

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 9 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed February 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8,614,000 head, 9 percent more than a year ago and 3 percent higher than February 1, 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Marketings of fed cattle during January totaled 1,740,000, 9 percent above last year and 19 percent greater than 1976.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during January totaled 1,639,000, 20 percent more than last year and 19 percent greater than January 1976. Net placements of 1,427,000 are 13 percent more than last year and 11 percent greater than 1976.

Other disappearance totaled 212,000 compared with 107,000 in January 1977 and 90,000 in 1976. Pasture and range conditions in California were considerably improved by recent heavy rains.

1/ CATTLE AND CALVES ON FEED ARE ANIMALS BEING FATTENED FOR SLAUGHTER MARKET ON GRAIN OR OTHER CON-CENTRATES AND ARE EXPECTED TO PRODUCE A CARCASS THAT WILL GRADE GOOD OR BETTER. 2/ INCLUDES DEATH LOSSES, MOVEMENT FROM FEEDLOTS TO PASTURES AND SHIPMENTS TO OTHER FEEDLOTS FOR FURTHER FEEDING.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 73 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
