



Nonfat Dry Milk - West U.S.

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In the West, the bottom end of the low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) price was unchanged, while the top end of the low/medium heat NDM price range moved slightly higher. Both ends of the mostly price series moved 1 cent higher. Domestic demand varies from steady to somewhat stronger. Export demand varies from steady to lighter. Low/medium heat NDM production schedules are mixed. In the southwest part of the region, milk production is weaker, and low/medium heat production schedules are noted as less busy. That said, loads are available to fill spot buyer needs. High heat NDM prices moved higher on the bottom end and were unchanged on the top end of the range. Production schedules are mixed, and demand is steady.
