Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 6/27/2025

Compared to the last report: Hay prices are mostly steady across all regions with light to moderate demand. According to the US Drought Monitor, In the South, especially in Texas and Oklahoma, temperatures across the region this week ranged from near-normal to 2-6 degrees warmer than normal in most of the region. Heavy rains fell in parts of central and northern Oklahoma, Tennessee, northeast Arkansas, Mississippi, and the western Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles. Most of central and south-central Texas had drier weather this week. Despite the dry weather there, some improvements to the Drought Monitor occurred in south-central Texas as the impact of recent heavy rains continued to be evaluated. A small increase in abnormal dryness and moderate drought occurred in the Midland-Odessa area due to growing short-term precipitation deficits and decreasing soil moisture and streamflow. Outside of Texas, the rest of the South remained free of drought or abnormal dryness. The next available hay report will be July 11, 2025.
