CHICKENS, EGGS, AND BROILERS

Production, Disposition, Cash Receipts and Gross Income, 1970-72 By States

Gross income from the production of eggs, chickens and broilers in the marketing year ending December 1, 1972 totaled \$3,531 million compared with \$3,416 million in 1971, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the 1972 gross income, 51 percent was from eggs, 46 percent from broilers, and 3 percent from other chickens. In 1971 the percentages were 54 percent for eggs, 43 percent for broilers, and 3 percent for other chickens. Cash receipts from eggs, broilers and chickens marketed during the year ending December 1, 1972 were \$3,509 million, accounting for 99 percent of gross income; the remaining 1 percent represented the value of poultry products consumed on farms where produced. Gross income from turkeys in 1972 totaled \$537 million, bringing the combined income from eggs, broilers, chickens, and turkeys to \$4,068 million compared with \$3,918 million in 1971.

EGG PRODUCTION DOWN SLIGHTLY: The 1972 production of 69,804 million eggs was down slightly from the 70,082 million produced in 1971. Layer numbers during the year averaged 307.1 million, compared with the 1971 average of 314.8 million. The average rate of lay per layer was 227 eggs in 1972 compared with 223 eggs in 1971. Eggs sold totaled 69,121 million, slightly below 1971. Gross income from eggs was \$1,798 million, down 2 percent from the 1971 total of \$1,833 million.

FEWER CHICKENS RAISED: Chickens raised in 1972 (excluding broilers) totaled 291 million, 8 percent fewer than in 1971. Chicken production (home consumption plus sales adjusted for change in inventory) was 233 million birds weighing 1,119 million pounds liveweight, compared with 258 million birds and 1,204 million pounds liveweight in 1971. Cash receipts in 1972 were \$106 million compared with \$91 million a year earlier. Gross income was \$111 million, up from the 1971 total of \$96 million.

BROILER PRODUCTION UP: Production of broilers in 1972 totaled 3,075 million birds, up 4 percent from 1971. Gross income at \$1,622 million was up 9 percent from the 1971 total of \$1,487 million.

EGG PRICES DOWN, BROILERS UP: Eggs averaged 30.9 cents per dozen in 1972 compared with 31.4 in 1971. Chickens (excluding broilers) sold in 1972 averaged 9.3 cents per pound liveweight, up from the 1971 average of 7.7 cents. Broilers in 1972 averaged 14.1 cents per pound, up from the year earlier average of 13.7 cents.

FARM CONSUMPTION OF EGGS AND CHICKENS: The number of chickens consumed on farms where produced totaled 16.4 million, 8 percent less than in 1971, while egg consumption of 682 million was down 15 percent from the 805 million eggs consumed in 1971.

DEATH LOSS: Death loss of chickens on hand December 1, 1971, excluding chickens destroyed under the Exotic Newcastle Disease Eradication Program, was 11.5 percent compared with 13.5 percent a year earlier.

CHICKENS AND BROILERS COMBINED: Sales of chickens and broilers in 1972 totaled 12,610 million pounds compared with 11,990 million pounds in 1971. The total value of sales was \$1,728 million, 9 percent above 1971. The value of broiler sales amounted to 94 percent of the total, the same as in 1971. The price per pound liveweight for broilers and chickens combined averaged 13.7 cents in 1972, compared with 13.2 cents in 1971.
