Prices in the West for low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) are unchanged for both the range and mostly price series. Sales activity outside of the recent price range is quiet. Domestic demand is steady. Demand from international buyers is stronger. Production schedules vary from steady to lighter. Among low/medium heat NDM manufacturers, spot load availability varies widely. In some cases, inventories remain tight for spot buyers. High heat NDM prices moved slightly lower on the bottom end and are unchanged on the top end. Demand is steady. Production schedules are mixed. Some high heat NDM producers are only slotting in production runs intermittently to accommodate requests.
