Total storage stocks of fall potatoes held by growers and local dealers on March 1, 1958, amounted to 47.4 million hundredweight, according to the Crop Reporting Board of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. These holdings are 20 percent below the 58.9 million hundredweight held on March 1, 1957, and 9 percent less than the 1949-56 average holding of 52.3 million hundredweight.

Disappearance of storage potatoes during February 1958 was 19.6 million hundredweight compared with 19.8 million hundredweight during February 1957, and the average of 19.6 million. Movement to fresh market of storage potatoes in February 1958, as indicated by rail and truck unloads in 20 cities, continued to hold above a year ago. The aggregate quantity used by processors for starch, frozen French fries, flour, and dehydration in February 1958 was substantially less than the quantity used in February 1957.

Disappearance of the 1957 crop of fall potatoes from the time of harvest to March 1, 1958, was 106.8 million hundredweight compared with 107.7 million hundredweight in 1956 and the average of 99.7 million for 1949-56. Disappearance covers sales for all purposes as well as quantities used to date on farms where grown and lost through shrinkage, decay, and dumping. Cumulative unloads of fall potatoes in 20 cities from October 1, 1957, to March 1, 1958, were greater than those reported for these cities from the 1956 crop to March 1, 1957. However, the total quantity of 1957 fall potatoes used for processing prior to March 1, 1958, was still substantially less than the quantity used from the 1956 crop.

The estimates of total stocks represent all potatoes held by growers and local dealers in or near producing areas in the 26 fall producing States. They include quantities to be sold for table use, starch, other processing, feed for livestock, seed for succeeding crops, and to be used for feed, seed and household use on farms where grown. These stocks figures, like the December 1, 1957, January 1, 1958, and February 1, 1958 reports, include potatoes that will be lost through shrinkage, decay, and dumping after March 1, 1958.
