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In the West, low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) prices moved higher across all facets of the range and mostly price series. Domestic demand varies from slightly stronger to slightly weaker. Export demand is steady. Stakeholders convey international buyers continue to focus more on near-term needs. Low/med heat NDM Production varies from steady to lighter with milk output noticeably decreasing in some parts of the region. However, most stakeholders indicate loads are generally available throughout the region. High heat NDM prices moved higher on both ends of the range. Demand is steady. Production schedules are mixed. Some manufacturers are only slotting in high heat NDM production runs upon requests.
