Compared to last week: Feeder steers sold sharply higher, instances as much as 10.000-12.00 higher. Feeder heifers not tested last week. Demand good very good. Rain continues across the trade area. Fat cattle trade is up to 143.00 increasing demand. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (52.6% Steers, 47.4% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 93%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3% shrink or equivalent, with up to a 15 cent slide > 600 lbs and up to a 20 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from OK.
