The low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) price range contracted on each end in the West. The mostly price series was unchanged. Domestic demand varies from steady to stronger. Demand from international buyers varies from steady to moderate. Stakeholders convey spot load availability remains tighter in the southwest portion of the region compared to other parts of the region. Production schedules are seasonally weaker. Some manufacturers indicate skim milk powder production is increasing, which is decreasing NDM production. High heat NDM prices moved higher on the bottom end of the range. Demand varies from steady to stronger. Loads are available to meet the needs of spot buyers. Production schedules remain mixed.
