Processing schedules for next week are normal to less than normal with many operations continuing to monitor labor and transport issues. Sales of finished product are sufficient. Market activity is moderate to good. Retail activity is light.

Prices are trending steady. Offerings are light to moderate for the moderate demand. Processing schedules are normal to less than normal with many operation continuing to monitor labor and transportation issues. Finished product are adequate for trade needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal cost are unchanged at 0-5 cents per head.

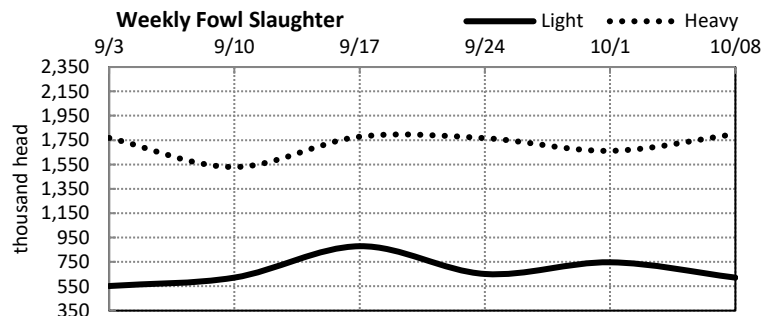

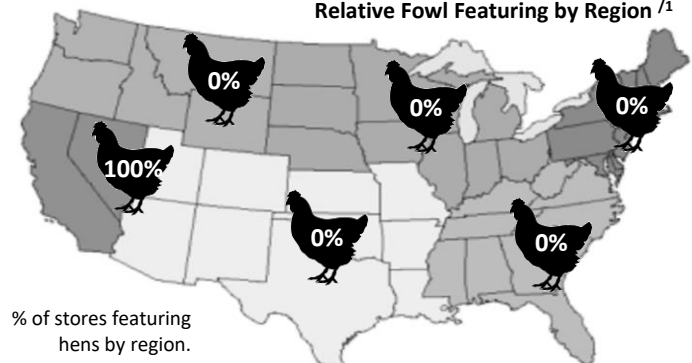
