For the low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) price range, the bottom end is unchanged, while the top end moved lower in the West. Both ends of the mostly price series moved 1 cent higher. Demand from domestic and international buyers is steady. Production schedules are steady for low heat NDM. Production schedules vary from steady to lighter for medium heat NDM. Some manufacturers convey stocks are tight for spot buyers, and spot load availability varies widely throughout the region. High heat NDM prices contracted this week. Demand is steady. Production paces are mixed. Some manufacturers are only running high heat NDM production upon request and price agreement.
