Compared to last week: Domestic origin feeder steers were 2.00 to 4.00 higher. Mexican origin steers were mostly 10.00 higher on comparable sales. Not enough comparable sales on domestic or Mexican origin heifers for a market trend. Trading activity and demand were moderate. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (91.8% Steers, 8.2% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 61%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 0% shrink or equivalent, with a 0 cent slide > 600 lbs. and 0 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
