

## Nonfat Dry Milk - West U.S.

In the West, the bottom of the low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) price range was unchanged, while the top of the price range moved lower. The mostly price series moved 1 cent lower on both ends. Domestic demand varies from steady to lighter. Demand from international buyers is lighter. Stakeholders note purchasing from southern boarder neighbors is less active. Low/medium heat production schedules are steady. Although some manufacturers convey extremely tight availability for spot purchasing, loads are available in the region to accommodate spot buyer needs. High heat NDM prices moved slightly lower on both ends of the range. Demand is steady. Production paces continue to be mixed in the region.
