
## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES OFF 4 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed March 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.87 million head, down 4 percent from a year ago and 8 percent from March 1, 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during February totaled 1.41 million, down 2 percent from last year and 11 percent lower than February 1980.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during February totaled 1.32 million, 11 percent more than last year and 8 percent greater than February 1980. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.23 million are up 16 percent from last year and 15 percent from February 1980.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 93 thousand compared with 129 thousand during February 1981 and 155 thousand two years ago.



The 23 State report scheduled for release on April 19, 1982 will reduce coverage to 13 States. The monthly report will continue to cover the 7 major cattle feeding States.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED UN DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED ESTIMATED ON THIS REPORT 69 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
