## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 4 PERCENT


Cattle and calves on feed August 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.89 million head, down 4 percent from a year ago and 12 percent less than August 1, 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during July totaled 1.35 million, down 8 percent from last year and 16 percent from July 1978. This is the lowest number of July marketings from the 7 States since 1975.

<u>PLACEMENTS</u> of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during July were 1.52 million, a 25 percent increase from last year but 3 percent less than July two years ago.

NET PLACEMENTS of 1.44 million were 31 percent more than July last year but 3 percent below July 1978.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during July totaled 79 thousand head compared with 108 thousand during July 1979 and 78 thousand during July 1978.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 75 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
