---PECANS: The next pecan report is scheduled to be released on Tuesday, January 21, 2025.

Prices are for (late afternoon Tuesday, January 14, 2025 thru Thursday, January 16, 2025), in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

Most growers are finished with harvest for the season. Several growers did not pick up nuts due to quality and low prices offered for pecans. Some growers will collected crop insurance, versus harvesting pecans.

Movement fairly slow. Some pecans stored to sell later. Wide range in quality.
