tall fescue seed production in 1980 fell 21 percent to 78.6 million pounds (35.7 thousand metric tons). Of the 7 producing States, only Oregon and Kentucky realized higher production than in the previous year.

All Oregon ryegrass seed production totaled 277 million pounds (126 thousand metric tons) in 1980, up 12 percent from 1979. Production of annual varieties in Oregon totaled 214 million pounds of (96.8 thousand metric tons), up 8 percent over 1979, while output of perennial varieties jumped 28 percent to 63.2 million pounds (28.7 thousand metric tons). Proprietary perennial variety production in Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Montana rose 17 percent to 32.1 million pounds (14.6 thousand metric tons).

In 1980, drought took its heavy toll on timothy and lespedeza seed. Timothy production fell 57 percent to 8.12 million pounds (3680 metric tons). Timothy production in Minnesota, the Nation's leading producer, was down 69 percent. Lespedeza seed producers saw their crop dwindle 57 percent to 5.37 million pounds (2440 metric tons).

The U.S. tables in this publication present totals for harvested area, yield, production, carryover of old crop, and where available, imports, total supply, exports, and total disappearance for the major legume, grass, and cover crop seeds. Import data include only seed permitted entry into the U.S. under the Federal Seed Act administered by the Grain Division, Agricultural Marketing Service. Export data are from the Census Bureau, U.S. Department of Commerce, and are available for only specific kinds of seed which are shown in the tables.

Season average prices shown in this report are estimates of average prices received by producers for that part of the crop sold. The average price is the price received by the farmer for clean seed before cleaning and marketing charges are deducted. The U.S. prices are obtained by weighting State prices by annual sales. This may differ slightly from the average computed by dividing value of production by the quantity produced.
