FARM PRODUCTION, DISPOSITION, CASH RECEIPTS AND GROSS INCOME
FOR CHICKENS AND EGGS, 1954-55; CHICKENS ON FARMS JANUARY 1, 1955-56

The 1955 gross income from eggs and chickens (including commercial broilers) totaled 3,066 million dollars --7 percent more than in 1954. Of the 1955 gross income, 63 percent was from eggs, 27 percent from commercial broilers, and 10 percent from farm chickens, compared with 62 percent from eggs, 26 percent from commercial broilers and 12 percent from farm chickens in 1954. Cash receipts from sales of eggs and chickens in 1955 accounted for 2,809 million dollars or 92 percent of the gross income. The remainder represented the value of products consumed on farms where produced.

Chicken production on farms in 1955 amounted to 377 million birds--17 percent less than in 1954. In addition, a record 1,078 million commercial broilers were produced--3 percent more than in 1954.

Farm Chicken and Egg Prices are Up: The average price per pound live weight of farm chickens sold in 1955 was 18.6 cents, compared with 16.8 cents in 1954. Egg prices averaged 38.9 cents per dozen, compared with 36.6 cents in 1954.

Sales of Farm Chickens Decrease: Farm chickens sold in 1955 totaled 265 million--20 percent less than in 1954. Of this number, 41 percent were young chickens and 59 percent mature, compared with 49 percent young and 51 percent mature in 1954. Average live weight of all chickens sold in 1955 was 4.6 pounds, compared with 4.5 in 1954. Young chickens sold averaged 3.8 pounds and mature 5.2 pounds, the same as in 1954. About 1,230 million pounds live weight of farm chickens were sold in 1955--18 percent less than in 1954. Of this total, about 66 percent were mature and 34 percent young chickens.

Egg Production Up: Egg production in 1955 was 59,485 million eggs--1 percent more than in 1954. A 2 percent increase in the rate of lay more than offset a decrease in the number of layers on hand during the year. The annual rate of lay in 1955 was 192 eggs per layer, compared with 188 in 1954. Gross income from eggs in 1955 was 1,922 million dollars--7 percent more than in 1954. Most of this increase was due to a 6 percent increase in the average egg price.

Chicken Inventories Decrease: Chickens on farms January 1, (excluding commercial broiler) totaled about 382 million--2 percent less than a year earlier. Of the chickens on farms January 1, 1956, 62 percent were pullets, 32 percent hens and 6 percent other chickens. This compares with 66 percent pullets, 28 percent hens, and 6 percent other chickens on January 1, 1955. Pullets on farms January 1, 1956, numbered about 238 million --7 percent less than a year earlier. Hens totaled 122 million --9 percent more. Holdings of other chickens totaled about 23 million--up 2 percent.

Farmers Eat About the Same Number of Eggs but Fewer Chickens: Farmers consumed 5,534 million eggs in 1955, about the same number as in 1954. Chickens consumed in farm households totaled about 121 million--6 percent less than in 1954.

Commercial Broiler Production at Record High: About 3,309 million pounds live weight of commercial broilers were produced in 42 States in 1955--2 percent more than in 1954. The average live weight price was 25.2 cents per pound, compared with 23.1 in 1954. Gross income from broilers was 834 million dollars--2 percent more than in 1954.

Georgia led all States in the number of commercial broilers produced in 1955, with about 16 percent of the Nation's broilers, followed by Texas and Arkansas with about 7 percent each, Delaware and North Carolina with 6 percent each, Maryland, Alabama and Virginia with 5 percent each, California with 4 percent and Mississippi with 3 percent. These 10 States accounted for 2/3 of the 1955 broiler production in the United States.

The term commercial broiler as used here includes all young chickens of the heavy or cross breeds raised for meat from which pullets, as well as cockerels, are sold as broilers.

Rate of Death Loss of Layers: Death loss of layers on farms in 1955 was 22 percent, compared with 21 percent in 1954. A 1 percent loss is equivalent to about 3.9 million layers.

Fewer Eggs for Farm Hatching: Farmers used 75 million eggs for farm and custom hatching in 1955--14 percent less than in 1954. Of the total chickens raised on farms in 1955, about 6 percent were hatched on farms and 94 percent were purchased or custom hatched, compared with 5 percent hatched on farms and 95 percent custom hatched in 1954.

Total Sales of Farm Chickens and Commercial Broilers Down: Combined sales of farm chickens and commercial broilers in 1955 totaled 4,540 million pounds, 4 percent less than combined sales in 1954. The average price per pound live weight received for sales was 23.4 cents, compared with 21.1 in 1954. Total value of birds sold was 1,063 million dollars--6 percent more than in 1954. Commercial broiler sales amounted to 73 percent of the total pounds sold, compared with 68 percent in 1954.
