---PECANS: The next pecan report is scheduled to be released on Tuesday, January 28, 2025.

Prices are for (late afternoon Tuesday, January 21, 2025 thru Thursday, January 23, 2025), in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

Most growers are finished with harvest for the season. Several growers did not pick up nuts due to quality and low prices offered for pecans. Some growers collected crop insurance, versus harvesting pecans.

Movement very slow due to snow and cold weather. Some pecans stored to sell later. Wide range in quality.
