
CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 2 PERCENT FROM A YEAR EARLIER

Cattle and calves on feed May I for the slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.38 million head, up 2 percent from a year ago and 4 percent more than May 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during April totaled 1.52 million, a 4 percent increase from last year and 8 percent above April two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during April totaled 1.52 million, 3 percent below both last year and 1982. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.33 million for April are down 6 percent from last year and 9 percent from 1982.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 184 thousand compared with 143 thousand during April 1983 and 109 thousand two years ago.
