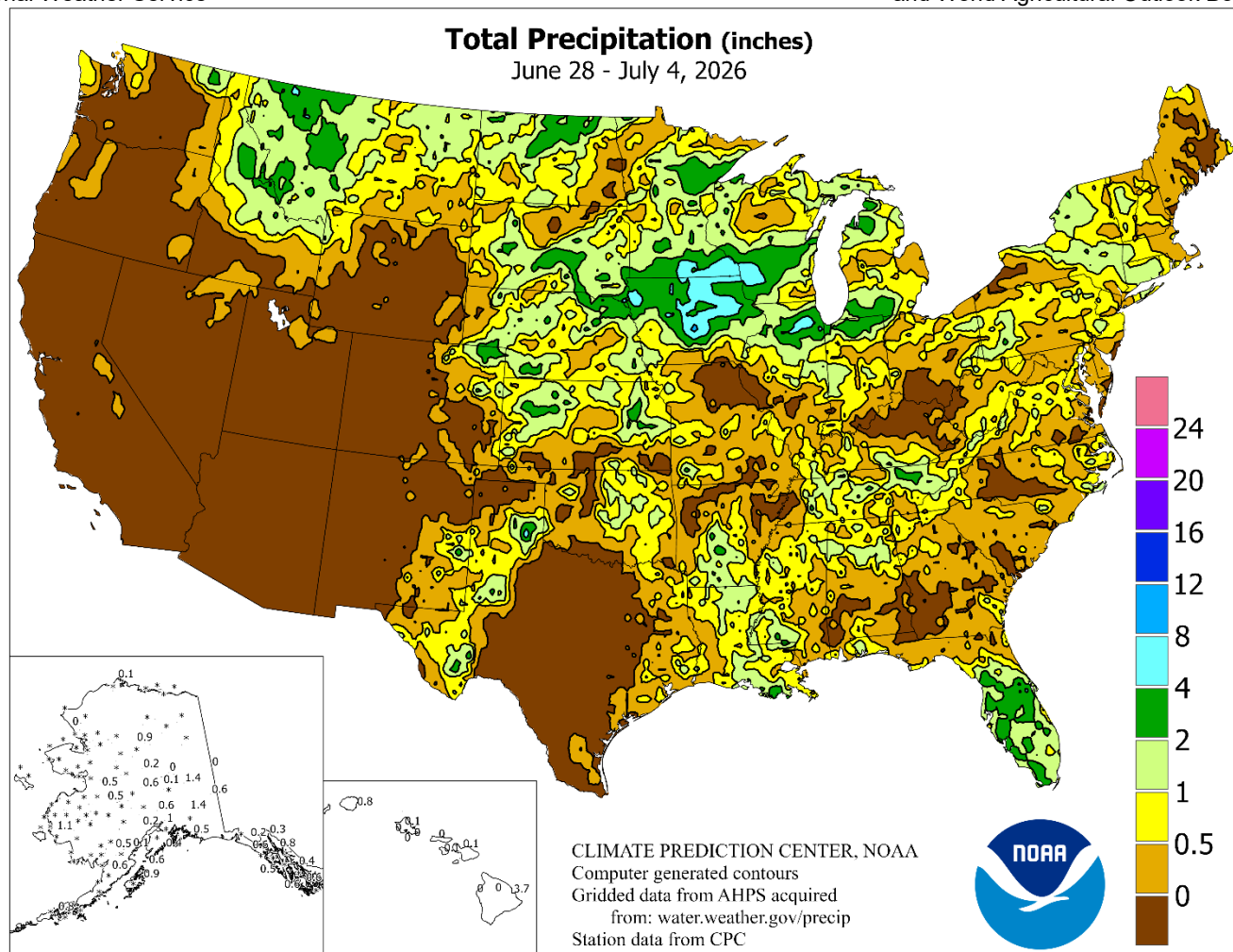

## HIGHLIGHTS

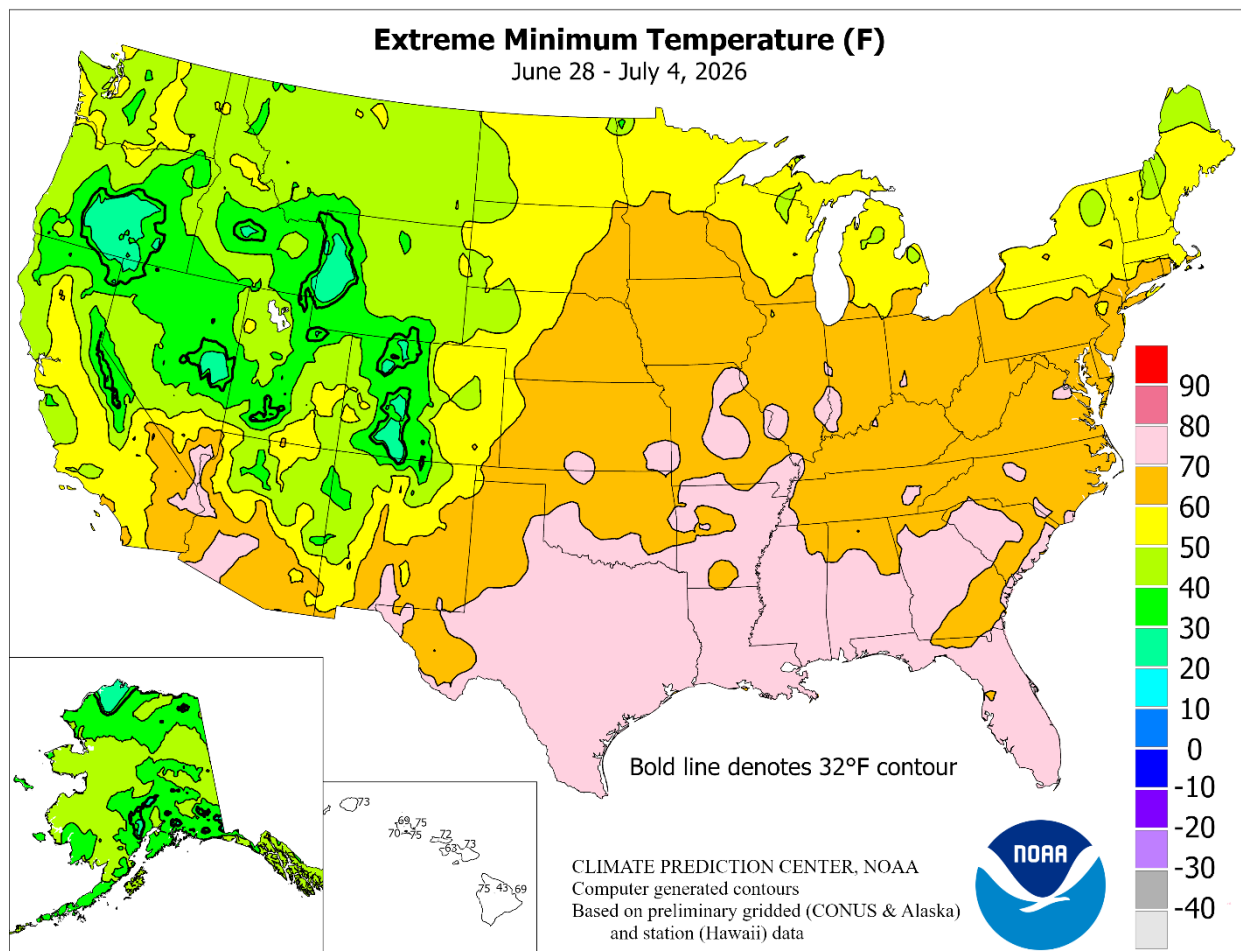
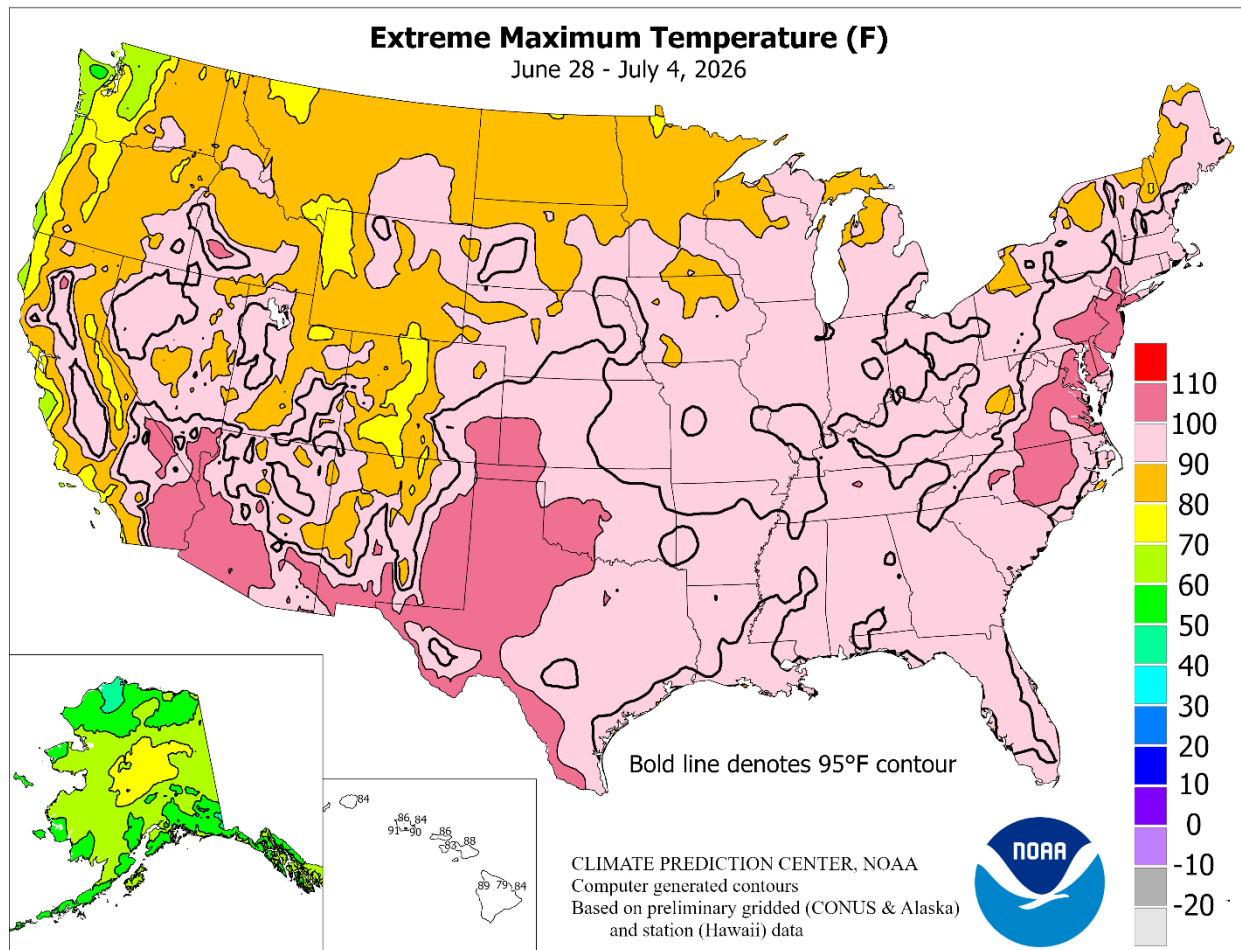
**June 28 – July 4, 2026**

Significant precipitation continued from the **northern Rockies into the upper Midwest and portions of the Great Lakes region**, but rainfall coverage and intensity decreased across the remainder of the **central and eastern U.S.** Building heat accompanied the modest drying trend from the **central and southern Plains into the middle and southern Atlantic States**, excluding **Florida's peninsula**. Near- or above-normal weekly temperatures prevailed along and east of a line from **southeastern Arizona into the western Dakotas**. Readings averaged 5 to 10°F above  
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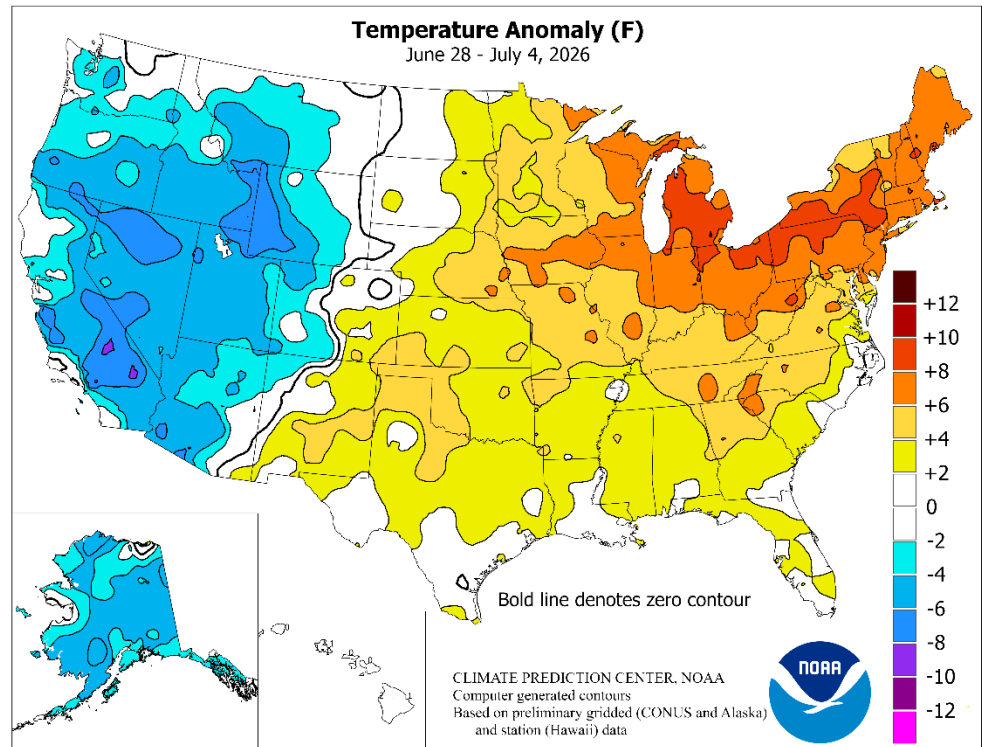
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normal in most areas from the **Midwest into the middle and northern Atlantic States**. In contrast, readings averaged at least 5°F below normal at many interior locations across the **West**. Despite the cool weather, an elevated wildfire threat continued to plague parts of the **western U.S.**, amid ongoing drought, low humidity levels, and gusty winds. By early July, year-to-date U.S. wildfires had charred more than 3.3 million acres of vegetation, well above the 10-year average of 2.3 million. One of the most destructive active blazes, the Aspen Acres Fire, has scorched more than 90,000 acres southwest of **Pueblo, CO**, and has destroyed more than 800 structures. Farther north, weekly precipitation totaled as much as 2 to 4 inches in **western Montana** and neighboring areas, while totals exceeding 4 inches were noted in parts of the **upper Midwest**. Locally severe thunderstorms accompanying the rain resulted in localized wind and hail damage.

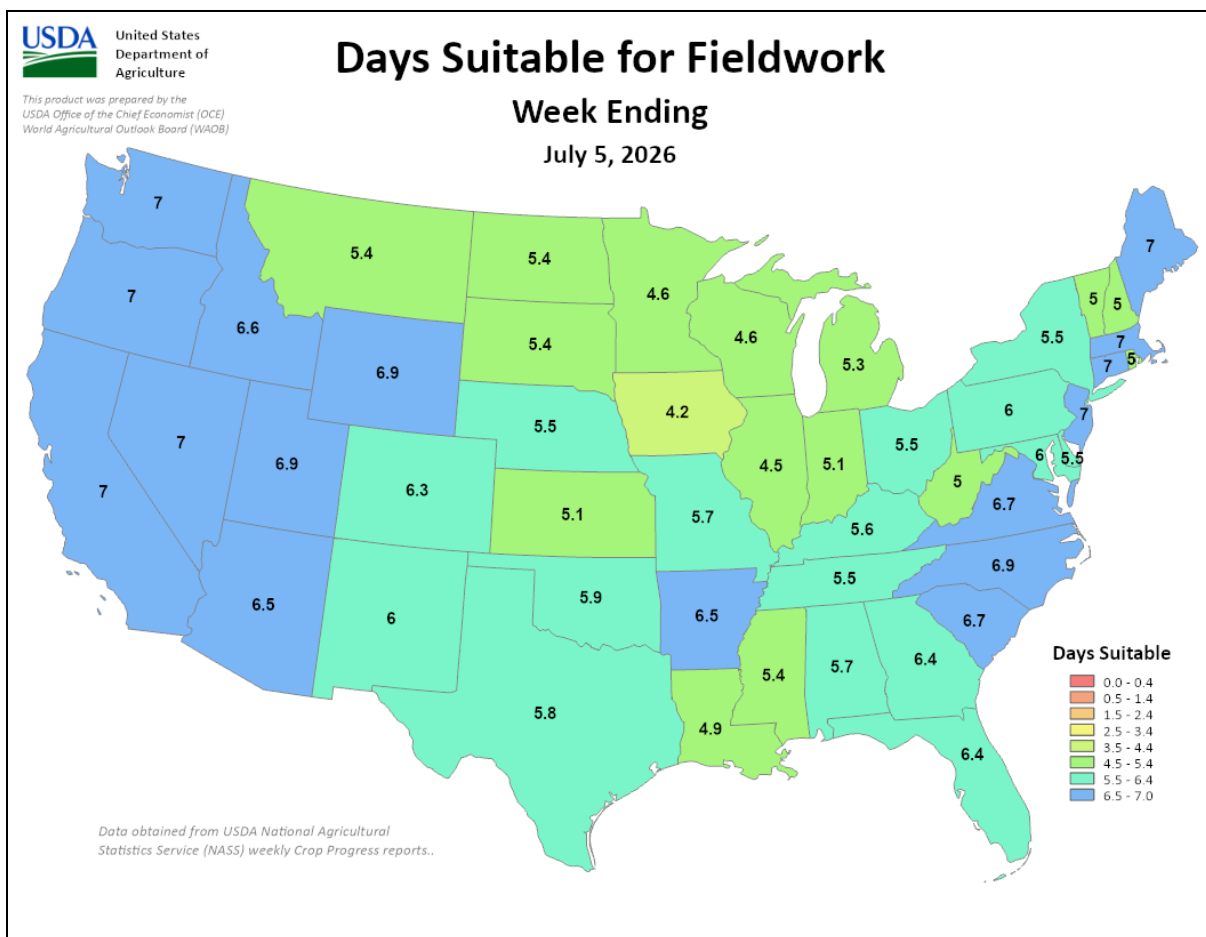
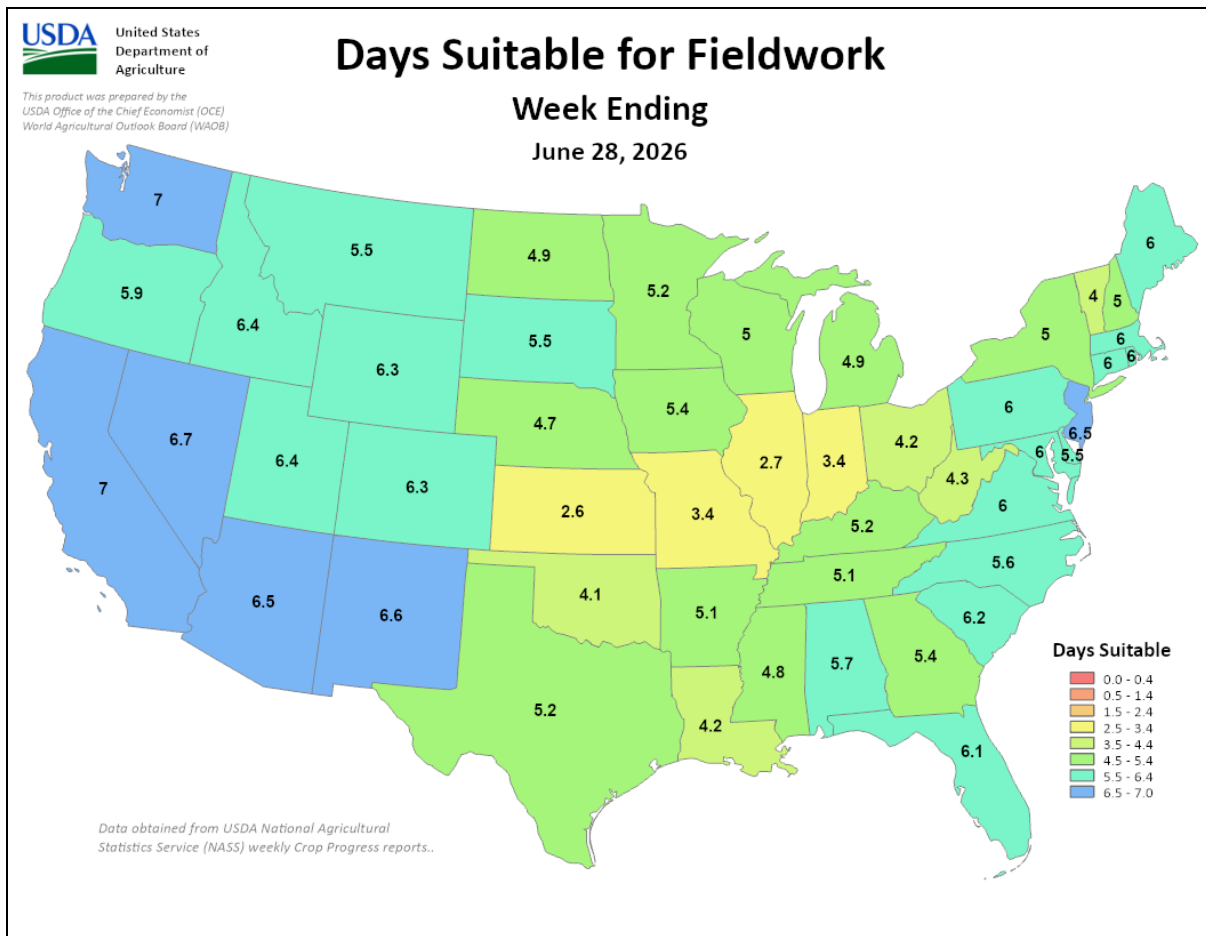


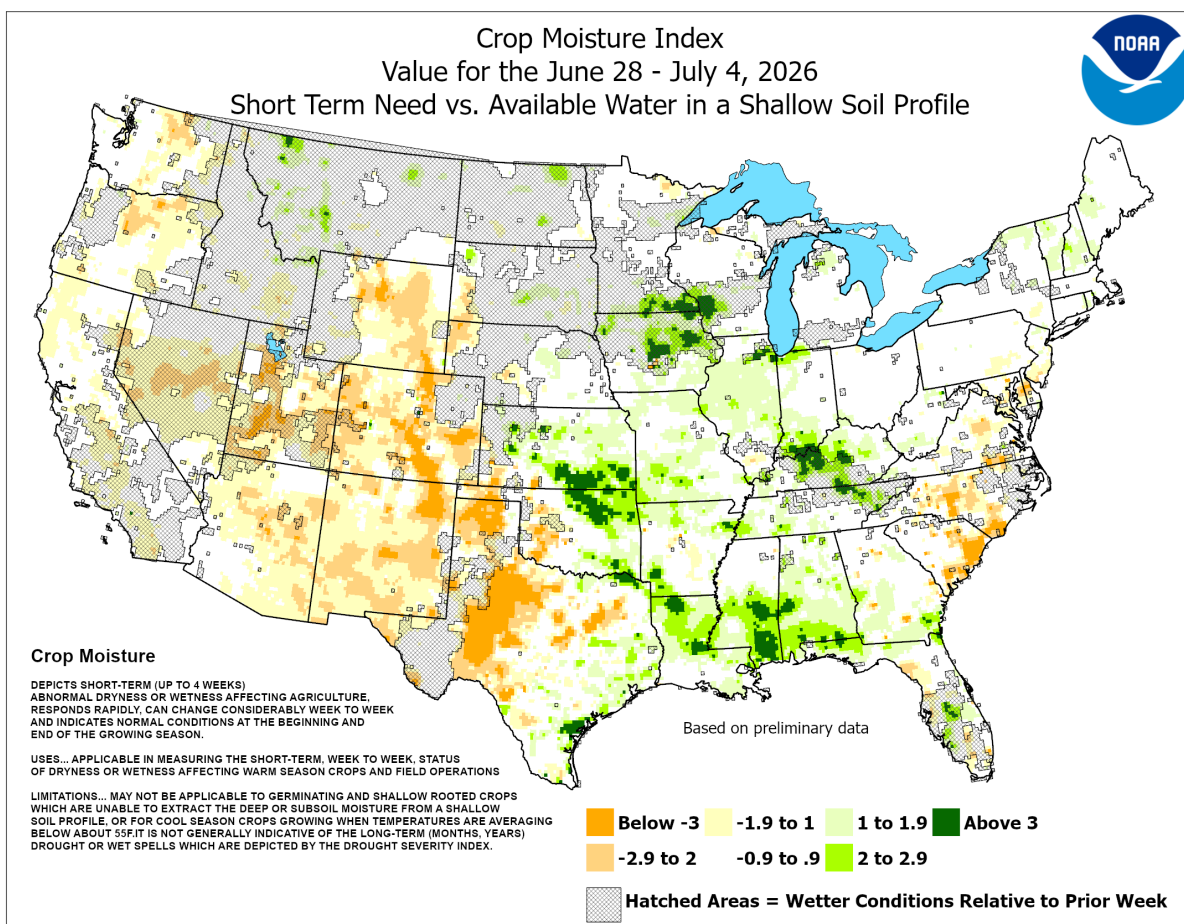
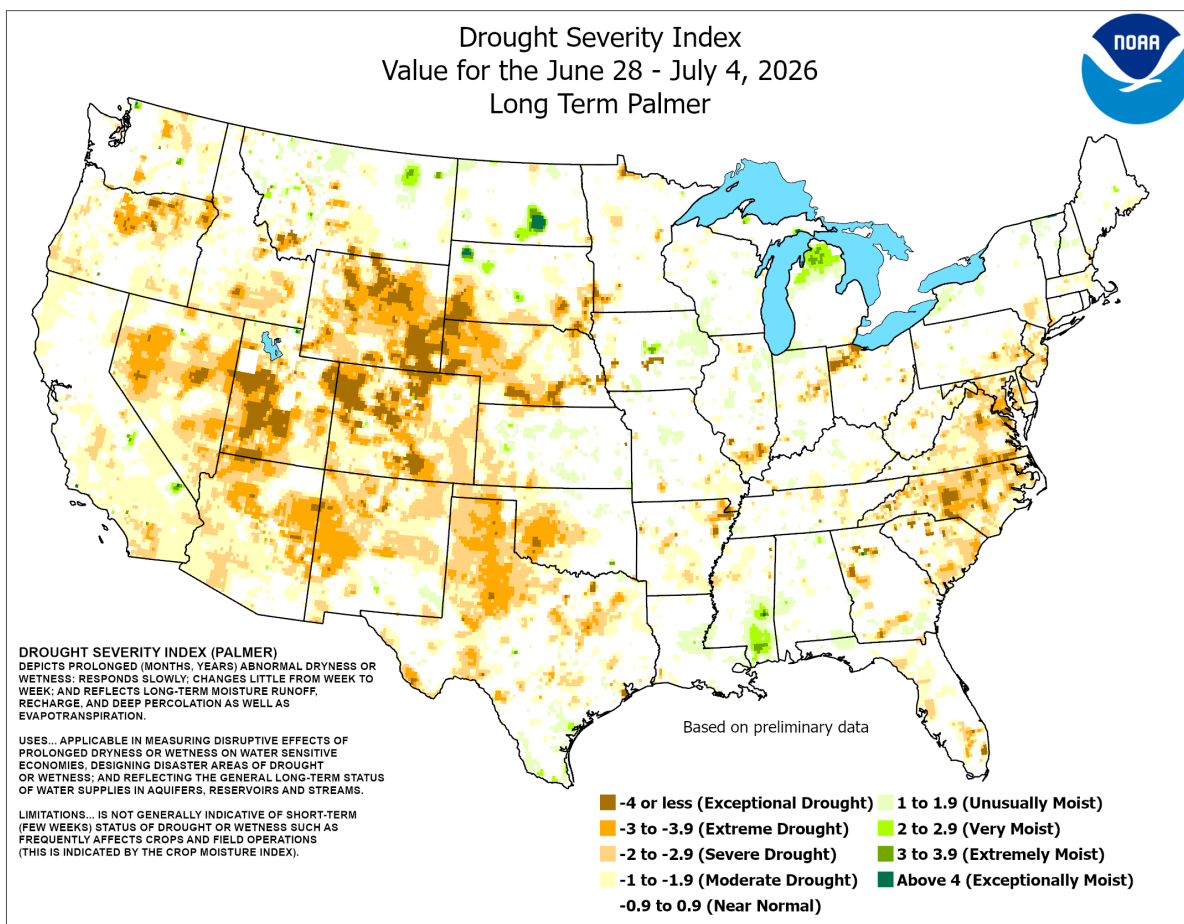
With heat building across the **central and eastern U.S.**, temperatures soared to 100°F or higher as far north as the **central High Plains** and were frequently observed in the **middle Atlantic coastal plain**. The onset of the **mid-Atlantic** heat coincided with days leading up to and continuing through Independence Day weekend, resulting in some of the hottest Fourth of July weather on record. In fact, July 1-3 featured a trio of triple-digit, daily-record highs in **Roanoke, VA**, with readings of 100°F each day. Elsewhere in **Virginia**, **Charlottesville** opened the month with four consecutive daily-record highs (101, 102, 103, and 101°F). Besides **Charlottesville**, the hottest July 4 on record occurred in locations such as **Atlantic City, NJ** (106°F); **Washington, DC** (103°F); **Danville, VA** (103°F); **Raleigh-Durham, NC** (103°F); **Baltimore, MD** (102°F); **Wilmington, DE** (102°F); **Salisbury, MD** (102°F); and **Norfolk, VA** (100°F). **Norfolk's** previous Fourth of July record, 98°F, had been set in 1879. Independence Day records from 1919 were broken in **Danville, Salisbury, and Washington, DC**. If verified, **Atlantic City's** reading of 106°F will tie an all-time station record, originally set on June 28, 1969. For several **mid-Atlantic** sites, July 2 was the hottest day in more than a decade. For example, July 2 readings of 103°F in **Philadelphia, PA**, and 101°F in **Trenton, NJ**, were the stations' highest temperatures since July 23, 2011. **Trenton** attained 101°F again on July 3. With a high of 103°F on July 2, **Reading, PA**, recorded its hottest day since July 7, 2012, when it was also 103°F. Record-setting warmth extended as far north as **Maine**, where **Bangor** (93°F on July 2) achieved its first 90-degree reading of the year. **New York City** (100°F on July 2) notched its first triple-digit reading since July 18, 2012, when it was also 100°F. In contrast, chilly weather prevailed in the **West**. On June 28, daily-record lows dipped to 30°F in **Eureka, NV**; 33°F in **Burns, OR**; and 44°F in **Paso Robles, CA**. **Ely, NV**, registered a daily-record low of 27°F on June 29. In **Wyoming**, **Big Piney** tallied a trio of daily-record lows (28, 26, and 30°F) from June 29 – July 1. Later, **Alamosa, CO**, posted a pair of daily-record lows (34°F both days) on July 3-4.

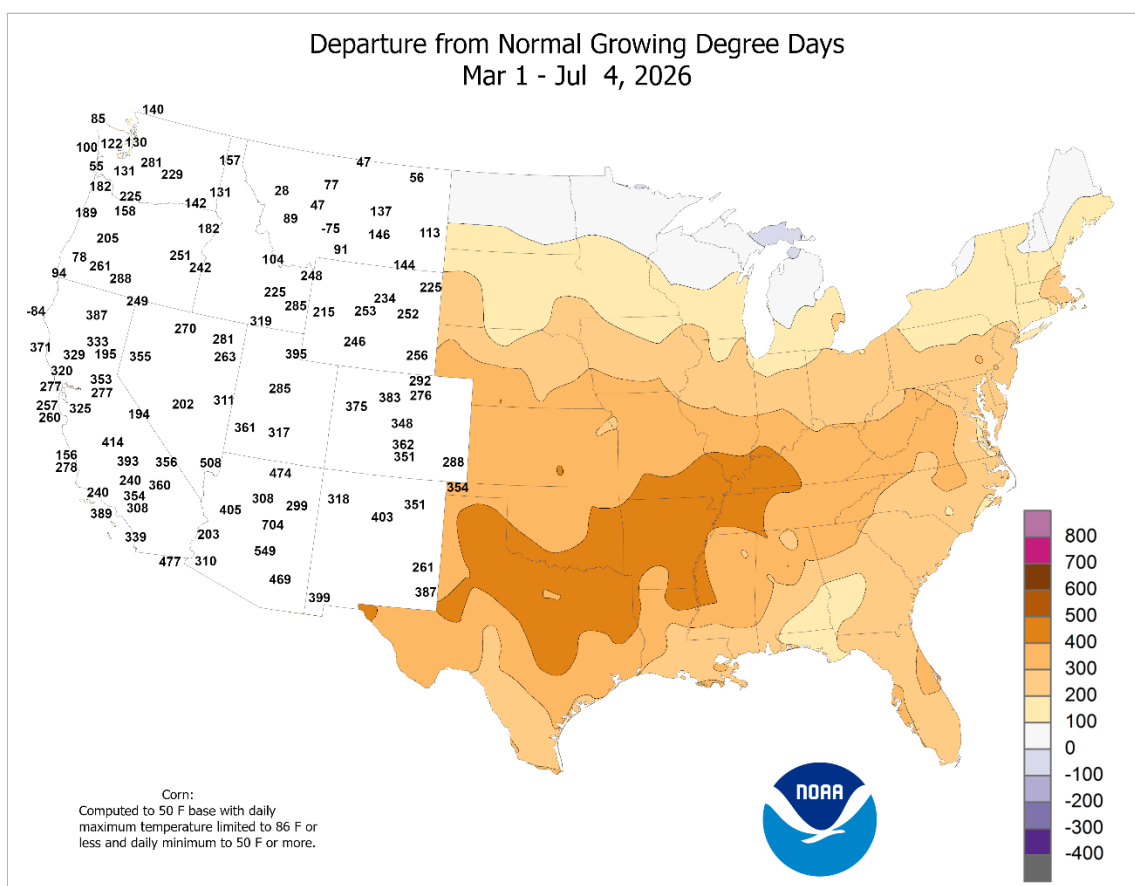
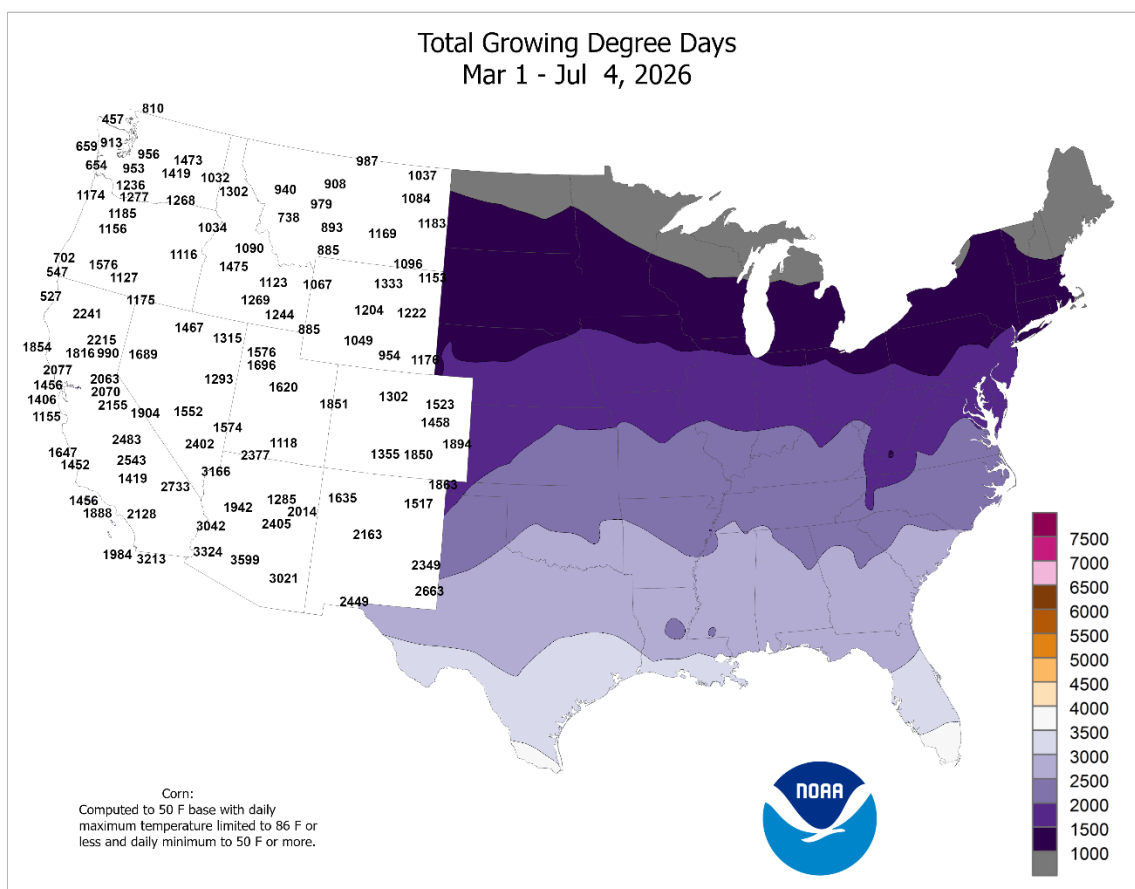
In late June, heavy rain and high-elevation snow pounded the **northern Rockies** and **northern High Plains**. High temperatures on

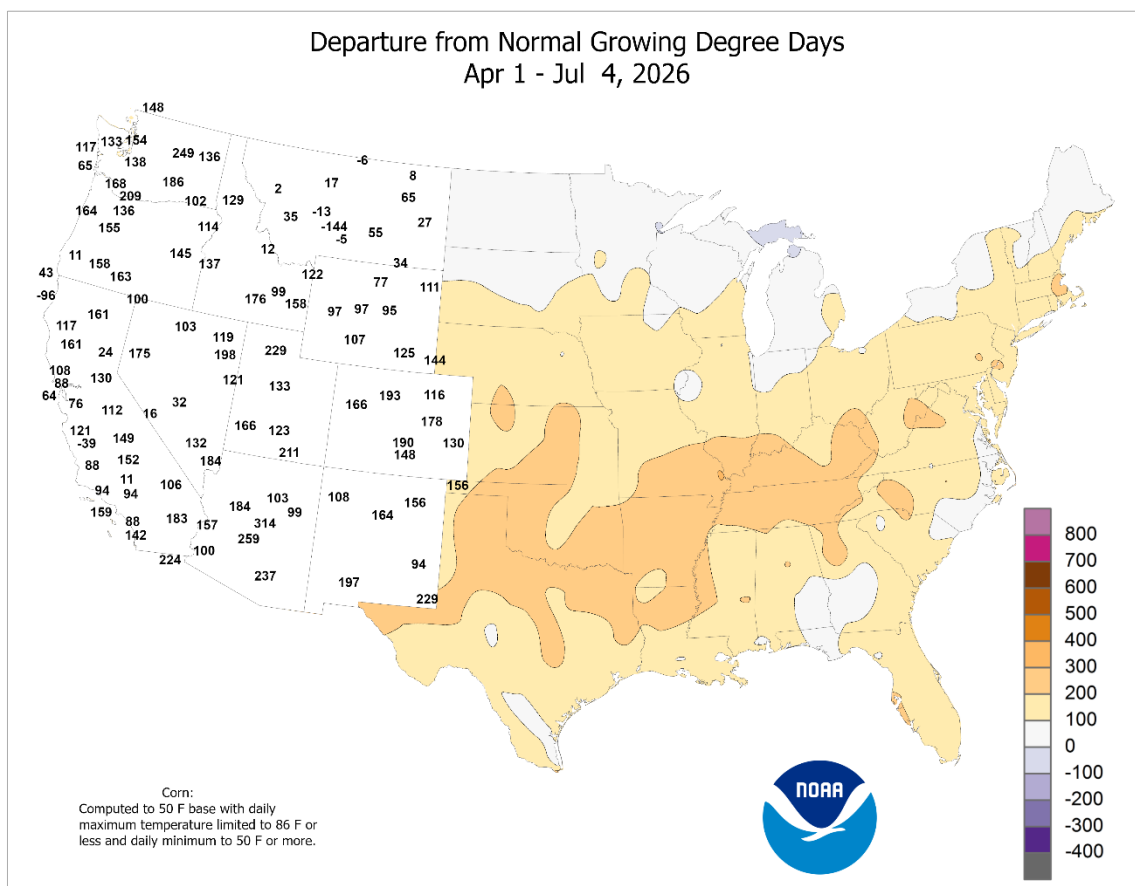
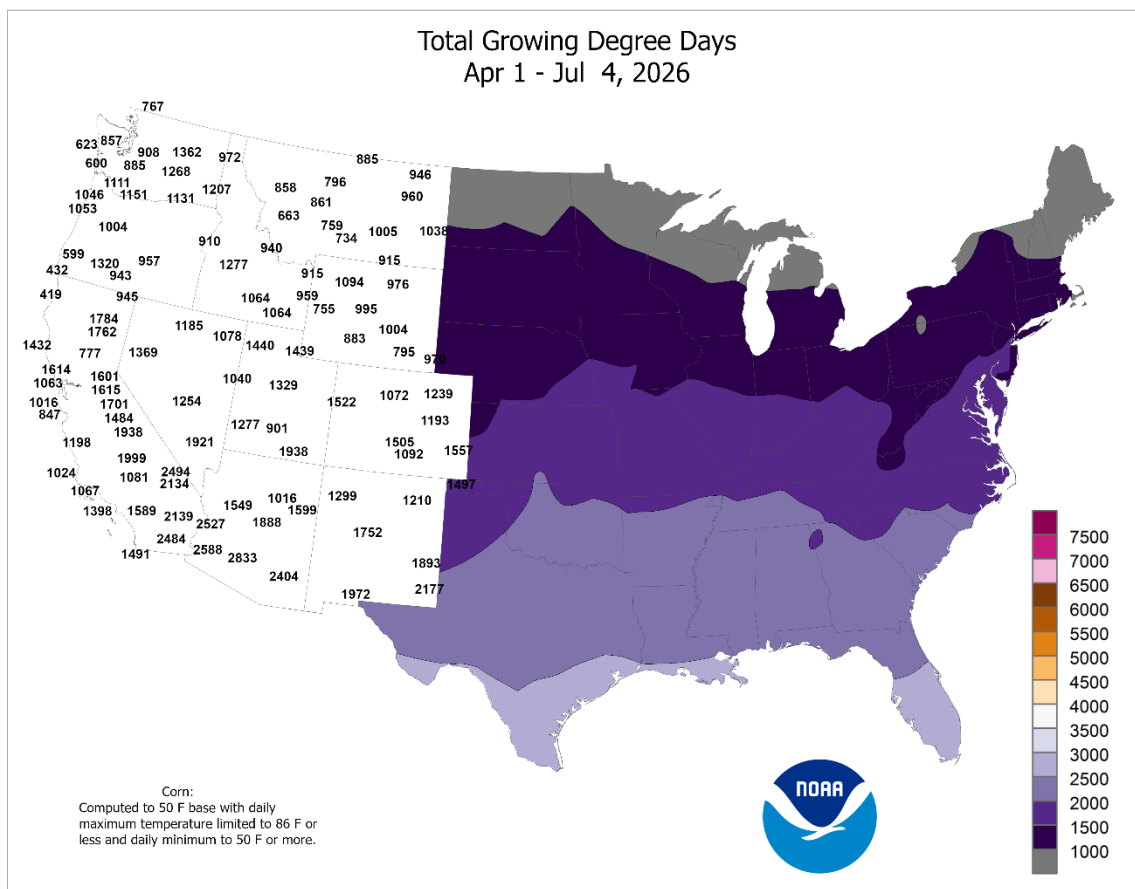
June 28 remained below the 50-degree mark in locations such as **Butte, MT** (46°F), and **Challis, ID** (48°F). In **Montana**, daily-record rainfall totals for June 28 topped an inch in **Great Falls** (1.62 inches), **Cut Bank** (1.54 inches), **Butte** (1.14 inches), and **Townsend** (1.07 inches). Over a 48-hour period in late June, **Montana** totals included 3.13 inches in **Shelby** and 2.87 inches in **Great Falls**. Meanwhile, locally heavy showers and thunderstorms peppered areas **east of the Rockies**. On June 28 in the **eastern U.S.**, daily-record amounts reached 1.99 inches at **Virginia's Dulles Airport** and 1.74 inches in **Lumberton, NC**. In **West Virginia**, **Beckley** observed its wettest June, with the 8.64-inch total edging the 2016 standard of 8.07 inches. July began on a wet note in the **Great Lakes States**; daily-record totals were set on the first day of the month in **Rochester, MN** (1.47 inches), and **Gaylord, MI** (1.28 inches). **Rochester** set another daily record on July 2, with 1.82 inches. With 4.24 inches on July 1-2, **La Crosse, WI**, marked its wettest 2-day period since August 7-8, 2021, when 7.36 inches fell. Late in the week, heavy rain returned across portions of the **northern Plains**, where **Glasgow, MT** (1.89 inches on July 3), observed its wettest day since May 20, 2020, when 1.94 inches fell. It was also **Glasgow's** wettest July day since July 11, 1975, when 2.36 inches fell. Late-week thunderstorms were quite heavy in parts of the **Midwest**, where **Des Moines, IA**, netted 3.26 inches, a record for July 3. Another daily-record, 1.25 inches, was set in **Des Moines** on July 4. Other locations experiencing their wettest Independence Day on record were **Sanford, FL** (3.45 inches); **El Dorado, AR** (3.26 inches); and **Oklahoma City, OK** (1.76 inches).

Cool, showery weather covered much of **Alaska**. During the afternoon of July 3, **Fairbanks** briefly reported pea-sized hail. Selected **Alaskan** daily-record lows included 24°F (on June 28) in **Utqiagvik** and 36°F (on July 4) in **Cold Bay**. Two days later, on the 6th, **Cold Bay** logged its first-ever July freeze with a low of 32°F. Farther south, **Hawaii** completed a mostly wetter-than-normal June, especially in windward locations. At the state's major airport observation sites, June rainfall ranged from 0.32 inch (64 percent of normal) in **Honolulu, Oahu**, to 11.39 inches (156 percent) in **Hilo, on the Big Island**. **Hilo** received rainfall totaling 2.48 inches during the first 4 days of July.

## National Agricultural Summary

June 29 – July 5, 2026

### HIGHLIGHTS

**Weather conditions varied across major U.S. agricultural regions. Above normal temperatures were observed across the Corn Belt, with anomalies ranging from 4 to 8°F above average. The Southeast, Delta, and New England also experienced warmer than normal conditions. In contrast, much of the western U.S. experienced below normal temperatures. Meanwhile, portions**

**of the northern Rockies, northern Great Plains, and upper Mississippi Valley received above normal rainfall, with some localized areas recording more than twice the typical weekly amount. Dry conditions prevailed across much of the Southwest, Delta, and Southeast, contributing to a decline in soil moisture levels across several states.**

**Corn:** Sixteen percent of the nation's corn was silking, 1 percentage point behind last year but 2 percentage points ahead of the 5-year average. Three percent of the corn crop was at the dough stage by week's end, equal to last year but 1 percentage point ahead of the 5-year average. On July 5, sixty-seven percent of the nation's corn crop was rated in good to excellent condition, unchanged from the previous week but 7 percentage points below the same time last year. In Iowa, the largest corn-producing state, 78 percent of the corn crop was rated in good to excellent condition.

**Soybeans:** Thirty-four percent of the 2026 soybean crop was blooming, 4 percentage points ahead of last year and 6 points ahead of the 5-year average. Nine percent of the soybean crop had begun setting pods by week's end, 2 percentage points ahead of last year and 3 points ahead of average. On July 5, sixty-four percent of the nation's soybean crop was rated in good to excellent condition, 1 percentage point below the previous week and 2 points below the same time last year.

**Winter Wheat:** Fifty-nine percent of the nation's winter wheat acreage had been harvested by July 5, eight percentage points ahead of both last year and the 5-year average. On July 5, twenty-six percent of the 2026 winter wheat crop was rated in good to excellent condition, unchanged from the previous week but 22 percentage points below the same time last year. In Kansas, the largest winter wheat-producing state, 55 percent of the winter wheat crop was rated in poor to very poor condition.

**Cotton:** Forty-nine percent of the cotton acreage had reached the squaring stage, 2 percentage points ahead of both last year and the 5-year average. Fourteen percent of the nation's cotton crop was setting bolls by week's end, 1 percentage point ahead of last year but equal to the 5-year average. On July 5, forty-six percent of the cotton crop was rated in good to excellent condition, 2 percentage points below the previous week and 6 points below the same time last year.

**Sorghum:** Ninety-seven percent of the nation's sorghum acreage had been planted by July 5, two percentage points ahead of last year and 1 point behind the 5-year average. By

July 5, twenty-five percent of the sorghum had reached the headed stage, 4 percentage points ahead of last year and 3 points ahead of average. On July 5, fifty percent of the sorghum was rated in good to excellent condition, 2 percentage points below the previous week and 17 points below the same time last year.

**Rice:** Twenty-six percent of the nation's rice crop had reached the headed stage by July 5, two percentage points ahead of last year and 4 points ahead of the 5-year average. On July 5, seventy-four percent of the nation's rice crop was rated in good to excellent condition, unchanged from both the previous week and the same time last year.

**Small Grains:** Eighty-six percent of the nation's oat crop had headed by July 5, three percentage points ahead of last year and 5 points ahead of the 5-year average. On July 5, fifty-three percent of the oat acreage was rated in good to excellent condition, 1 percentage point above the previous week but 7 points below the same time last year.

Sixty percent of the barley crop had reached the headed stage by July 5, nine percentage points ahead of last year and 8 points ahead of the 5-year average. On July 5, fifty-two percent of the nation's barley crop was rated in good to excellent condition, unchanged from the previous week but 10 percentage points above the same time last year.

Fifty-four percent of the spring wheat crop had reached the headed stage by July 5, four percentage points behind last year but equal to the 5-year average. On July 5, fifty-seven percent of the nation's spring wheat crop was rated in good to excellent condition, 2 percentage points below the previous week but 7 points above the same time last year.

**Other Crops:** Fifty-one percent of the nation's peanut crop had reached the pegging stage by July 5, two percentage points behind last year but equal to the 5-year average. On July 5, fifty-nine percent of the nation's peanut crop was rated in good to excellent condition, 3 percentage points below the previous week and 16 points below the same time last year.

## International Weather and Crop Summary

June 28 – July 4, 2026

*International Weather and Crop Highlights and Summaries provided by USDA/WAOB*

### HIGHLIGHTS

**EUROPE:** The recent record-shattering heat over western Europe shifted briefly over central and eastern growing areas before widespread showers signaled the arrival of much cooler air.

**WESTERN FSU:** Hot and mostly dry weather for much of the week was replaced by cooler temperatures and showers late in the period.

**EASTERN FSU:** Widespread, locally heavy showers persisted, with cooler temperatures in western growing areas contrasting with hot weather farther east.

**MIDDLE EAST:** Seasonably sunny skies in Turkey promoted fieldwork and summer crop development.

**AUSTRALIA:** Widespread moderate to heavy rain eased drought in New South Wales and boosted soil moisture for winter crops elsewhere.

**SOUTH ASIA:** The Southwest Monsoon advanced farther northward, bringing beneficial rainfall to central and northern India and improving moisture for cotton, soybeans, and corn.

**EAST ASIA:** Southern China saw widespread showers after Tropical Storm Maysak made landfall on the Vietnam–China border, creating localized flooding and wind related crop risks.

**SOUTHEAST ASIA:** Seasonal monsoon rains brought widespread showers, and Tropical Storm Maysak increased rainfall in northern Vietnam after landfall along the Vietnam–China border.

**MEXICO:** Seasonal showers across the southern plateau corn belt benefited summer crops, while dry weather dominated northwestern and northeastern Mexico.

**CANADIAN PRAIRIES:** Significant rain slowed fieldwork but maintained mostly favorable to locally excessive soil moisture for spring-sown crops.

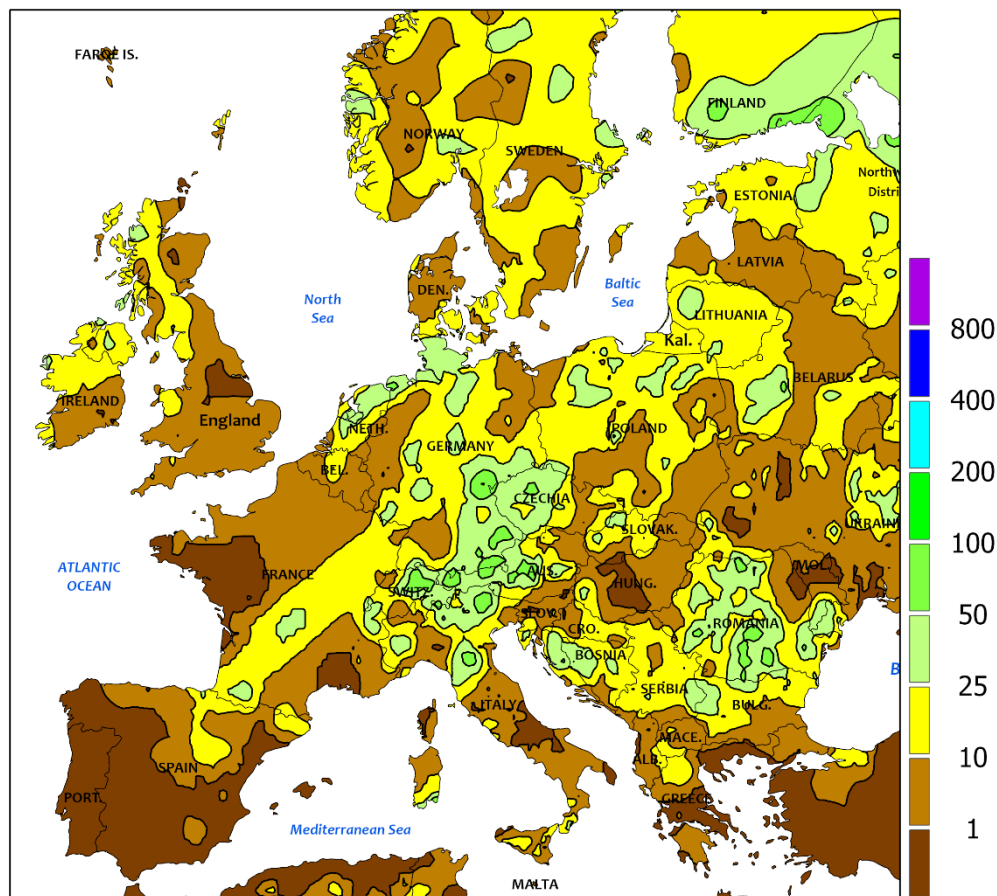
**SOUTHEASTERN CANADA:** Sudden heat promoted winter wheat maturation and summer crop development, while mostly dry weather prevailed in parts of Quebec and in Ontario between Lakes Huron and Erie.

## EUROPE

The recent record-shattering heat wave shifted eastward across the continent before a strong cold front brought much cooler temperatures and locally heavy showers to the eastern half of the continent by week's end. The front initially swept slowly across France at the onset of the monitoring period, ending the preceding week's historic heat while triggering showers and thunderstorms (2-25 mm, locally more) from southeastern France east-northeastward into eastern portions of the country. Behind the front, cooler albeit still above-normal temperatures (2-5°C above normal) prevailed across much of western Europe, though anomalous warmth (up to 7°C above normal, highs in the upper 30s to lower 40s) lingered in southern Spain. Despite the localized showers, conditions for reproductive summer crops across France continued to decline rapidly; the latest satellite-derived Vegetation Health Index (VHI) for France's croplands was the second lowest on record for late June, only slightly behind 2025's record-low benchmark. Extreme heat (35-40°C, locally higher) surged eastward out ahead of the cold front, hastening summer crops

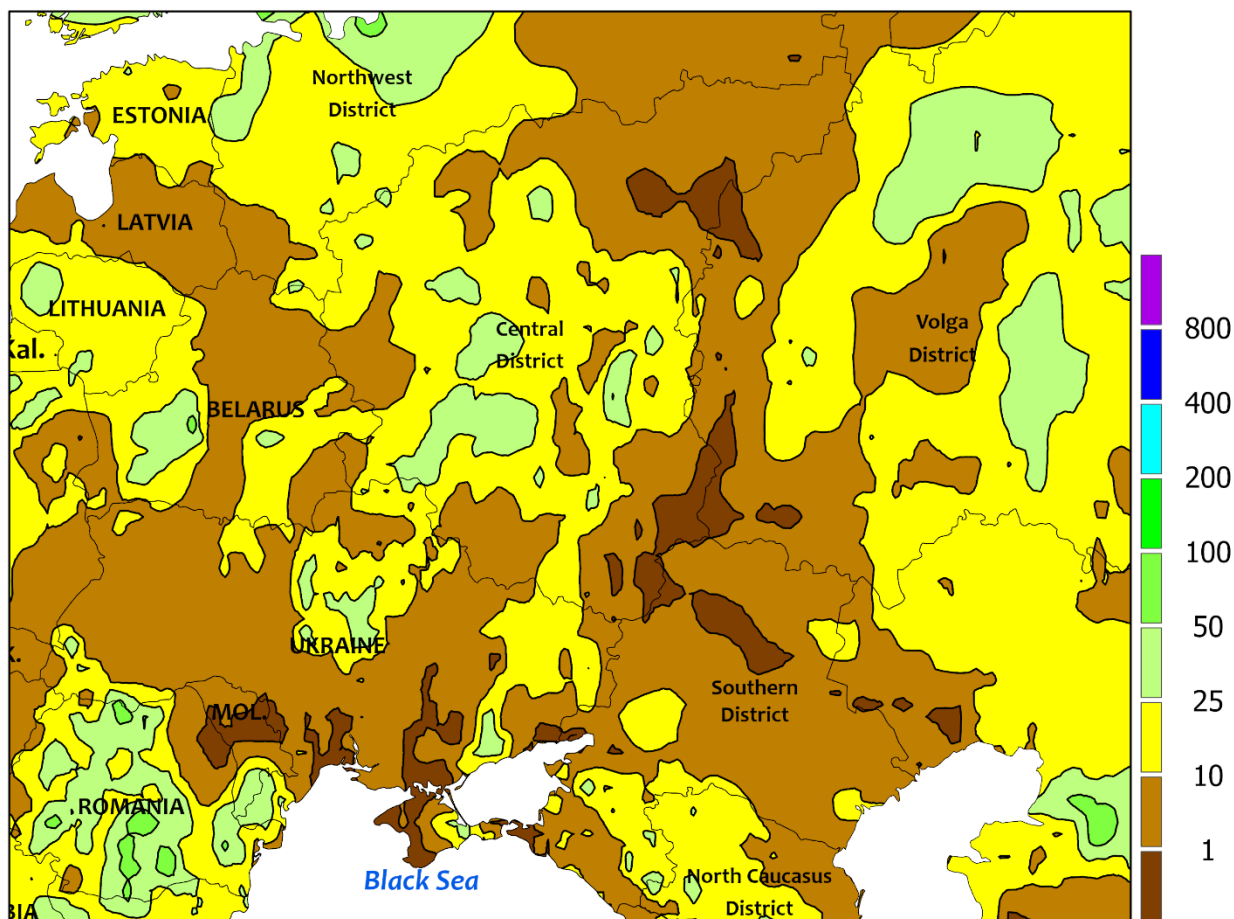
toward or into reproduction over central and eastern Europe. However, widespread albeit highly variable showers and thunderstorms (5-75 mm, locally more) associated with the front brought the heat to an end and improved soil moisture supplies from Germany eastward. Nevertheless, the recent spell of hot and dry weather has driven crop conditions downward, with the latest VHI approaching record lows for this time of year in Austria, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, and Hungary. The rain and heat relief also reached northern Italy's Po River Valley, which had endured 14 consecutive days with highs at or above 35°C (a peak of 39.8°C) since mid-June as corn progressed through reproduction. At week's end, another heat wave was building across Spain and France, with daytime highs reaching the upper 30s and lower 40s (degrees C) on July 5 and 6.

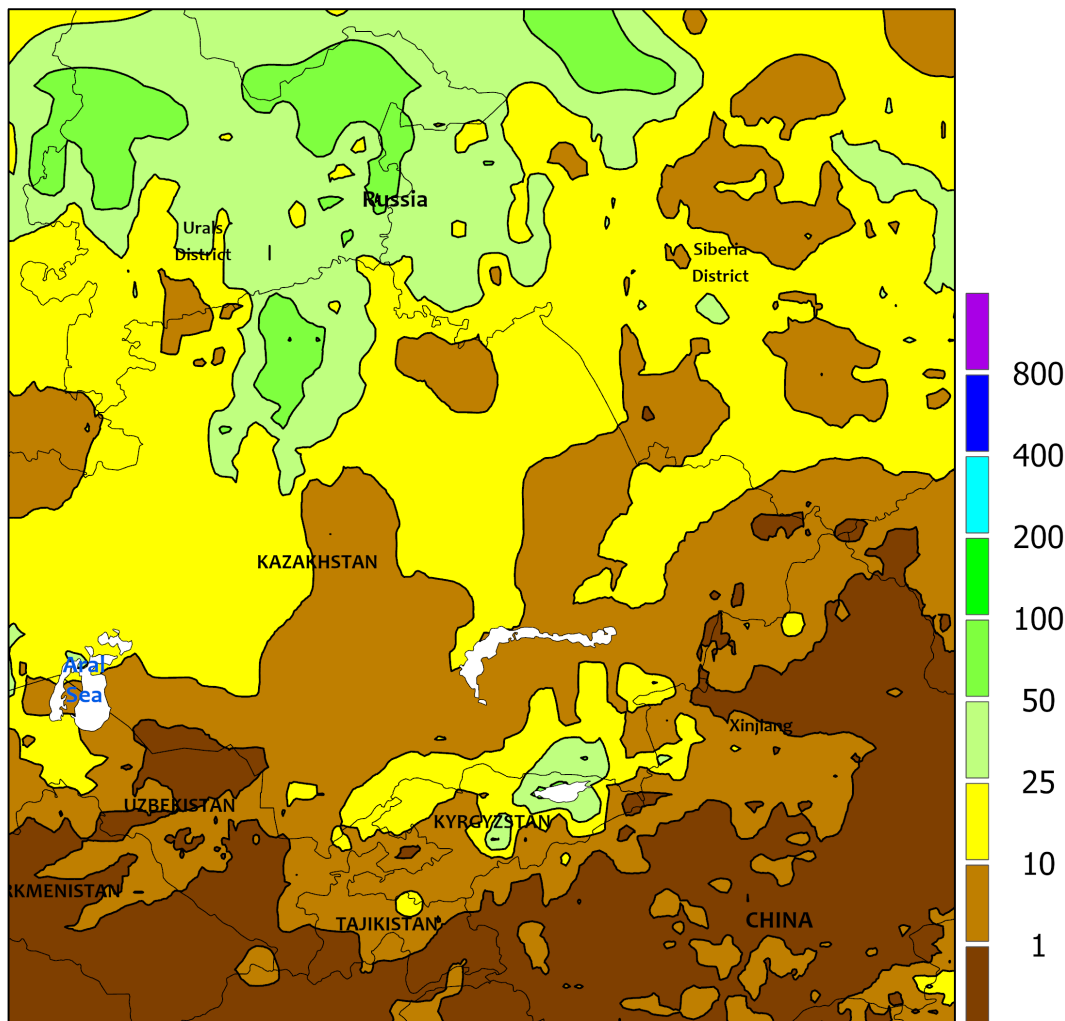


## WESTERN FSU

Hot and dry weather surged eastward across the region before a cold front arrived at the end of the monitoring period. The heat wave, which previously afflicted much of Europe, shifted eastward across Belarus, Ukraine, and Moldova, with daytime highs spiking into the middle and upper 30s (degrees C) from southwestern Belarus southeastward across much of Ukraine into Moldova, reaching west-central Russia later

in the week. However, a strong cold front swept eastward across the region during the latter half of the period, triggering scattered but locally heavy showers and thunderstorms (5-50 mm). Behind the front, sharply cooler air settled over western and central growing areas, eliminating the risk of heat stress as corn, sunflowers, and soybeans progress through the temperature-sensitive reproductive stages of development.

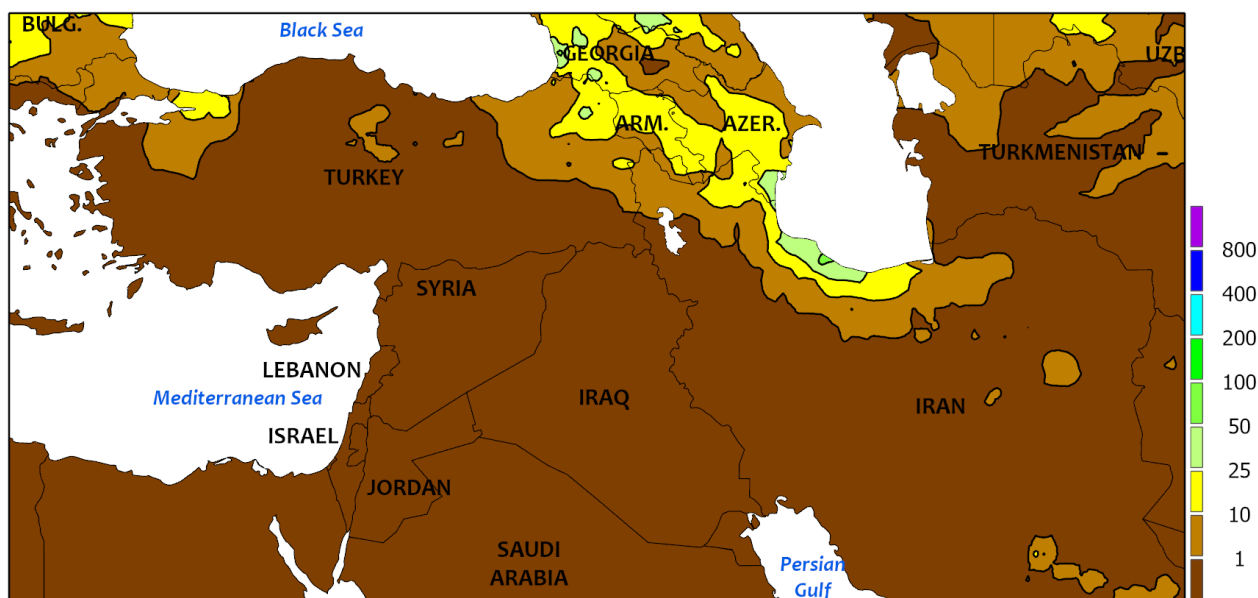


**EASTERN FSU**

Widespread showers continued across much of the region, with cool conditions in western croplands contrasting sharply with anomalous heat farther east. Unusually wet weather continued across the western and central spring grain belt of northern Kazakhstan and central Russia, with weekly rainfall totaling 15 to 120 mm. Showers were lighter and more hit and miss (5-45 mm) from northeastern Kazakhstan into Russia's Siberia District, helping to offset the elevated moisture demands and crop stress brought on by anomalous warmth (3-6°C above normal), with highs reaching 38°C along the eastern Kazakhstan-Russia border. As a result, spring grains and summer crops were rapidly approaching or entering reproduction more than a week ahead of average. Conversely, cooler-than-

normal conditions (up to 4°C below normal) slowed wheat and barley development in northwestern Kazakhstan and the southwestern Urals District. Farther south across the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS), another round of unusually heavy and widespread late-season rain (10-55 mm, locally more) from central Uzbekistan eastward maintained abundant supplemental soil moisture for irrigated summer crops, including flowering cotton and silking to blistering corn. Unusually heavy showers (10-30 mm) also developed over western Uzbekistan, accompanied by significantly below-normal temperatures (5-8°C below normal). Conversely, temperatures averaged 2 to 4°C above normal in eastern cotton areas.

MIDDLE EAST

Sunny skies across the region favored fieldwork and summer crop development. In Turkey, winter wheat was filling to maturing in excellent condition due to abundant rainfall during the spring and early summer as well as a lack of extreme heat. Meanwhile, Turkey's summer crops were mostly entering or progressing through reproduction, though corn and sunflowers on the cooler Anatolian Plateau were still vegetative. Seasonably dry weather prevailed from the eastern Mediterranean

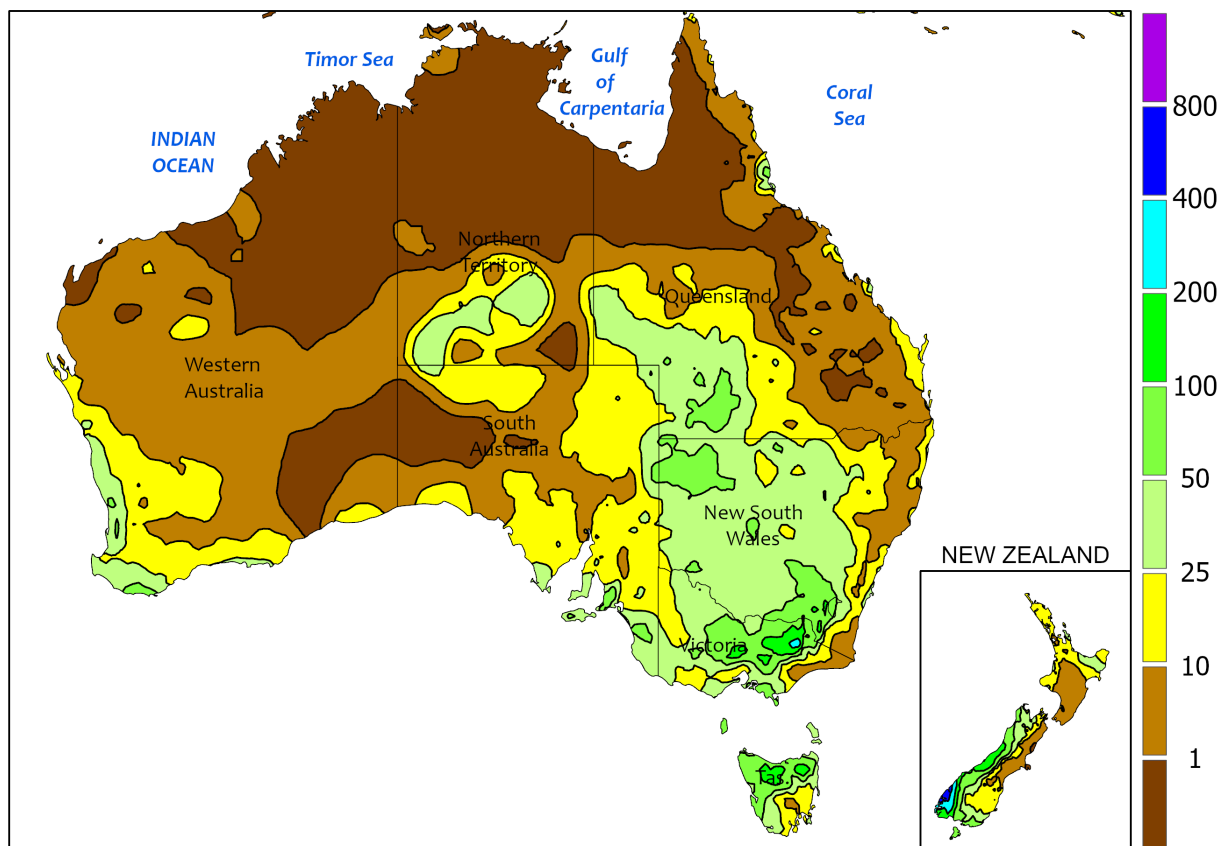
Coast into Iraq\* and Iran, facilitating a rapid pace of winter grain harvesting. Temperatures averaged within 1 to 2°C of normal across much of the region save for abnormal warmth (up to 3°C above normal, daytime highs in the upper 30s degrees C) in northwestern Turkey.

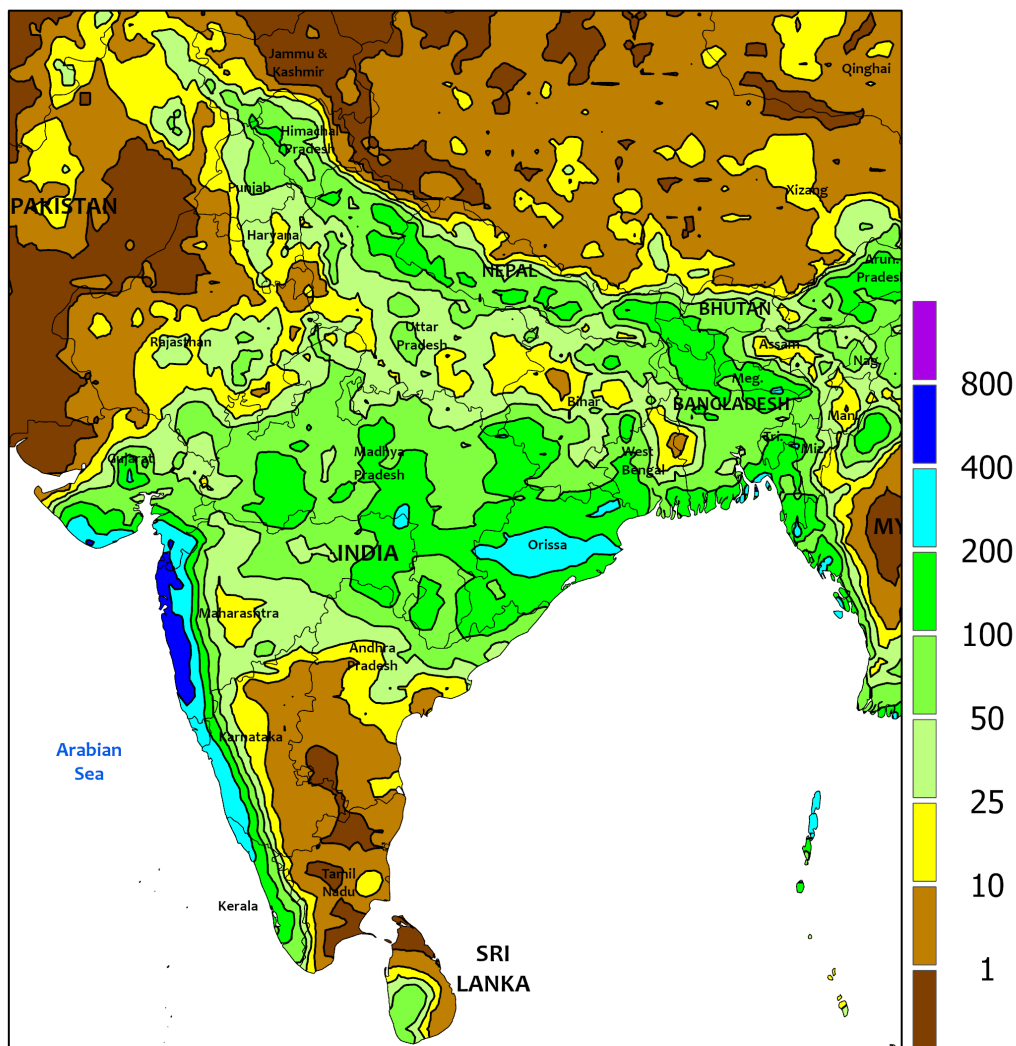


## AUSTRALIA

A pair of slow-moving cold fronts brought widespread rain to much of the country. In Western Australia, light to moderate showers (10-30 mm) maintained favorable soil moisture for vegetative winter wheat, barley, and rapeseed. Moderate to heavy showers (10-40 mm) kept soils favorably moist for winter crops in South Australia, with very heavy rain (50-120 mm) falling east of Adelaide. Farther east, widespread soaking rainfall (20-65 mm) boosted

soil moisture in western Victoria and eased long-term drought in New South Wales. As of July 2, water storage levels in New South Wales stood at 50.8 percent of normal, up from 48.1 percent last month but still down nearly 6 percentage points from this time last year (56.6 percent). Showers tapered off to the north, from 50 mm south of the border with Queensland to less than 10 mm in southeastern Queensland's primary winter crop areas.

### SOUTH ASIA

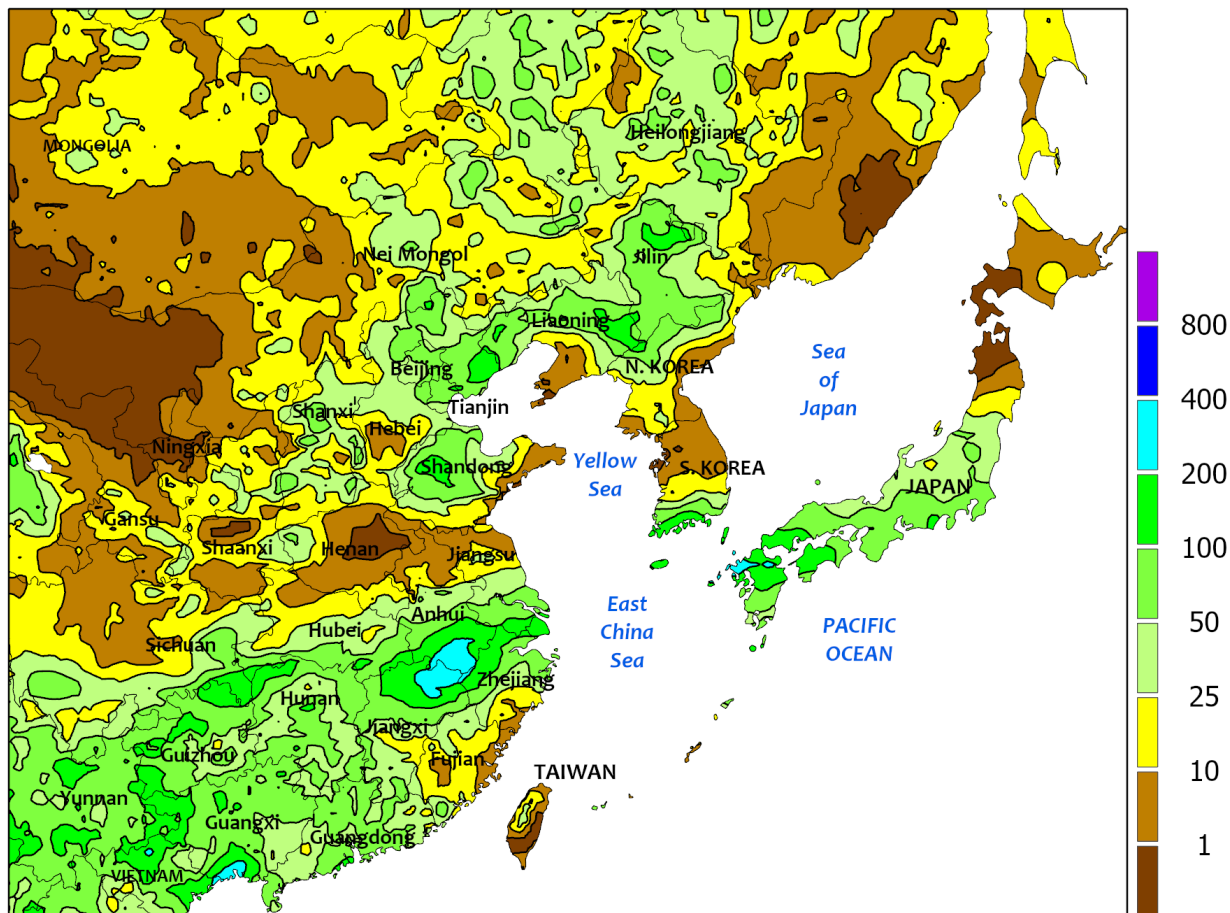
The Southwest Monsoon advanced farther northward and covered nearly all of India, delivering widespread rainfall across central and northern states. Weekly totals generally ranged from 25 to 200 mm, though amounts remained more uneven in the northwest and southeast. Rainfall ranged from 100 to 250 mm toward the eastern coast in Orissa, whereas strong southwesterly monsoon winds produced torrential downpours of up to 800 mm along the western coastline. After several weeks of intense heat and inconsistent rainfall, this moisture was broadly beneficial for the kharif season,

supporting continued planting of cotton, soybeans, and corn in central and northern India. Improved soil moisture conditions also helped early sown crops establish more reliably. Temperatures moderated where rain occurred; however, parts of northwest India and Pakistan remained much hotter than normal—up to 3°C above average—with daytime highs in the lower to middle 40s (degrees C), maintaining heat stress and slowing planting progress where monsoon rains had not yet arrived. Elsewhere across the region, temperatures generally ranged from the lower to upper 30s.

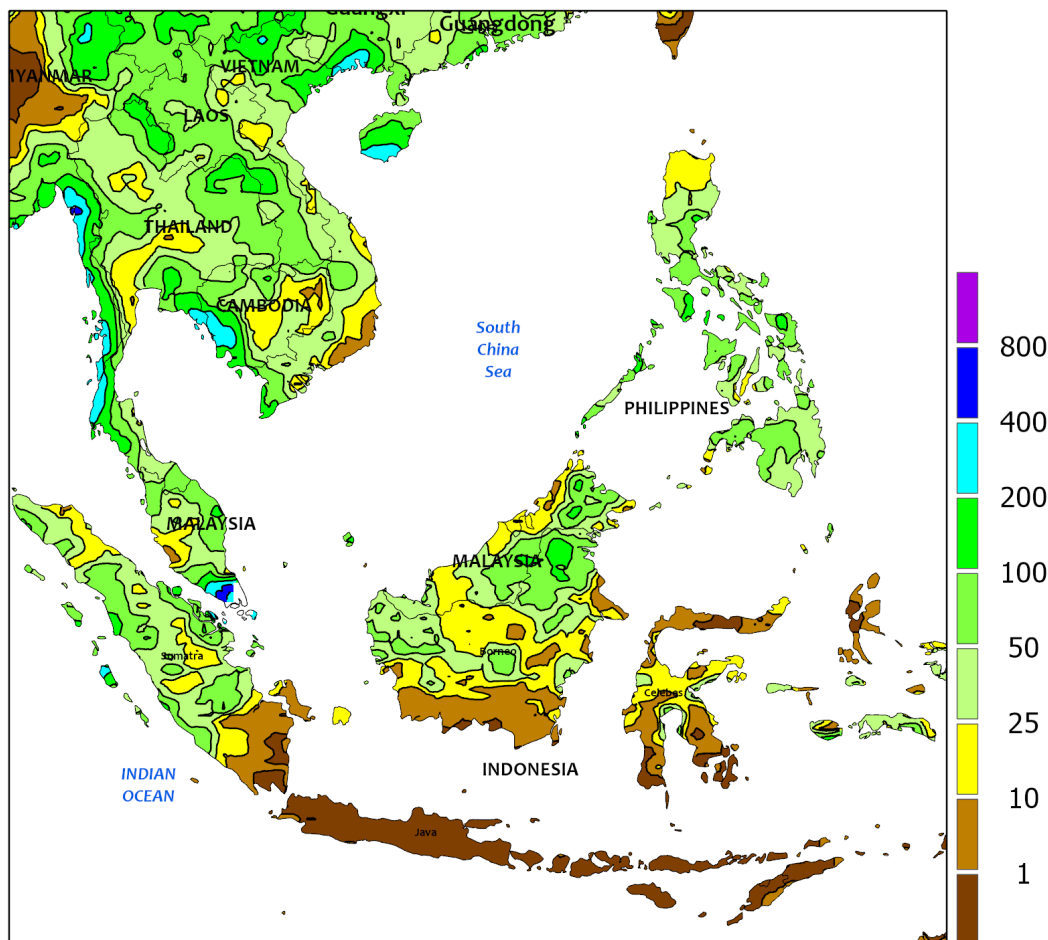


## EASTERN ASIA

Widespread showers continued across eastern Asia, though some areas received less than 25 mm. Southern China saw the heaviest rainfall as Tropical Storm Maysak made landfall on Hainan Island, moved across the Gulf of Tonkin, and then came ashore again along the Vietnam-China border between Hanoi province and Guangxi province, with coastal totals exceeding 300 mm and most other southern areas receiving 25 to 200 mm. These rains generally supported early-season rice establishment and maintained moisture for corn, though localized flooding may have disrupted low lying paddies.

Farther north, rainfall across northern China and the Korean Peninsula ranged from 10 to 100 mm, with some dry pockets under 10 mm, resulting in mixed conditions for corn and soybeans entering key vegetative stages. Japan again experienced heavy to extreme rainfall, especially in central and southern regions where 25 to 200 mm fell (isolated totals approaching 300 mm), benefiting rice paddies but heightening waterlogging and lodging risks. Temperatures mostly ranged from the lower to upper 30s (degrees C), promoting rapid crop development where moisture was sufficient.

**SOUTHEAST ASIA**

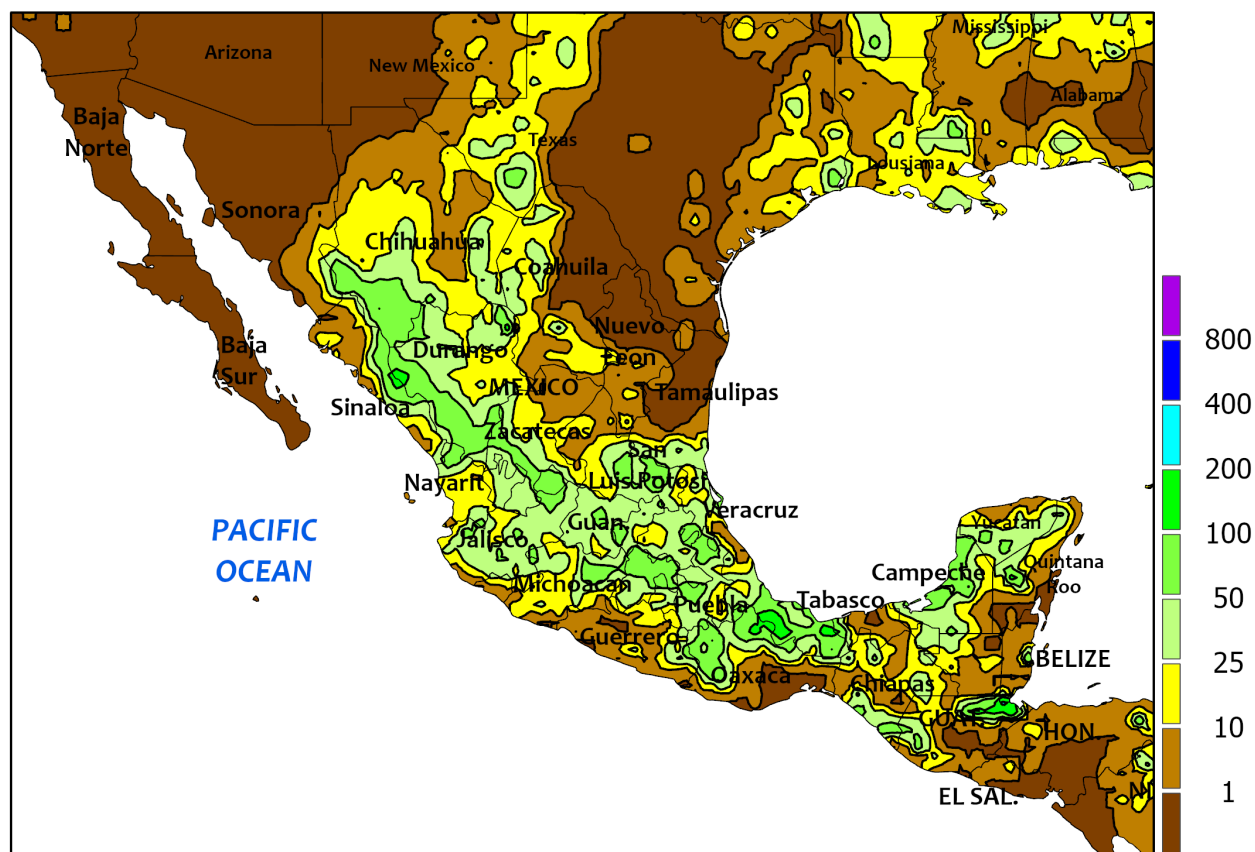
Southwest Monsoon activity continued across much of the region, producing widespread rainfall and supporting seasonal crop development. Thailand received 25 to over 200 mm of rain as a shifting monsoon trough and strong southwesterly monsoon winds brought frequent showers, with 200 to 400 mm along the western coast. A low pressure system west of the central Philippines strengthened into Tropical Storm Maysak, making landfall on Hainan Island before crossing the Gulf of Tonkin and striking the Vietnam–China border.

Although the storm's core tracked north of major crop belts, its outer rainbands delivered locally heavy rainfall (25–200 mm) across northern Vietnam and parts of Laos, while areas near the landfall zone in Vietnam received much higher totals (up to 350 mm). Elsewhere, most of mainland Southeast Asia received 25 to 150 mm, while parts of Indonesia and Malaysia saw lighter totals under 25 mm. These patterns generally favored rice and maize growth. Daytime highs ranged from the lower to upper 30s (degrees C).

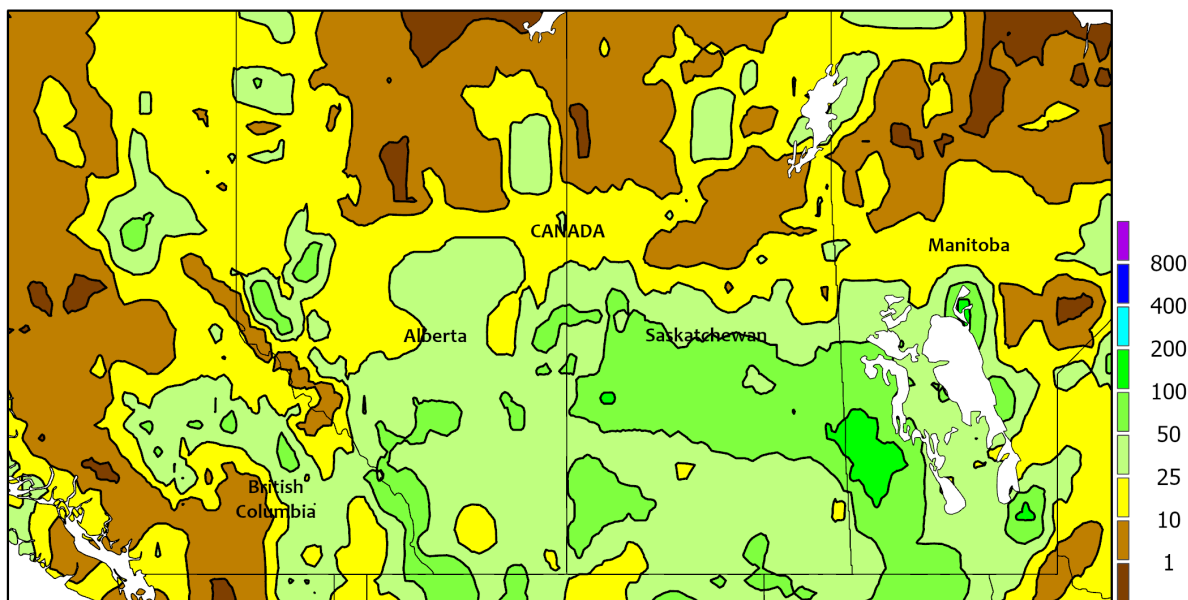
Light to moderately heavy showers (10-50 mm or more) across the southern plateau maintained mostly favorable moisture reserves for corn and other summer crops. The showers helped to suppress temperatures, which averaged near normal. Meanwhile, monsoon-related shower activity began to surge into northwestern Mexico but stalled, largely failing to reach into Sonora and

northern Chihuahua. Just to the south, however, isolated weekly totals of 50 to 100 mm or greater were observed in the western Sierra Madre, extending into southern Chihuahua. Elsewhere, dry weather covered northeastern Mexico, where temperatures averaged 1 to 2°C above normal, while locally heavy showers dotted the Gulf Coast States from Veracruz to Yucatán.

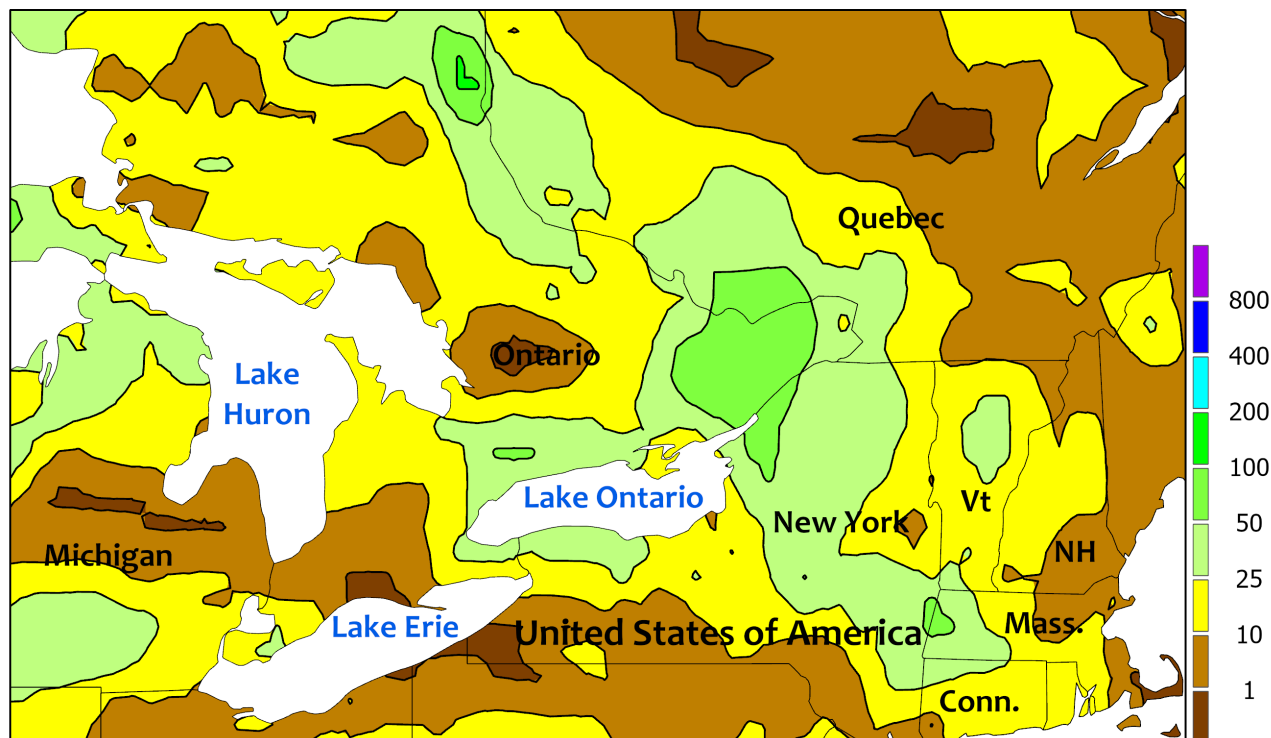
For the second week in a row, significant rain (25-100 mm) fell on the Prairies, leading to increasing instances of surplus soil moisture. In fact, rain during the week ending July 4 was more widespread than the previous week, affecting nearly all Prairie crop production areas. Despite the rain, Prairie weekly temperatures averaged near normal. According to provincial reports, cropland topsoil moisture in Saskatchewan at the end of June was reported to be 63 percent adequate and 36 percent surplus,

with additional rain falling in early July. Significant lowland flooding was observed in portions of Manitoba's Interlake region. Meanwhile in Alberta, rain limited fieldwork but left all crops rated 68 percent good to excellent on June 30, above the 5-year average of 65 percent. Although periods of warmth and sunshine will be needed across the Prairies in coming weeks, only scattered areas—mainly in Saskatchewan and Manitoba—have become wet enough that dry weather is desperately needed.

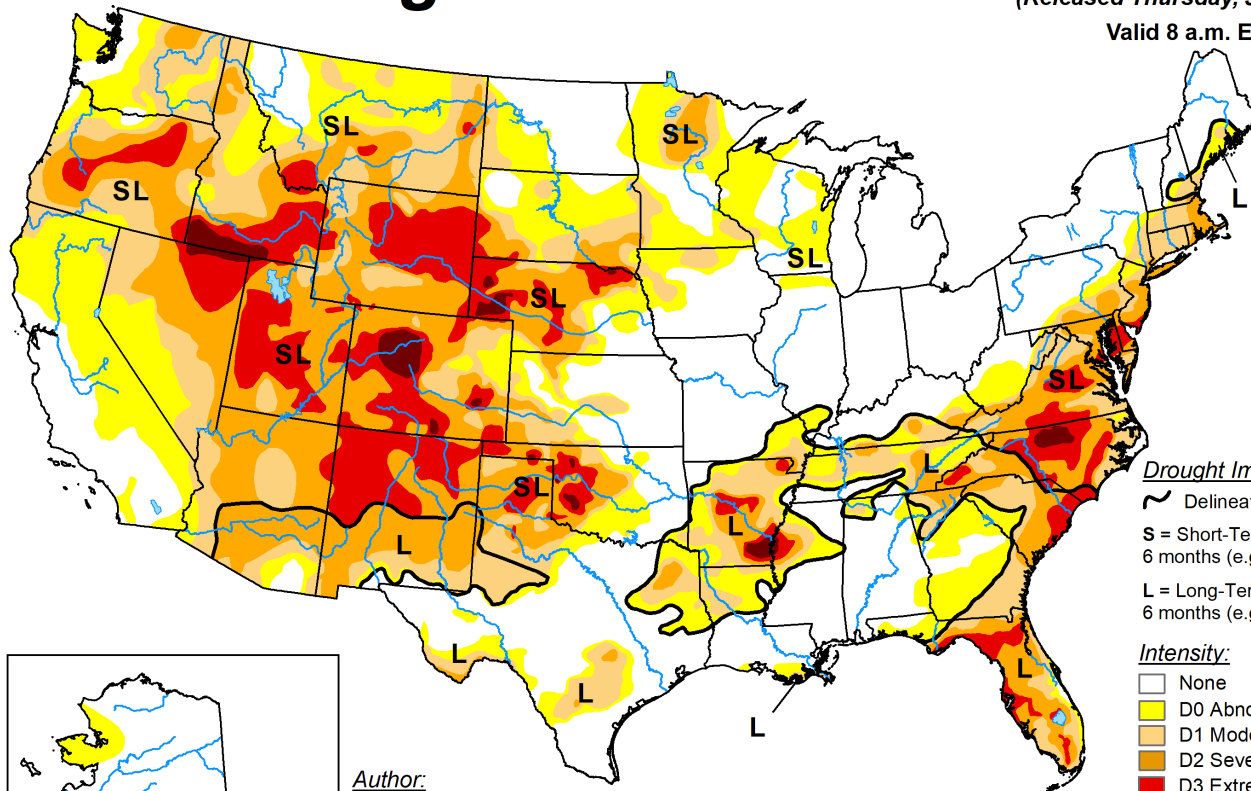
Sudden heat pushed temperatures 3 to 6°C above normal, with maximum readings ranging from 30 to 35°C. Most areas retained adequate soil moisture to withstand the hot weather, especially where weekly rainfall totaled 10 to 50 mm or more. Some of the highest totals,

greater than 50 mm, occurred along and near the Ontario-Quebec border. In southwestern Ontario, however, mostly dry weather supported the early stages of winter wheat harvesting. Mostly dry weather also prevailed in Quebec's eastern farming areas.
