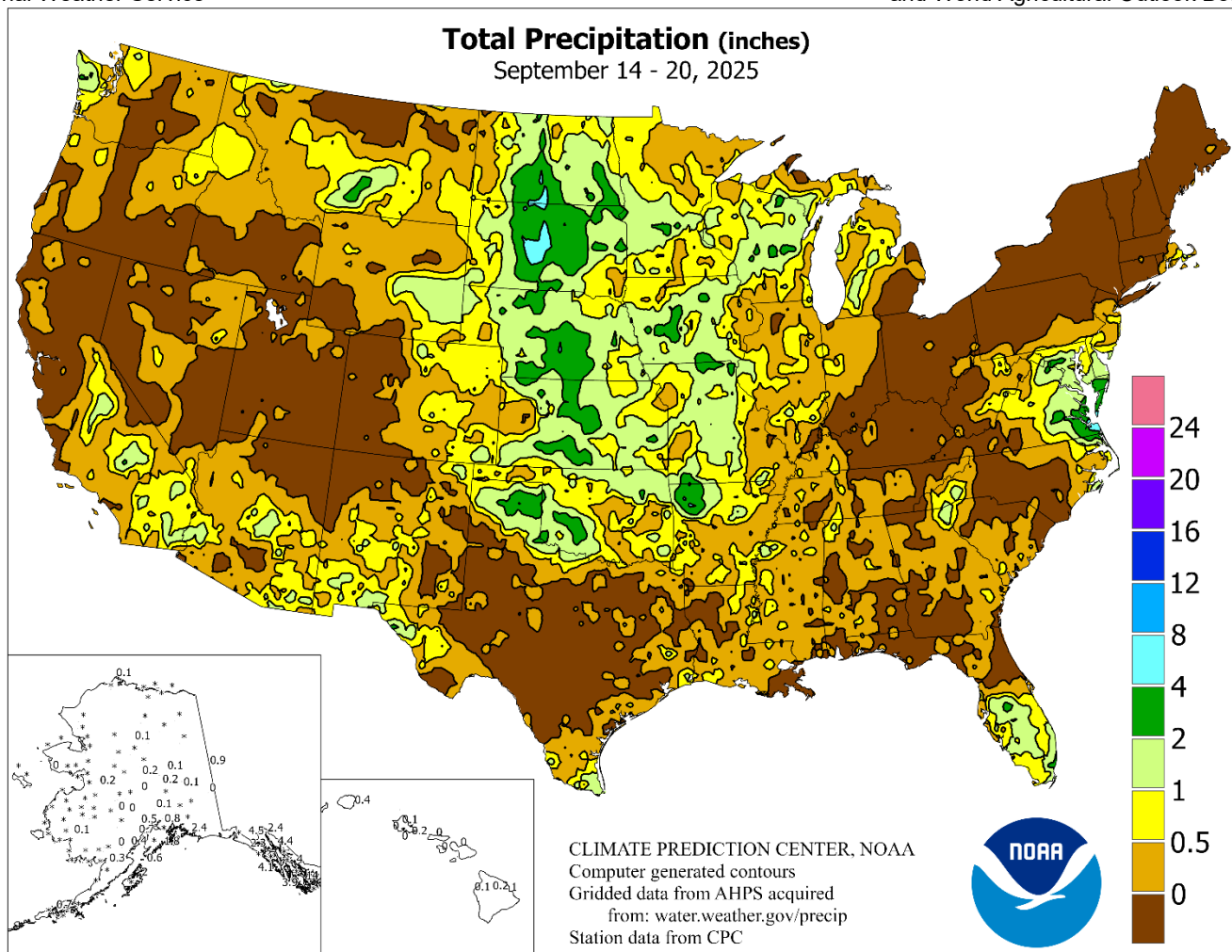

## HIGHLIGHTS

**September 14 – 20, 2025**

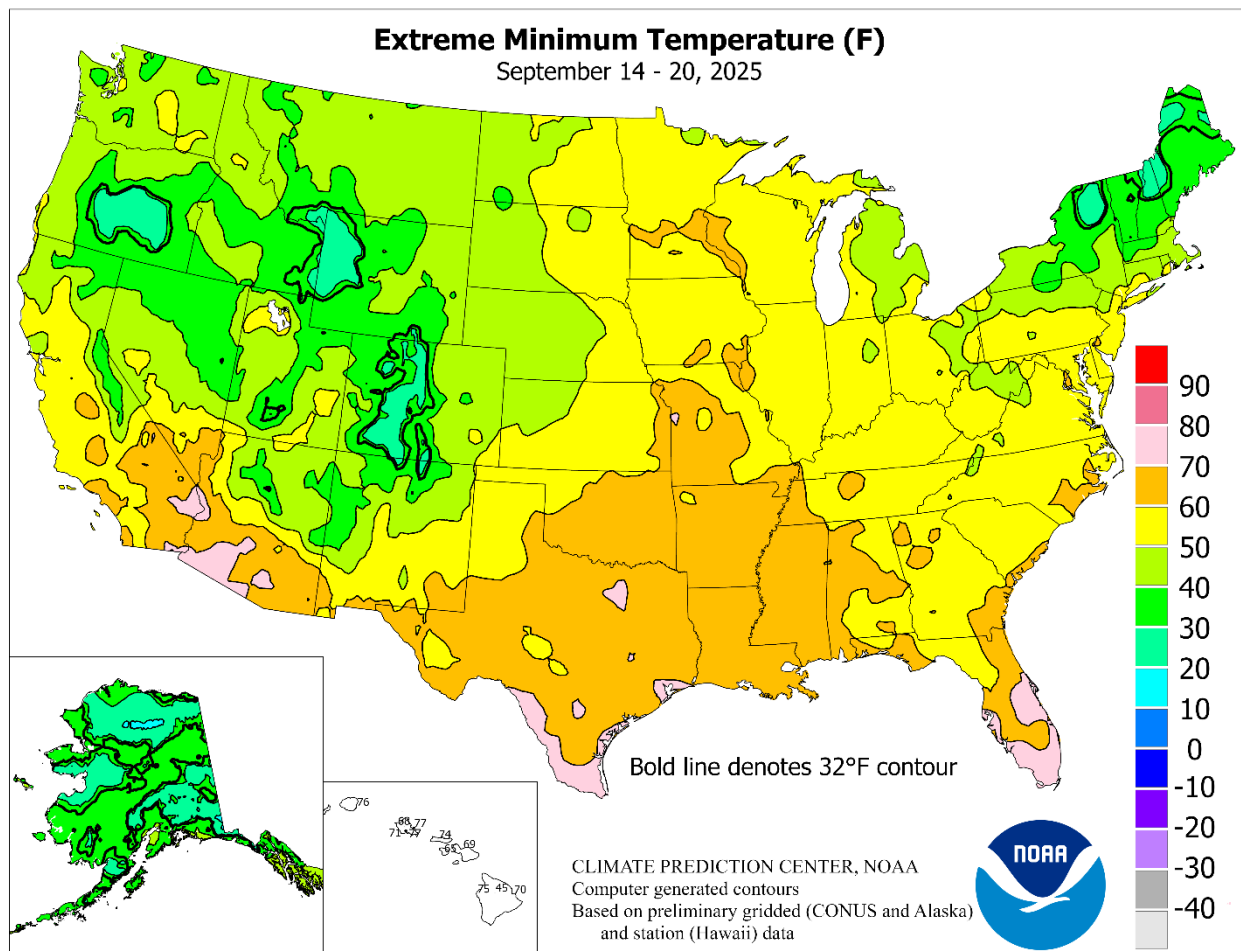
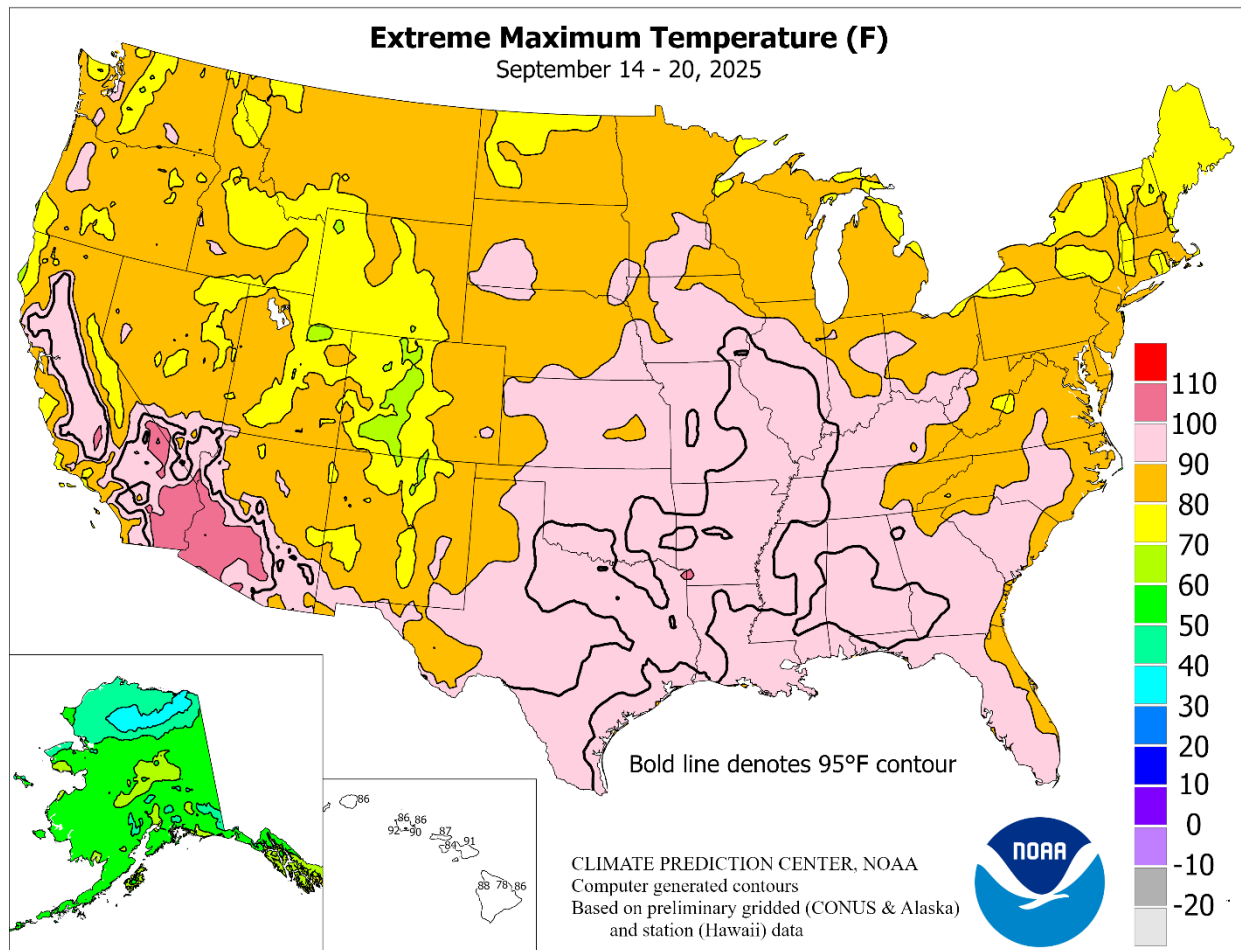

Significant rain developed across the **nation's mid-section**, including large sections of the **Plains** and **upper Midwest**. The rain, which bypassed parts of **Montana** and much of **Texas**, slowed fieldwork but boosted soil moisture for recently planted winter wheat. By week's end, rain had not yet reached into drier areas from the **mid-South into the Northeast**, where many pastures and immature summer crops continued to experience significant drought stress. Dry weather also dominated the **Deep South**—excluding **southern Florida** and the

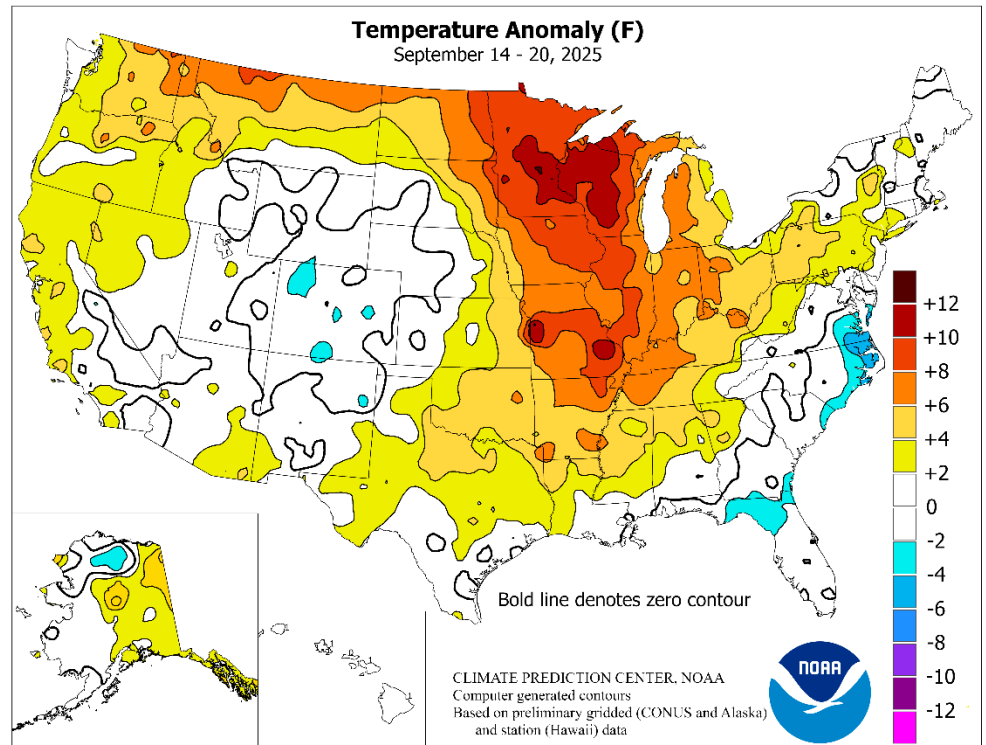

**southern tip of Texas**—favoring summer crop maturation and harvesting. Along the **middle Atlantic Coast**, a non-tropical storm system interrupted an otherwise dry weather pattern. Farther west, out-of-season showers—associated with moisture stripped from the remnants of **eastern Pacific** Tropical Storm Mario—fell in **central and southern California** and parts of the **Southwest**. Isolated showers dotted the **Northwest**, where more rain will be needed for the establishment of fall-sown crops, while mostly dry weather prevailed from **northern California to the Intermountain West**. Meanwhile, late-season warmth dominated the **eastern half of the U.S.**, except along and near the **Atlantic Coast**. Warm weather also covered the **nation's northern tier**, extending as far east as the **Great Lakes States**. Weekly temperatures averaged 5 to 10°F above normal in much of the **Mississippi Valley**, extending to other regions. Notably, readings also averaged at least 5°F above normal from **central and eastern Washington into the upper Midwest**. In contrast, temperatures averaged as much as 5°F below normal in the **middle and southern Atlantic States**. Cooler-than-normal conditions also prevailed in the **central Rockies**, but the remainder of the **western U.S.** experienced near- or above-normal temperatures.

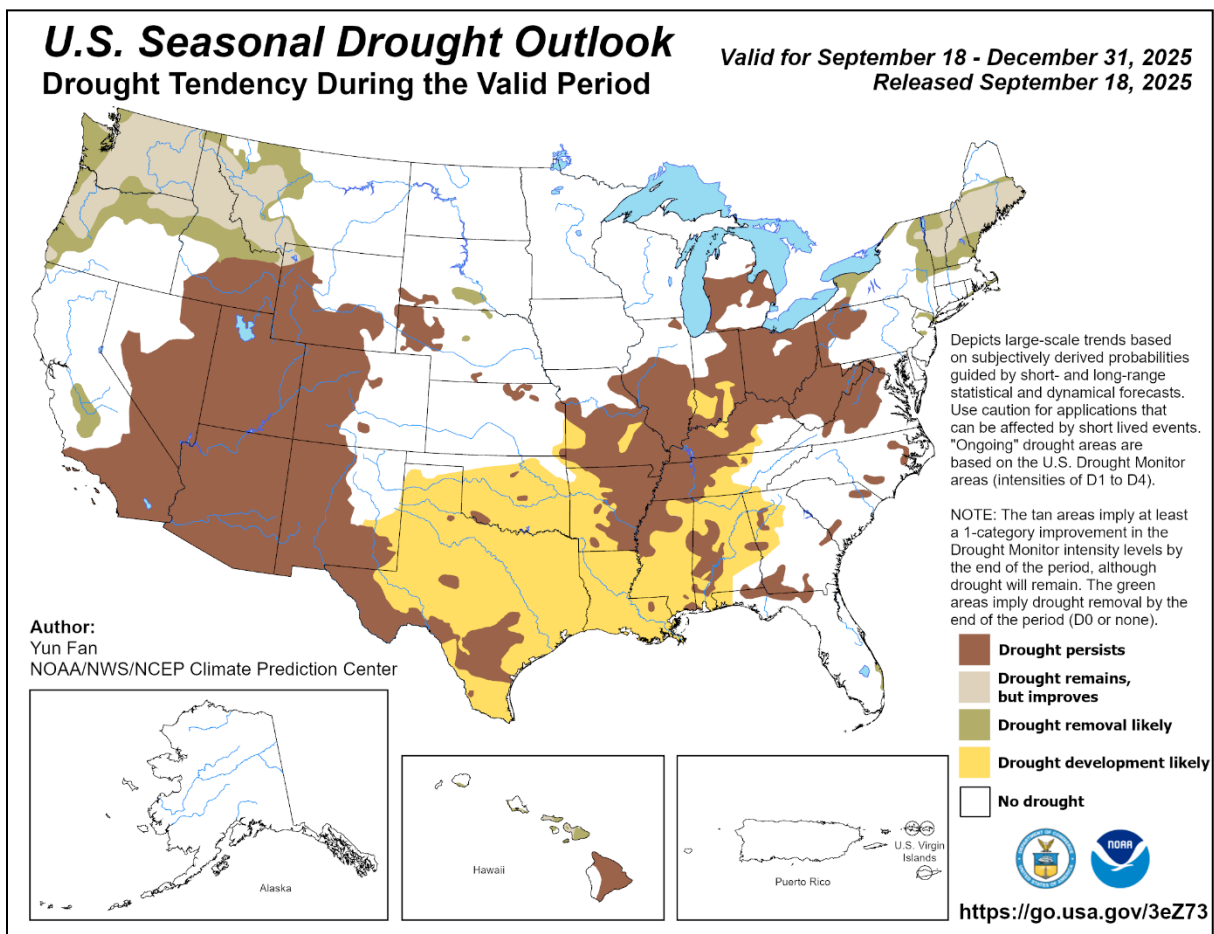
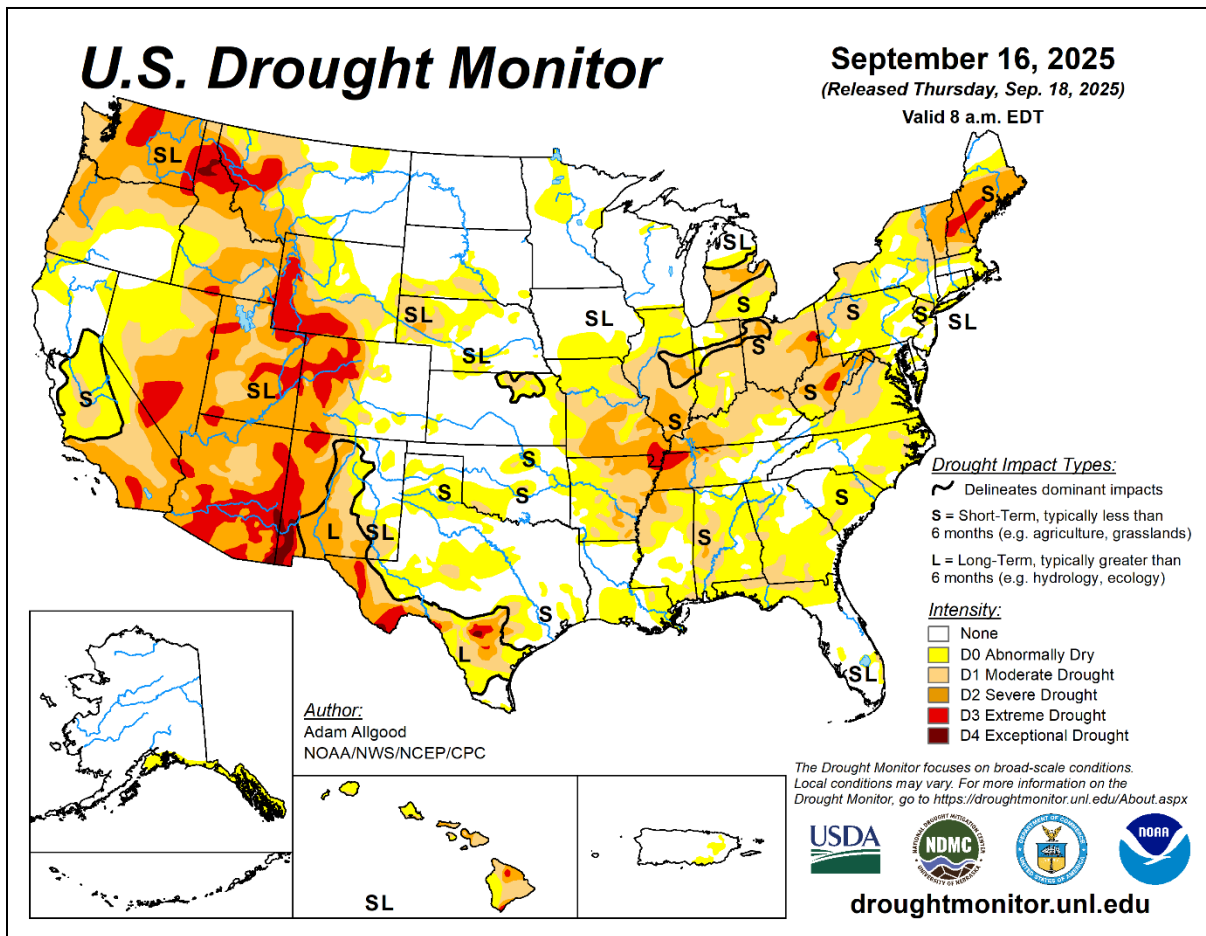
Despite widespread and sustained warmth in the **Mississippi Valley** and neighboring areas, only scattered records were set. In **Missouri**, however, daily-record highs included 96°F (on September 14 and 18) in **Cape Girardeau** and 95°F (on September 16) in **Springfield**. From September 11-18, high temperatures ranged from 92 to 96°F each day in **Cape Girardeau** and 91 to 95°F in **Springfield**. There was also a notable warm spell in the **Pacific Coast States**, where record-setting highs for September 16 rose to 96°F in **Roseburg, OR**, and 91°F in **Seattle, WA**. In **California**, **Livermore** noted a daily-record high of 99°F on September 17. Late in the week, heat shifted into parts of the **South and East**, where selected daily-record highs included 98°F (on September 18) in **Jackson, TN**, and 91°F (on September 20) in **Parkersburg, WV**. A few days earlier, when cool air had lingered in the **Atlantic Coast States**, record-setting lows in **Florida** for September 15 had included 56°F in **Tallahassee** and 60°F in **Jacksonville**.

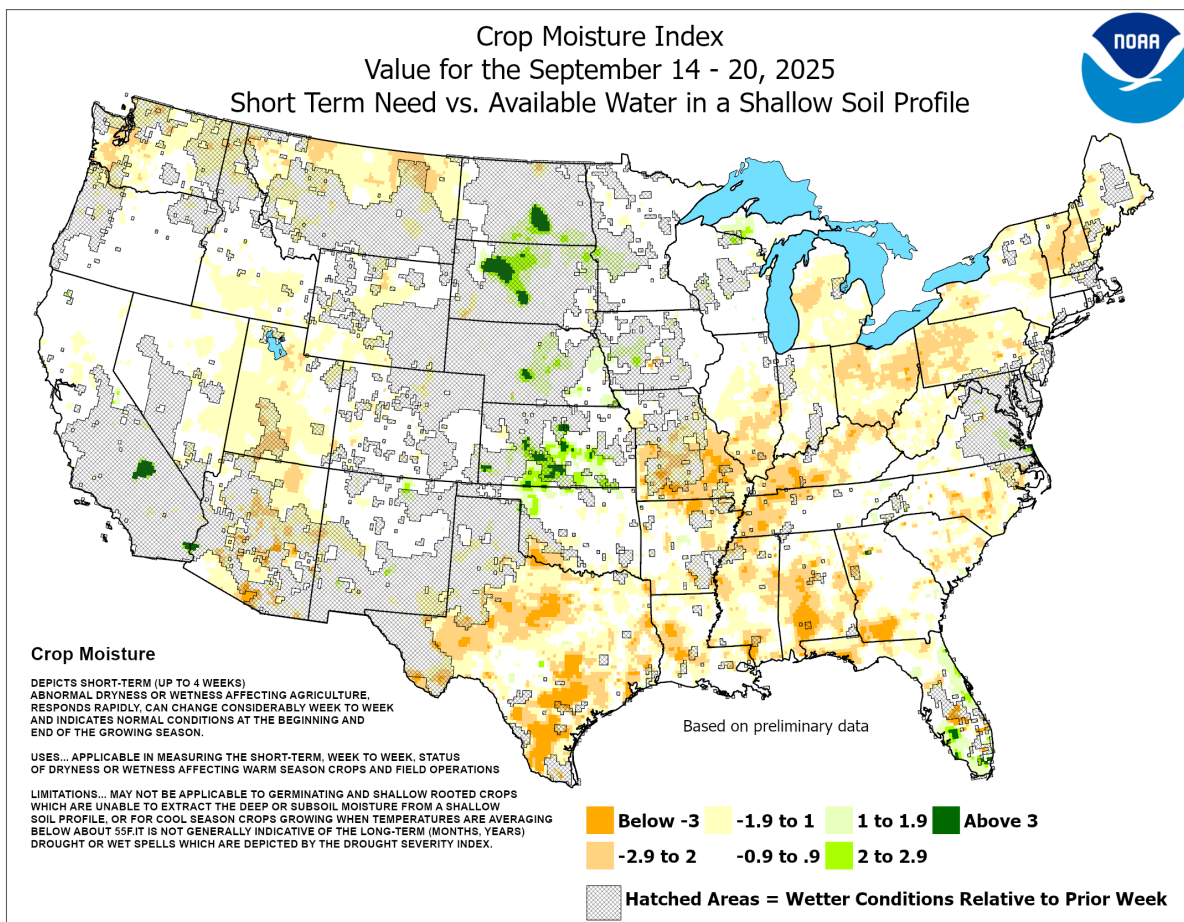
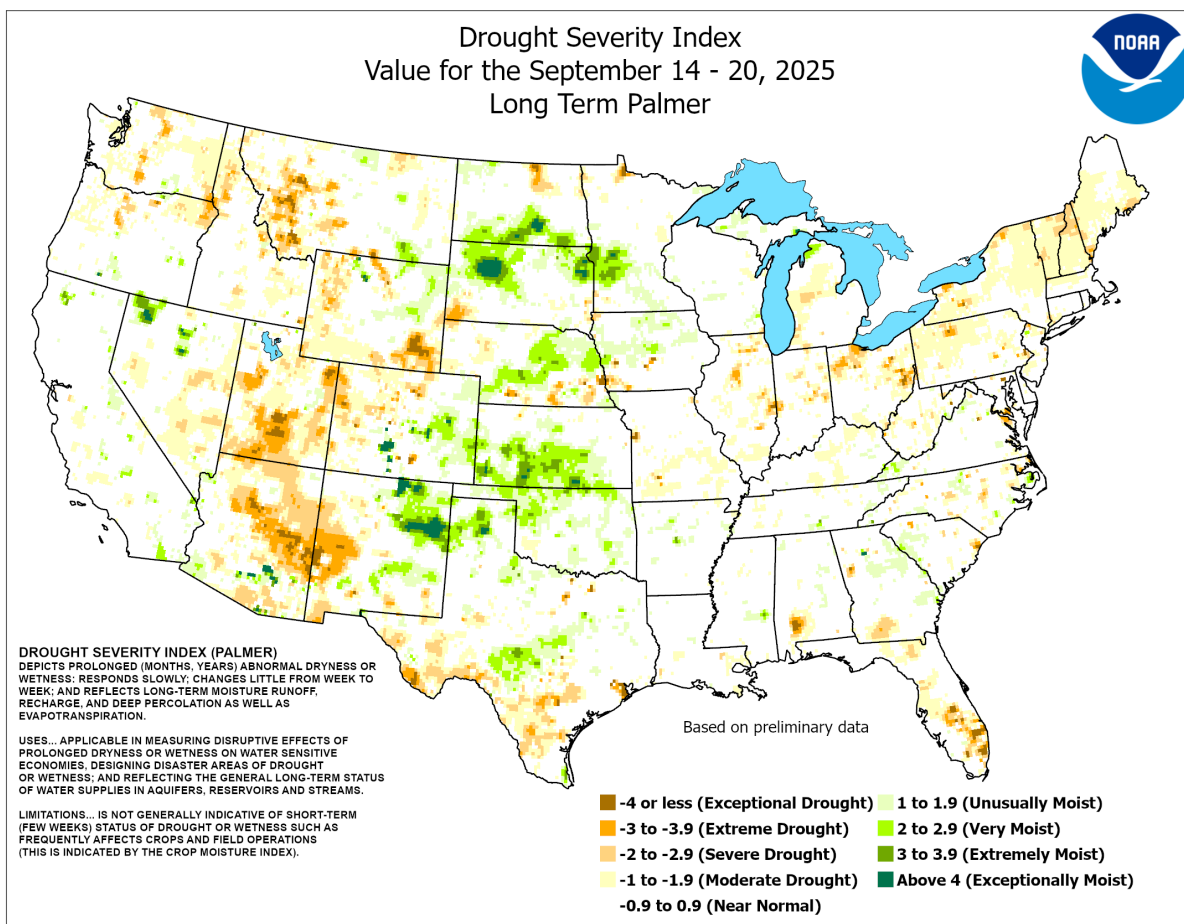
On September 14, as the week began, severe weather—including more than a dozen tornadoes—tore across portions of the **Dakotas**. On that date, daily-record rainfall totals included 2.44 inches in **Bismarck, ND**, and 1.16 inches in **Pierre, SD**. **Minot, ND**, noted a record-setting rainfall total (1.23 inches) for September 15. Rain shifted southward by the 16th, when **McCook, NE**, experienced its wettest September day on record. **McCook's** 5.01-inch total surpassed 4.33 inches on September 3, 2016. It was also **McCook's** third-wettest day during any month,

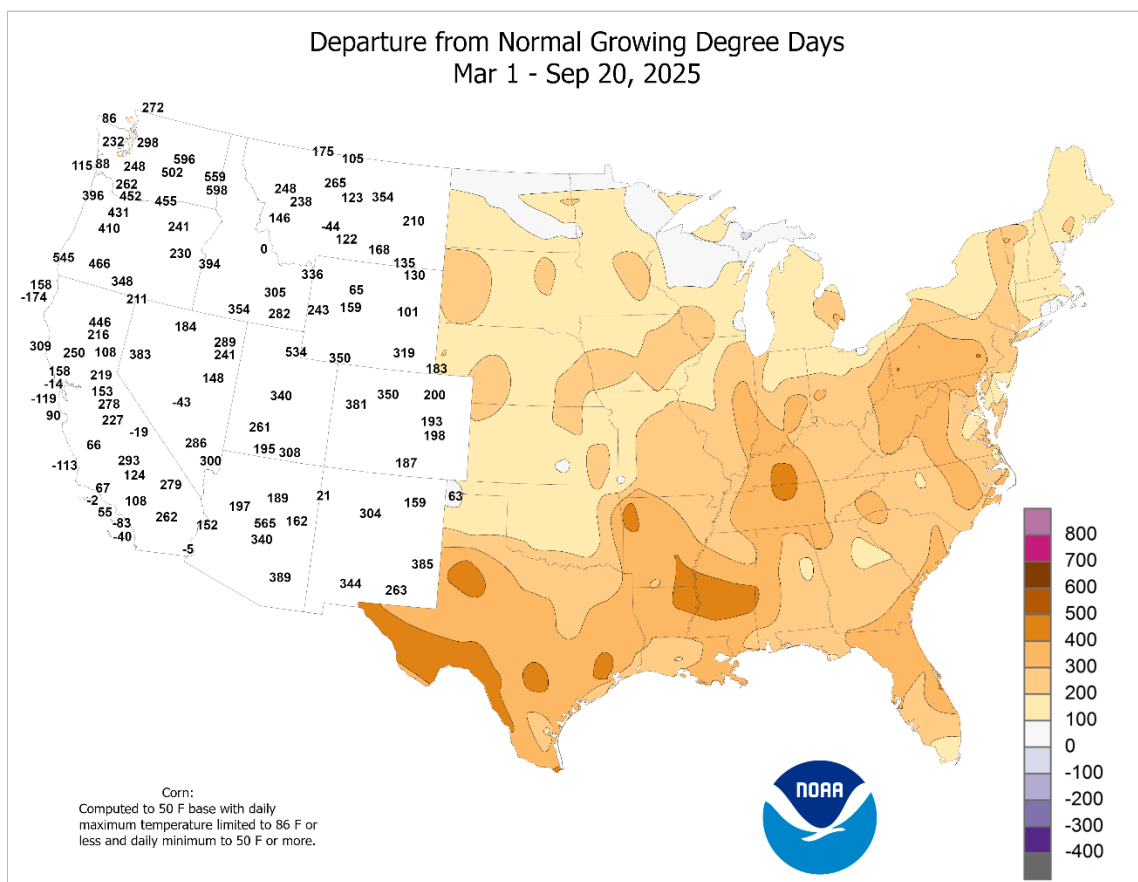
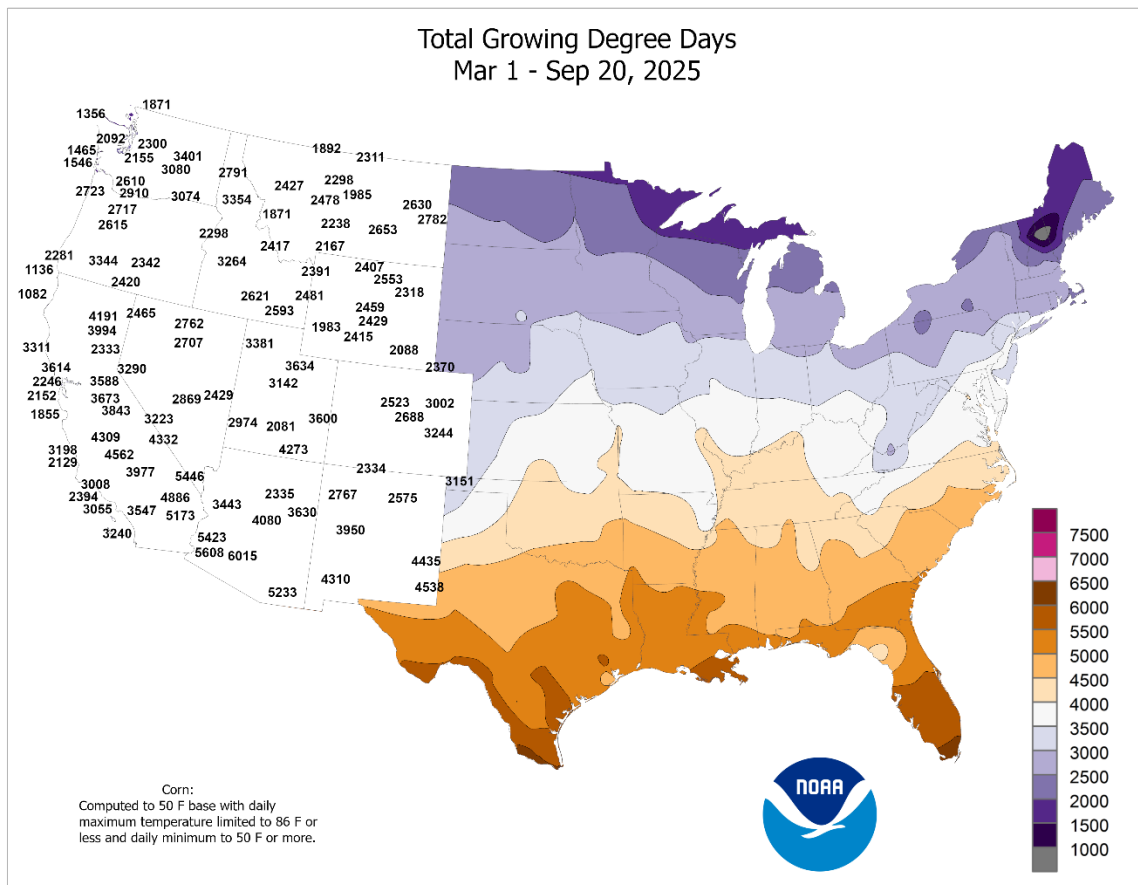


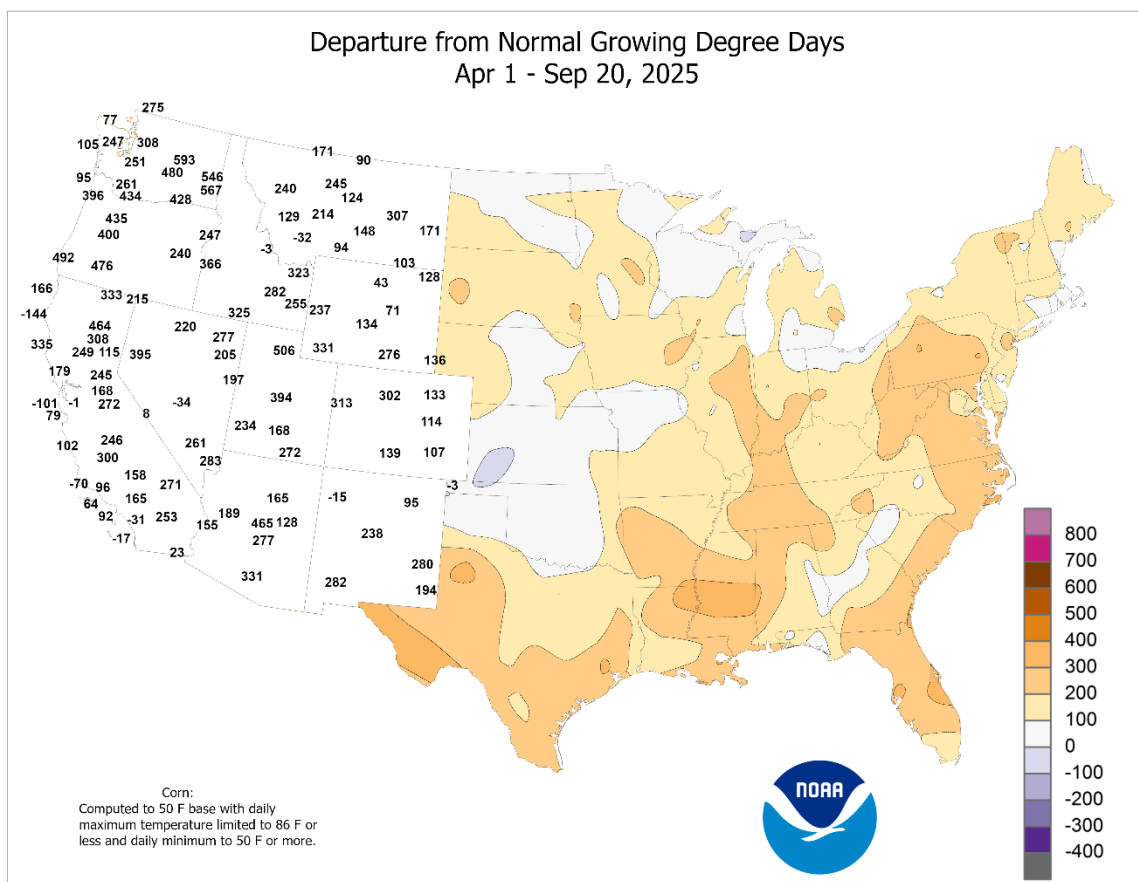
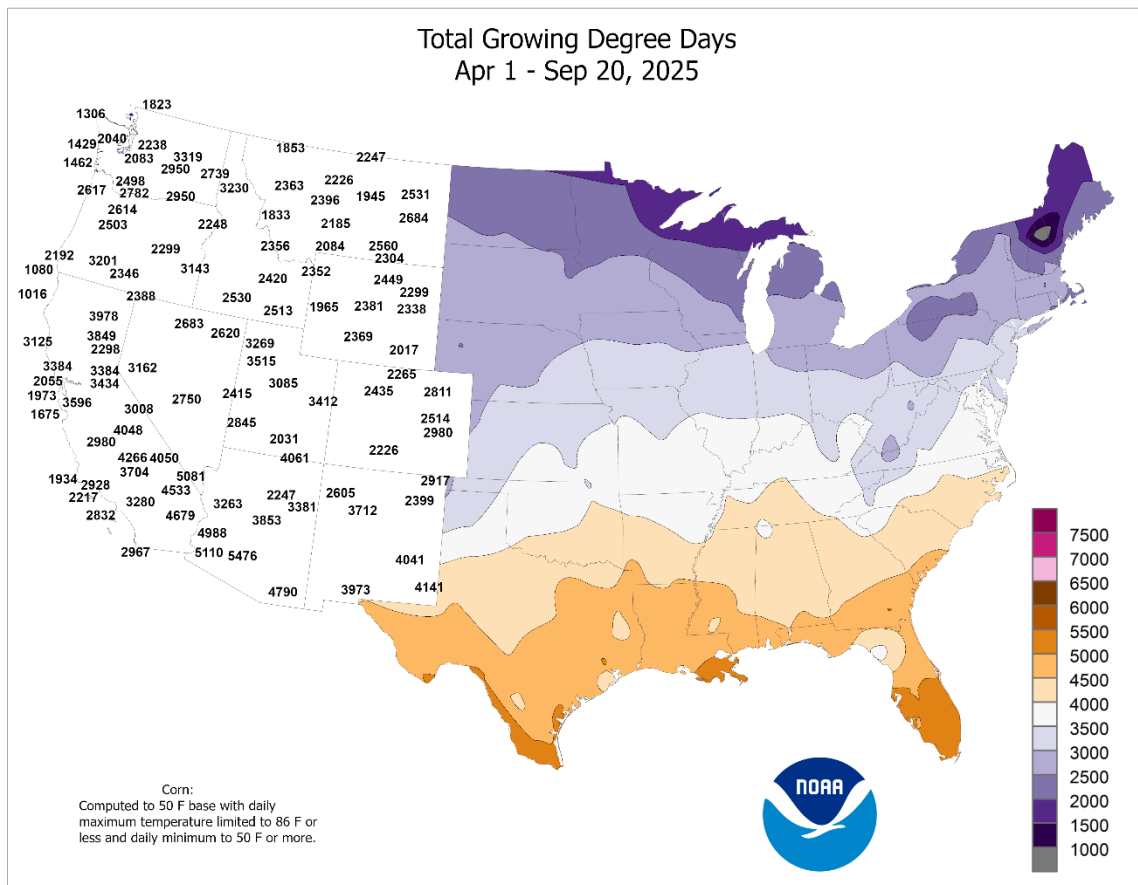
behind only 6.06 inches on May 26, 2023, and 5.13 inches on May 23, 2008. Elsewhere on September 16, daily-record totals included 1.40 inches in **Broken Bow, NE**, and 1.24 inches in **Casper, WY**. During another widespread round of showers on September 17, daily-record amounts included 2.57 inches in **Pierre, SD**; 2.00 inches in **Borger, TX**; and 1.12 inches in **Dodge City, KS**. **Casper** netted another daily record (0.82 inch), boosting its September 16-17 total to 2.06 inches. Meanwhile, mid- to late-week showers spread northward across the **West**. By September 18, daily-record totals in **California** included 0.74 inch in **Hanford** and 0.33 inch in **Needles**. **Hanford** noted another record, 0.28 inch, the following day. **Death Valley, CA**, received rainfall totaling 0.60 inch on September 18-19, contributing to flash flooding in the area. Heavy showers extended as far east as **western and southern Texas**, where record-setting totals included 1.95 inches (on September 19) in **El Paso** and 1.22 inches (on September 18) in **Laredo**.

Showery weather prevailed across parts of **Alaska**, with heavy precipitation falling in many southeastern locations. In fact, **Ketchikan** received a daily-record sum of 7.66 inches on September 15, followed by 5.53 inches on September 19-20. Through the 20th, **Ketchikan's** month-to-date rainfall climbed to 15.42 inches, 164 percent of normal. Meanwhile, near- or above-normal temperatures covered **Alaska**, except for cooler-than-normal conditions in some northern locations. From September 10-17, **Nome** recorded six freezes, including a low of 25°F (not a record for the date) on the 12th. In contrast, **Sitka** posted a daily-record high of 73°F on September 16. Farther south, much of **Hawaii** continued to experience drier-than-normal weather and gradually worsening drought. At the state's major airport observation sites, September 1-20 rainfall ranged from 0.01 inch (3 percent of normal) in **Kahului, Maui**, to 2.48 inches (43 percent) in **Hilo, on the Big Island**.

## National Agricultural Summary

September 15 – 21, 2025

### HIGHLIGHTS

**Weather conditions varied across key U.S. agricultural regions.** Temperatures ranged from near to above normal across much of the country. Parts of the Great Lakes region, the upper and middle Mississippi Valley, and the Ohio Valley recorded temperature averaging of 4 to 10°F above normal. In contrast, cooler-than-normal conditions were observed in scattered areas of the middle and southern Atlantic Coast States and the central Rockies, with temperatures averaging up to

6°F below normal. Meanwhile, portions of the Great Plains recorded above-normal rainfall, with localized areas receiving more than twice the normal weekly amount. However, dry conditions contributed to reductions in topsoil moisture across parts of the Corn Belt. Very short to short topsoil moisture ratings exceeded 70 percent in several states, including Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio. The western U.S. was mostly dry, although localized rainfall was recorded in the Southwest.

**Corn:** Ninety-one percent of the nation's corn had reached the dented stage by September 21, equal to last year but 2 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Fifty-six percent of the corn was mature by week's end, 3 percentage points behind both last year and the average. Eleven percent of the corn acreage had been harvested by September 21, two percentage points behind last year but equal to the average. On September 21, sixty-six percent of the nation's corn was rated in good to excellent condition, 1 percentage point below the previous week. In Iowa, the largest corn-producing state, 74 percent of the corn was rated in good to excellent condition.

**Soybeans:** By September 21, sixty-one percent of the soybeans had dropped leaves, 1 percentage point behind last year but 1 point ahead of the 5-year average. Nine percent of the soybean acreage had been harvested by September 21, three percentage points behind last year but equal to the average. On September 21, sixty-one percent of the soybeans were rated in good to excellent condition, 2 percentage points below the previous week.

**Cotton:** On September 21, sixty percent of the nation's cotton crop had bolls opening, 2 percentage points behind last year but 1 point ahead of the 5-year average. Twelve percent of the cotton had been harvested by September 21, one percentage point behind last year but equal to the average. Forty-seven percent of the cotton was rated in good to excellent condition by September 21, five percentage points below the previous week.

**Winter Wheat:** Nationwide, producers had sown 20 percent of the intended 2026 winter wheat acreage by September 21, three percentage points behind both last year and the 5-year average. By September 21, four percent of the winter wheat acreage had emerged, equal to both last year and the average.

**Sorghum:** Eighty-nine percent of the nation's sorghum had reached the coloring stage by September 21, two percentage points behind both last year and the 5-year average. By

September 21, fifty-two percent of the sorghum was mature, 6 percentage points behind last year and 2 points behind average. Twenty-five percent of the 2025 sorghum acreage had been harvested by September 21, three percentage points behind last year and 2 points behind average. On September 21, sixty-four percent of the sorghum was rated in good to excellent condition, 1 percentage point below the previous week.

**Rice:** Seventy-one percent of the nation's rice acreage had been harvested by September 21, one percentage point ahead of last year and 14 points ahead of the 5-year average. By September 21, producers in Louisiana and Texas had harvested 97 and 95 percent of their rice acreage, respectively.

**Other Small Grains:** Ninety-six percent of the spring wheat acreage had been harvested by September 21, one percentage point ahead of last year but equal to the 5-year average. By week's end, spring wheat acreage was at or beyond 95 percent harvested in five of the six estimating states.

**Other Crops:** Nine percent of the 2025 peanut acreage had been harvested by September 21, four percentage points ahead of last year and 3 points ahead of the 5-year average. On September 21, fifty-five percent of the peanuts were rated in good to excellent condition, 9 percentage points below the previous week. At week's end, South Carolina and Virginia led the nation with 80 percent of their peanuts rated in good to excellent condition.

Twelve percent of the 2025 sugarbeet acreage had been harvested by September 21, one percentage point ahead of last year but equal to the 5-year average. In three of the four estimating states, sugarbeet harvest progress was equal to or ahead of the average pace.

By September 21, one percent of the sunflower acreage had been harvested in Colorado, 1 percentage point ahead of both last year and the 5-year average.

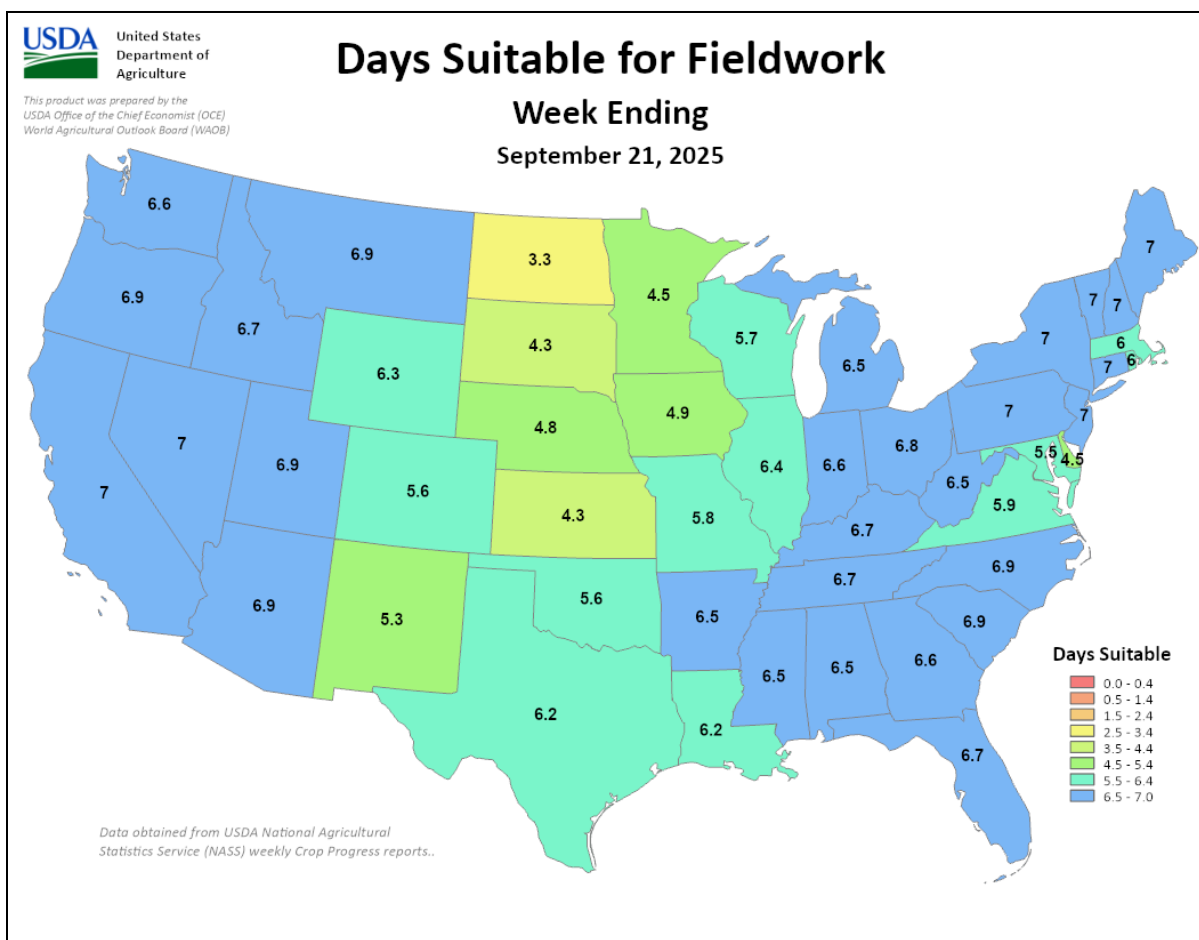

## International Weather and Crop Summary

September 14 – 20, 2025

International Weather and Crop Highlights and Summaries provided by USDA/WAOB

### HIGHLIGHTS

**EUROPE:** Additional widespread showers maintained overall favorable conditions for winter crops across central and northern Europe, while drought persisted in Greece and the Balkans.

**WESTERN FSU:** Dry and warm weather favored fieldwork but heightened short-term dryness in west-central Russia, while showers improved soil moisture for winter crops in western- and southern-most growing areas.

**MIDDLE EAST:** Dry but cooler conditions in Turkey favored seasonal fieldwork, though heavy showers were noted along the Black Sea Coast.

**SOUTH ASIA:** Widespread monsoon rain continued, with the exception of Pakistan and northwestern India, where the monsoon started to recede.

**EAST ASIA:** Though widespread rain fell across the region, some areas remained dry, even as Tropical Storm Mitag unleashed a deluge on China's southern coast.

**SOUTHEAST ASIA:** The northern Philippines (Luzon) was impacted by both Tropical Storm Mitag and the approaching Typhoon Ragasa, even as heavy and widespread monsoon rains continued to affect Thailand and its surrounding areas.

**AUSTRALIA:** Light to moderate showers maintained good to excellent prospects for vegetative to reproductive winter crops.

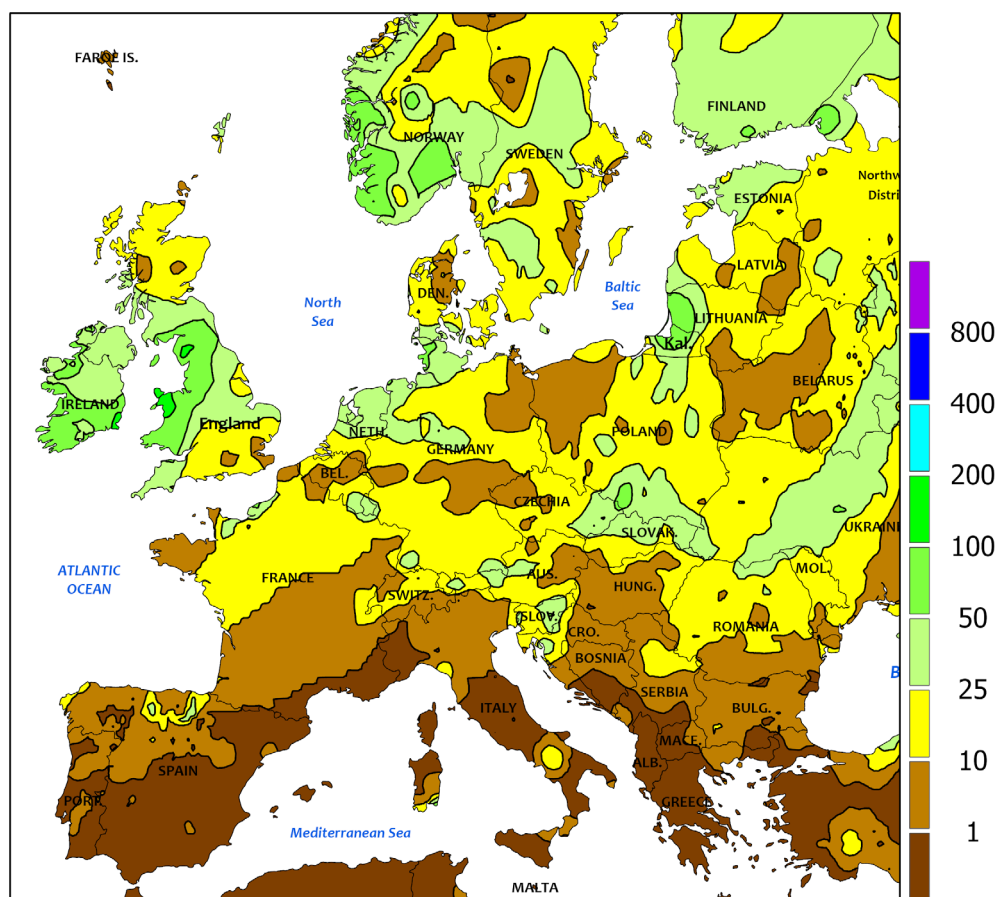
**MEXICO:** Tropical showers maintained mostly favorable moisture reserves for immature summer crops throughout the country and further eased drought in northwestern Mexico.

**CANADIAN PRARIES:** Prairie harvesting of small grains and oilseeds quickly advanced, amid summer-like warmth.

**SOUTHEASTERN CANADA:** Freezes ended the growing season in parts of Quebec and eastern Ontario, with overall minor impacts on immature summer crops.

EUROPE

Additional widespread showers maintained or improved moisture supplies for winter crops across much of central and northern Europe, while dry weather prevailed over the Mediterranean Basin. A pair of cold fronts bookended the week, with widespread showers and thunderstorms noted from England and France\* eastward into Poland and the Baltic States. Weekly rainfall totaled 10 to 50 mm over many of the continent's primary growing areas, with amounts locally in excess of 100 mm in western portions of England and Norway. Conversely in southern Europe, mostly dry weather favored summer crop harvesting and

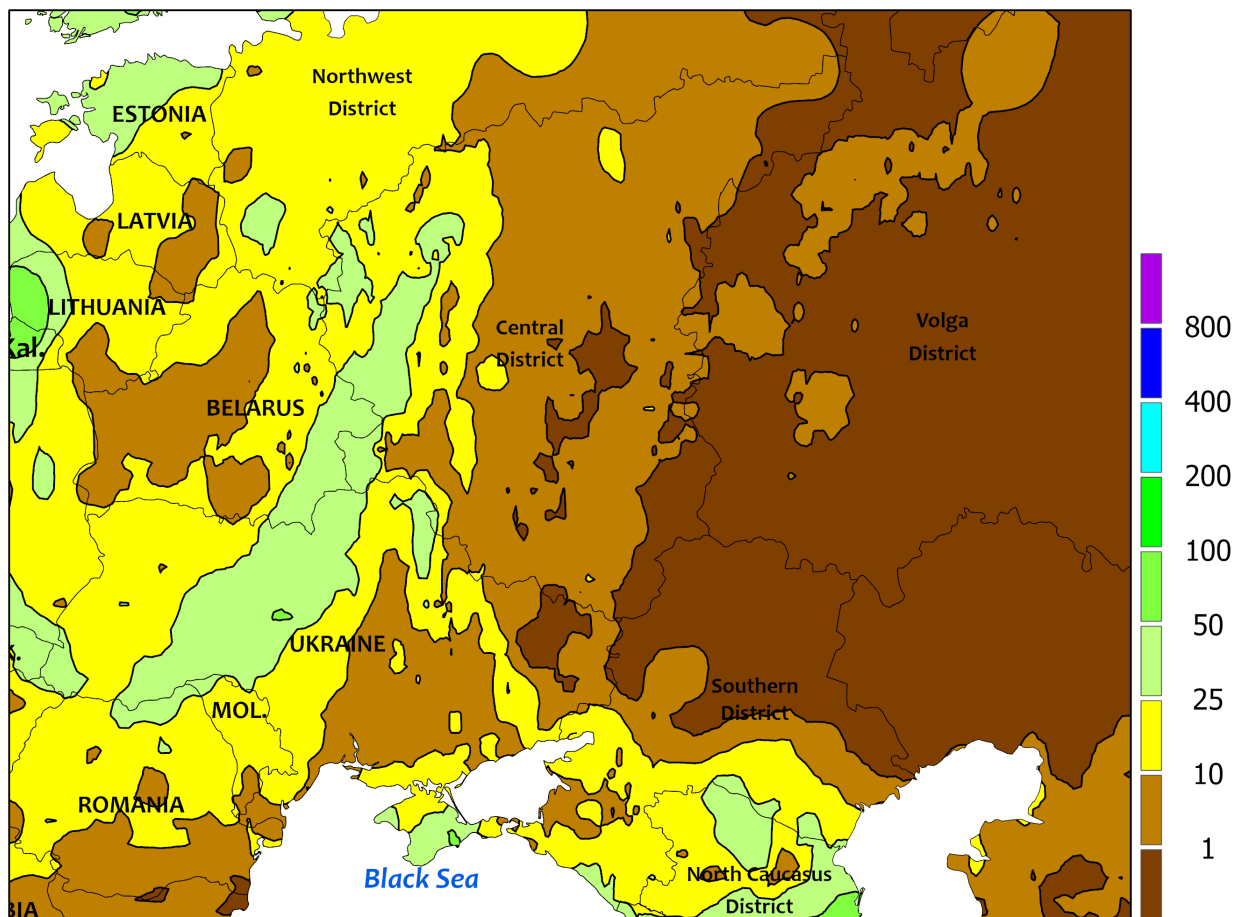
winter crop sowing but sustained drought concerns over Greece and the lower Danube River Valley. Farther west, sunny skies in Spain were accompanied by searing late-season heat, with daytime highs reaching the upper 30s (degrees C) in central and southern portions of the country; in fact, temperatures during the third week of September were the hottest on record for this time of year — by far — in Andalucía and Castilla La Mancha.

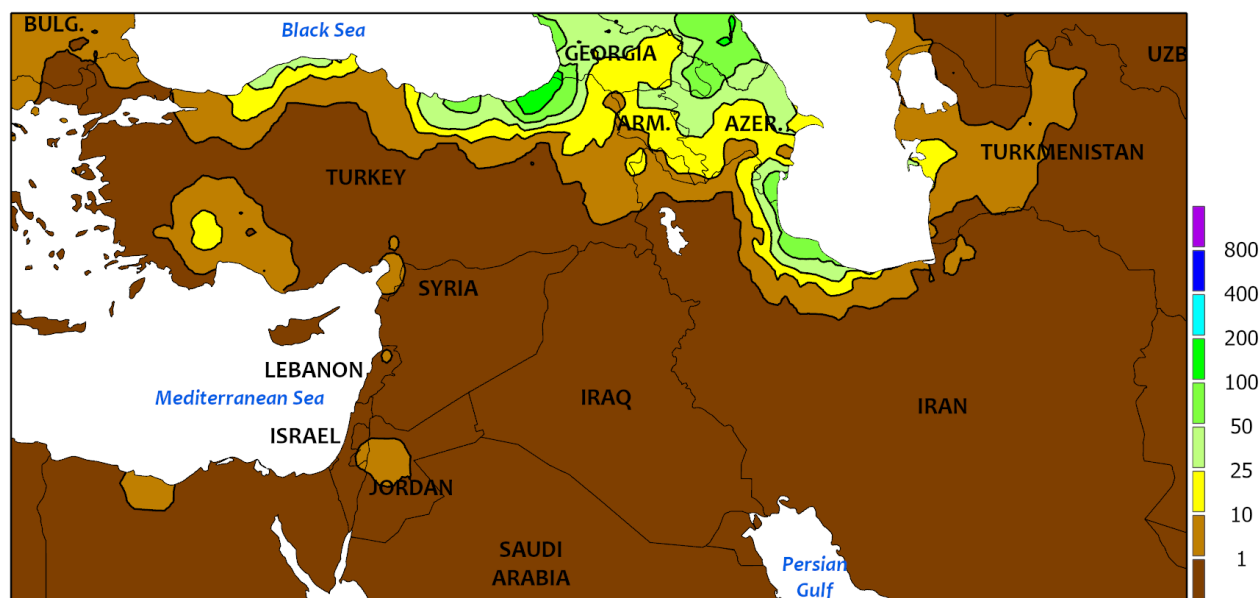


## WESTERN FSU

Showers in western and southern crop areas contrasted with short-term dryness in west-central Russia. An upper-air disturbance tracked southeastward from western Ukraine, triggering widespread showers and thunderstorms (10-40 mm) in Belarus, western Ukraine and central Ukraine, and Moldova. Showers accompanied the disturbance as it traced the Black Sea Coast, with 10 to 50 mm reported in southern Russia's

North Caucasus District and the southern tier of the Southern District. The rain eased drought along the Black Sea Coast and maintained adequate to abundant moisture supplies for winter crops farther west and north. Conversely, mostly dry weather persisted across west-central Russia, raising concerns over developing short-term drought but promoting a rapid pace of summer crop harvesting and winter crop sowing.

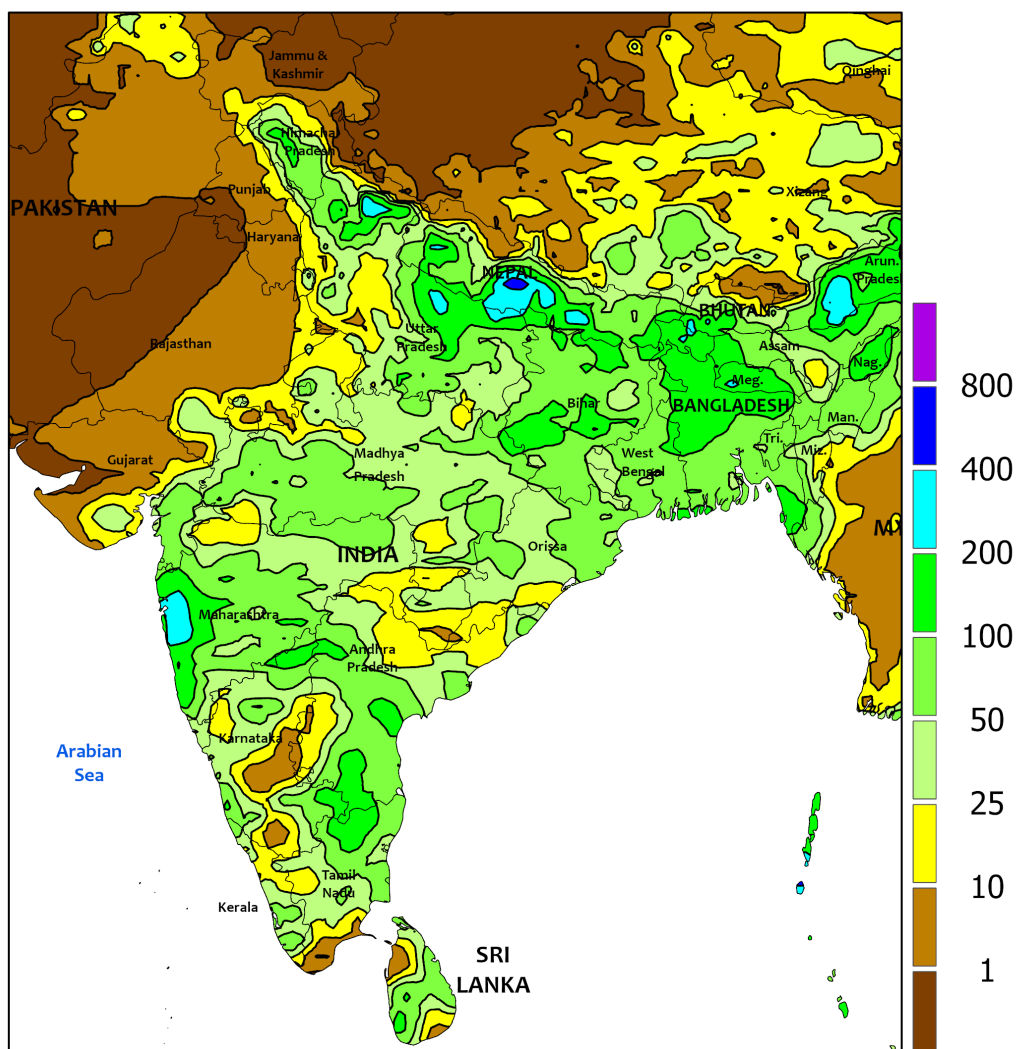


MIDDLE EAST

Mostly dry but cooler weather prevailed in Turkey during the monitoring period, though locally heavy rain fell on the country's northern coast. A disturbance tracked southeastward across Black Sea, with a trailing cold front producing moderate to very heavy showers and thunderstorms along Turkey's Black Sea Coast (10-80 mm, but as much as 260 mm

in eastern-most locales). The remainder of Turkey was dry but sharply cooler following the front's passage, promoting summer crop harvesting and winter grain sowing. Seasonably sunny and warm weather persisted elsewhere in the Middle East, though heavy showers were noted along the Iranian Caspian Sea Coast courtesy of the aforementioned disturbance.

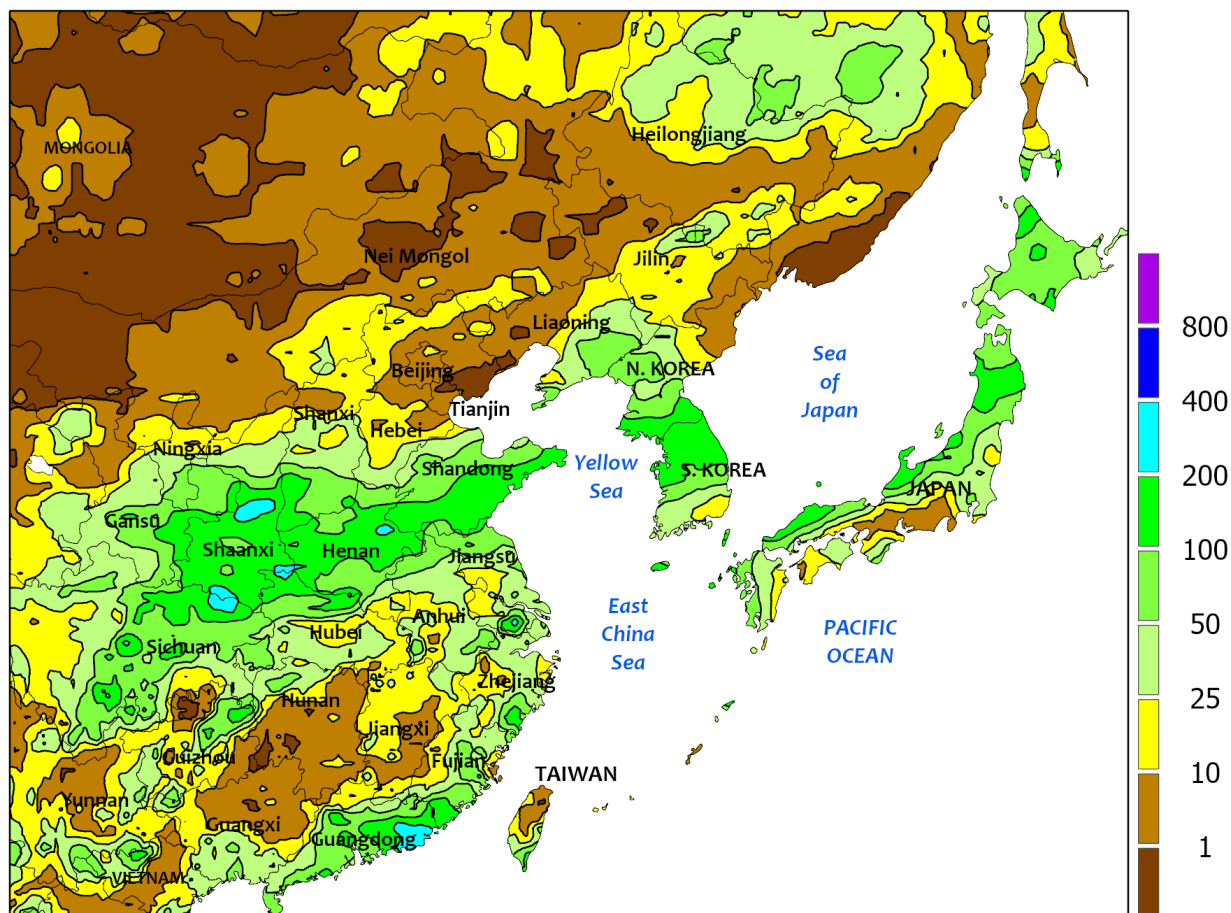


### SOUTH ASIA

The region experienced continued widespread rainfall, with most areas receiving between 25 and 200 mm and some isolated totals exceeding 200 mm. In contrast, most of Pakistan and parts of northwestern India saw little to no rainfall (less than 10 mm) as the Southwest Monsoon began its withdrawal on September 14, three days earlier than normal and nine days earlier than last year. This rainfall offered only slight relief from ongoing

flooding in Pakistan, which has been primarily caused by heavy upstream precipitation in India and glacial melt. Temperatures were at or slightly above normal (1–3°C above average) across the region. The most extreme heat was concentrated primarily in Pakistan and northern India, where daytime highs climbed into the upper 30s (degrees C). Temperatures were slightly milder elsewhere, with highs in the lower to middle 30s and nighttime lows in the 20s.

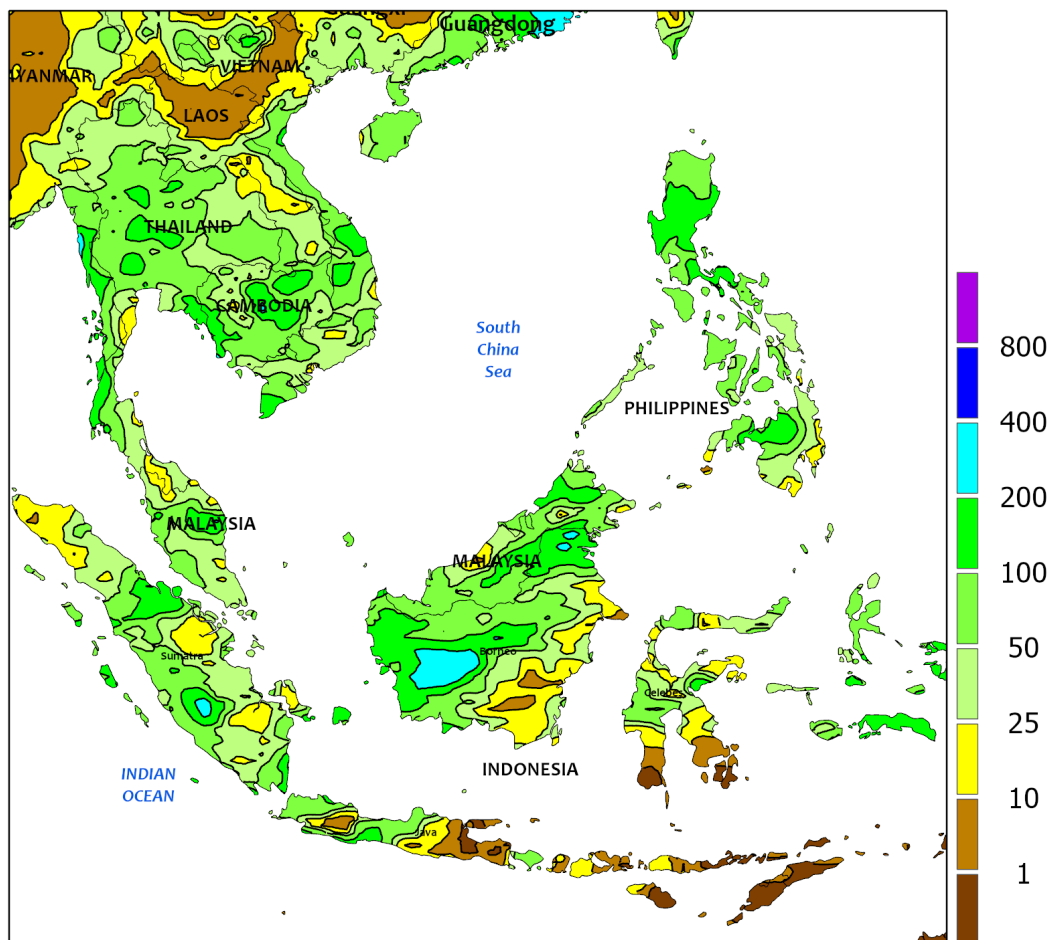


**EASTERN ASIA**

After Tropical Storm Mitag made landfall east of Hong Kong in China's Guangdong province, where it caused downpours of more than 200 mm, the region experienced a mix of widespread showers and dry conditions, alongside unseasonably high temperatures. Most of the Korean Peninsula and Japan also saw widespread showers, with most areas receiving 25 to 200 mm and isolated spots recording over 200 mm. Elsewhere, showers of 10 to 100 mm were common, though some locations received extremely heavy rainfall (100–300 mm). In stark

contrast, Mongolia, northern China near the Mongolian border, and parts of southern China received little to no rain (less than 10 mm), and showers were lighter and more scattered in northeast China (under 50 mm). While the region endured unseasonably high temperatures (1–6°C above normal) with daytime highs in the upper 30s (degrees C), cooler nighttime conditions created more favorable conditions for maturing crops. A similar pattern was seen in Xinjiang, where nighttime lows (5–15°C) provided relief from daytime highs in the upper 20s and 30s.

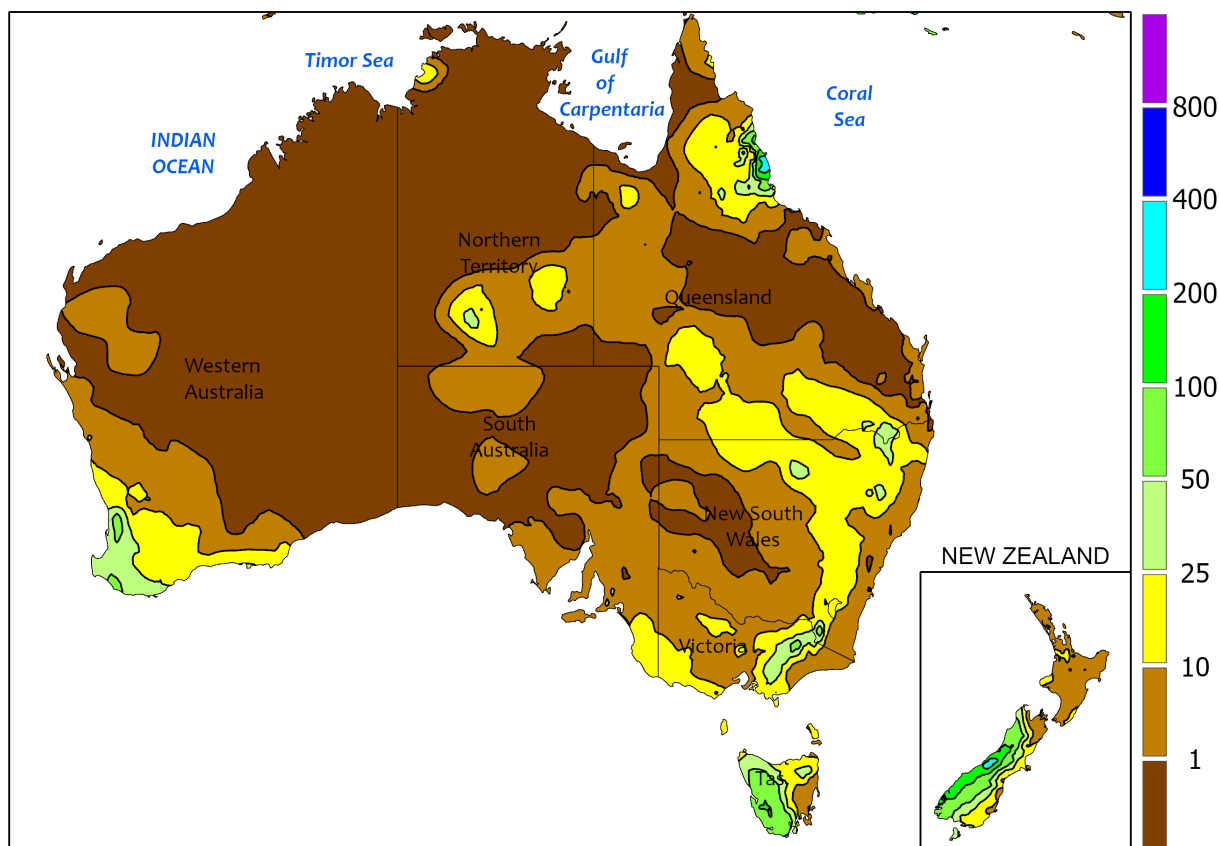
A combination of widespread monsoon activity and tropical systems influenced rainfall across the region, while some areas experienced extreme, unrelated downpours. Thailand and its neighbors received 25 to 200 mm of rain from monsoon showers. Meanwhile, several isolated instances of exceptionally heavy, non-tropical rainfall (300 mm or more) were recorded in other countries. In the Philippines, the Luzon area endured heavier downpours first from Tropical

Storm Mitag, which moved north-northwestward across the island, and later in the week from the approaching Typhoon Ragasa. Indonesia also faced continued excessive rainfall, with some already saturated areas adding 50 to 200 mm to their totals. Amid these weather patterns, temperatures region-wide were at or just above normal (1-2°C above normal) with daytime highs in the middle to upper 30s (degrees C) and nighttime lows in the lower to middle 20s.

## AUSTRALIA

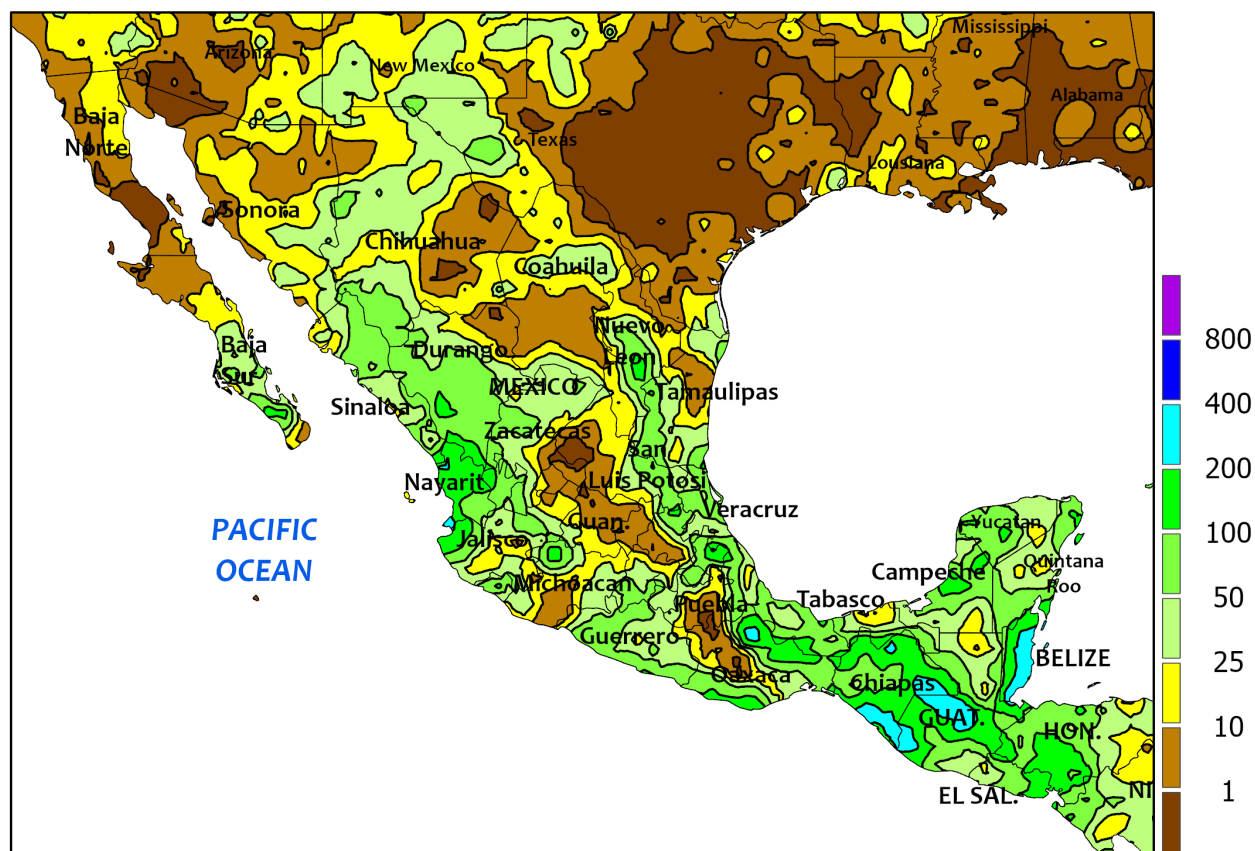
Widespread showers across many of the country's primary croplands maintained good to excellent prospects for winter grains and oilseeds. A cold front swept eastward across southern Australia, generating 5 to 40 mm of rain in Western Australia's primary growing areas. The same system produced light to moderate showers (1-30 mm) over much of southeastern and eastern Australia, while heavy rain (50-110 mm) fell in the

higher elevations of the Great Dividing Range in southern New South Wales and northeastern Victoria. As a result, conditions remained good to excellent for vegetative (south and southeast) to reproductive (west and north) winter wheat, barley, and rapeseed. Temperatures averaged near normal for the week, as unseasonable warmth ahead of the cold front was offset by sharply cooler air following the front's passage.

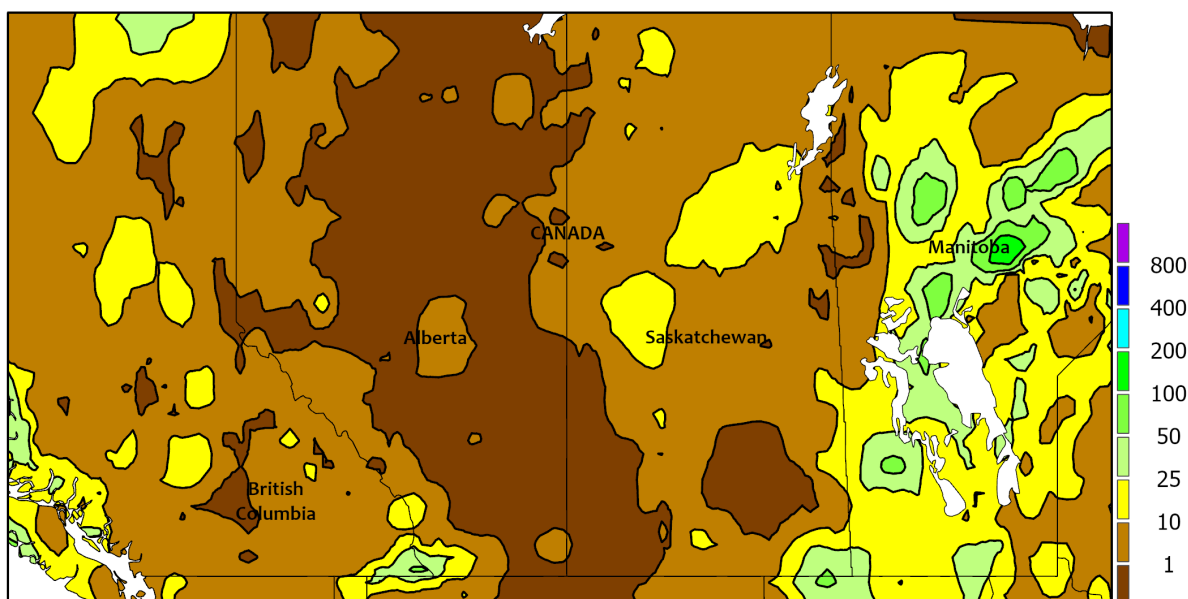


## MEXICO

Although Tropical Storm Mario dissipated over open water on September 16, moisture stripped from the former eastern Pacific cyclone contributed to unusually heavy rain in parts of northwestern Mexico. Tropical moisture from other sources resulted in significant shower activity in the Pacific Coast States as far north as Sinaloa and much of southeastern Mexico. Some of the highest weekly

rainfall totals, locally exceeding 200 mm, occurred in Chiapas and neighboring states. Locally heavy rain also affected the Gulf Coast States. Meanwhile, generally light but highly variable amounts (mostly less than 50 mm) fell across the southern plateau corn belt, though immature summer crops retained plenty of soil moisture for normal development.

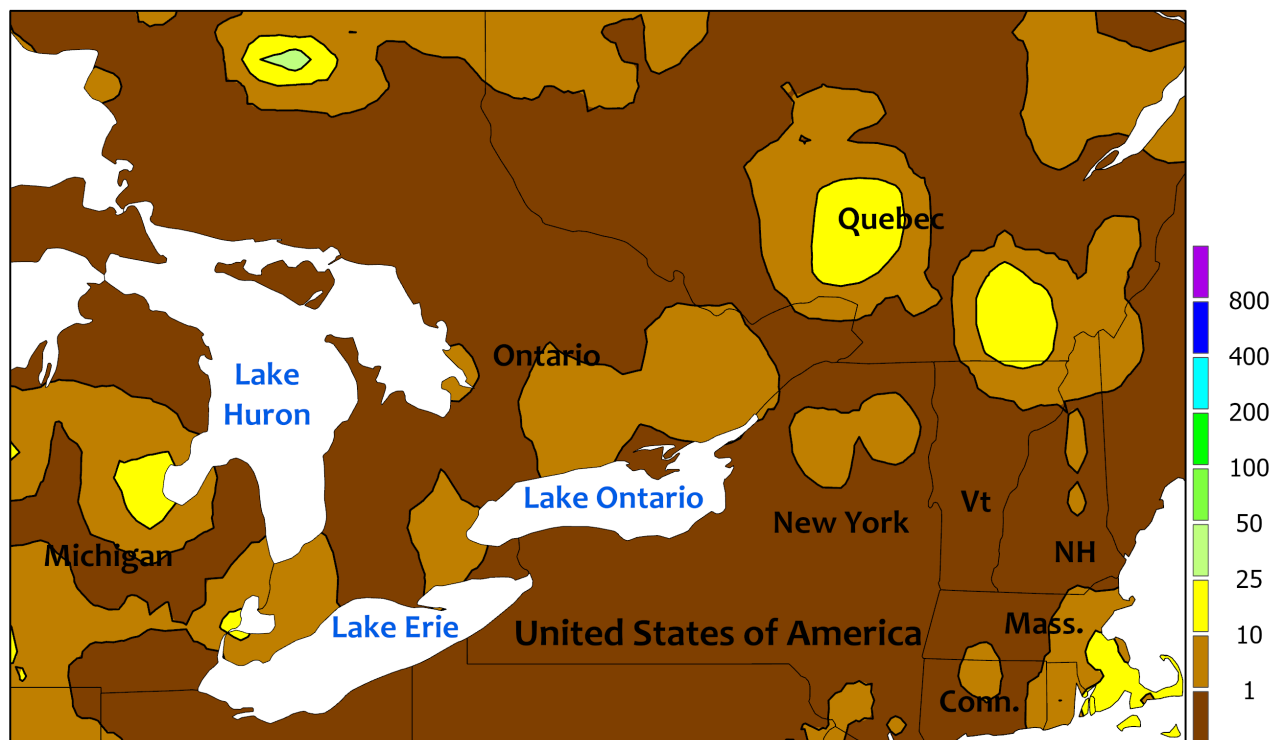
As the week began, harvest completion of major crops ranged from 50 percent in Manitoba to 59 percent in Alberta. Subsequently, a late-season warm spell promoted a rapid pace of small grain and oilseed harvesting, although brief showers (locally 10-25 mm or more) in southern Manitoba and neighboring areas resulted in temporary fieldwork delays. Weekly

temperatures averaged 4 to 6°C above normal throughout the Prairies, with readings reaching 30°C or higher in southern Alberta and southwestern Saskatchewan. As summer crop harvesting nears completion in the next few weeks, precipitation will be needed in the western Prairies for germination and establishment of any fall-sown crops.

## SOUTHEASTERN CANADA

A late-week cold snap delivered freezes across parts of eastern Ontario and southern Quebec. Although minimum temperatures were highly variable, a few locations reported hard freezes, with readings from -2 to -4°C. In some of the colder agricultural locations, frost and freezes ended the growing season, with impacts on immature summer crops being monitored. Meanwhile, southwestern Ontario

escaped without a freeze, allowing summer crops to push toward maturity. For the week, near- or slightly above-normal temperatures were observed, as the cool spell replaced previously warm conditions. Meanwhile, dry weather prevailed throughout the week, allowing any fieldwork to proceed. Notably, winter wheat planting was just getting underway in southwestern Ontario.

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
