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Annual production, disposition, cash receipts and gross income estimates for chickens, eggs and broilers are changed to a December 1 through November 30 marketing year beginning with the 1970 estimates in this report. Estimates for 1969 and earlier years, as previously published, will remain on a calendar year basis. The change to a marketing year beginning December 1 was necessitated by the shift of annual inventory estimates from January 1 to December 1 announced in October 1971.

CHICKENS, EGGS, AND BROILERS

Production, Disposition, Cash Receipts and Gross Income by States, 1970-71

Gross income from the production of eggs, chickens and broilers in the marketing year ending December 1, 1971 totaled \$3,459 million compared with \$3,865 million in 1970, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the 1971 gross income, 54 percent was from eggs, 43 percent from broilers, and 3 percent from other chickens. In 1970 the percentages were 59 percent for eggs, 38 percent for broilers, and 3 percent for other chickens. Cash receipts from eggs, broilers and chickens marketed during the year ending December 1, 1971 were \$3,428 million, accounting for 99 percent of gross income; the remaining 1 percent represented the value of poultry products consumed on farms where produced. Gross income from turkeys in 1971 totaled \$501 million, bringing the combined income from eggs, broilers, chickens, and turkeys to \$3,960 million compared with \$4,362 million in 1970.

EGG PRODUCTION UP: The 1971 production of 71,644 million eggs was up 2 percent from the 70,023 million produced in 1970. Layer numbers during the year averaged 321.8 million, compared with the 1970 average of 321.3 million. The average rate of lay per layer was 223 eggs in 1971 compared with 218 eggs in 1970. Eggs sold totaled 70,646 million, 2 percent above 1970. Gross income from eggs was \$1,875 million, down 18 percent from the 1970 total of \$2,280 million, as sharply lower egg prices in 1971 more than offset the increase in the number of eggs sold.

FEWER CHICKENS RAISED: Chickens raised in 1971 (excluding broilers) totaled 318 million, 3 percent fewer than in 1970. Chicken production (home consumption plus sales adjusted for change in inventory) was 258 million birds weighing 1,221 million pounds liveweight, compared with 264 million birds and 1,185 million pounds liveweight in 1970. Cash receipts in 1971 were \$90 million compared with \$103 million a year earlier. Gross income was \$96 million, down from the 1970 total of \$109 million.

BROILER PRODUCTION DOWN: Production of broilers in 1971 totaled 2,947 million birds, down 1 percent from 1970. Gross income at \$1,488 million was up 1 percent from the 1970 total of \$1,475 million.

EGG PRICES DOWN, BROILERS UP: Eggs averaged 31.4 cents per dozen in 1971 compared with 39.1 in 1970. Chickens (excluding broilers) sold in 1971 averaged 7.7 cents per pound liveweight, down from the 1970 average of 9.1 cents. Broilers in 1971 averaged 13.7 cents per pound, up slightly from the year earlier average of 13.6 cents.

FARM CONSUMPTION OF EGGS AND CHICKENS: The number of chickens consumed on farms where produced totaled 19.3 million, 7 percent less than in 1970, while egg consumption of 998 million was down 6 percent from the 1,062 million eggs consumed in 1970.

DEATH LOSS: Death loss of chickens on hand December 1, 1970 was 13.7 percent compared with 14.5 percent a year earlier.

CHICKENS AND BROILERS COMBINED: Sales of chickens and broilers in 1971 totaled 11,992 million pounds compared with 11,949 million pounds in 1970. The total value of sales was \$1,578 million, about the same as in 1970. The value of broiler sales amounted to 94 percent of the total compared with 93 percent in 1970. The price per pound liveweight for broilers and chickens combined, averaged 13.2 cents in 1971, the same as in 1970.
