

## CATTLE ON FEED UP 8 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market on October 1, 1966 in 32 major feeding States totaled 7,943,000 head, 8 percent more than a year earlier according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Increases from a year earlier were shown for all weight groups. The number placed on feed during the past quarter was 6 percent above the same quarter a year earlier. Marketings during this period were up 12 percent.

The October 1 number on feed was 5 percent below the number on feed July 1 this year compared with a 2 percent decrease for this same period last year.

## NORTH CENTRAL STATES INCREASE 8 PERCENT

On October 1 there were 4,592,000 cattle and calves on feed in the North Central States, 8 percent more than last year. Iowa and Nebraska, the leading States in this region and the Nation, were up 3 and 15 percent respectively. The sharpest increase of 40 percent was in Kansas. Increases also occurred in Ohio, Minnesota, and Missouri.

## WESTERN STATES UP 5 PERCENT

On October 1 there were 2,456,000 cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 11 Western States--up 5 percent from a year earlier. Increases were shown for all States except Arizona, Utah, and Oregon. California, the leading Western State, increased 2 percent. Colorado, the second ranking State, had 3 percent more.

## OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES

The nine other cattle feeding States had 895,000 cattle and calves on feed October 1--up 16 percent from last year. Texas, the major feeding State in this group, showed an increase of 17 percent. Pennsylvania, Georgia, Florida, Tennessee, Alabama, and Oklahoma also had more cattle on feed, but Kentucky and Mississippi had fewer.

### PLACEMENTS AND MARKETINGS UP

Cattle and calves placed on feed in the 32 States during July-September totaled 4,509,000 head, an increase of 6 percent from the same period in 1965. Placements were up 13 percent in the North Central States, but down 4 percent in the Western States. Shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into 8 Corn Belt States during July and August were up 17 percent from the same period in 1965.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the third quarter totaled 4,917,000 head--12 percent above the same period in 1965. Fed cattle marketings were up 15 percent in the North Central States and 3 percent in the Western States.

Total slaughter of steers and heifers under Federal Inspection during the July-September quarter was up 10 percent from a year earlier.

Beef steers and heifers (prime, choice and good) sold out of first hands for slaughter at 15 livestock markets during July-September were down 7 percent from the same period in 1965. These data do not include direct sales to packing plants, mixed lots, and some deliveries bought on prior contract.

### WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

The October 1 number of cattle and calves on feed in the 32 States by weight groups showed a larger number than last year in all groups. The number of head in each weight group and the percentage change from October 1 last year are as follows: Under 500 pounds, 528,000 head, up 5 percent; 500-699 pounds, 1,648,000 head, up 8 percent; 700-899 pounds, 2,968,000 head, up 6 percent; 900-1,099 pounds, 2,404,000 head, up 9 percent; 1,100 or more pounds, 395,000 head, up 20 percent. There were fewer heifers under 700 pounds this year compared with a year ago but steer numbers were larger in all weight groups.

### KINDS ON FEED

Steers and steer calves on feed in the 32 States totaled 5,604,000 head, a 9 percent increase from October 1 a year ago. There were 2,315,000 heifers and heifer calves on feed, an increase of 4 percent. Cows and others on feed totaled 24,000 head, 4 percent less than last year.

### TIME ON FEED

Cattle and calves on feed less than 3 months totaled 4,312,000 head, 6 percent above a year earlier. The total on feed 3-6 months, at 2,190,000 head, was up 5 percent. Cattle on feed 6 months or longer totaled 1,441,000 head, up 19 percent.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Of the October 1 number on feed, cattle feeders intend to market 4,488,000 head during October, November, and December. This would be 7 percent above October-December marketings last year from October 1 numbers. Intentions are to market 35 percent of the 3-month total during October, 32 percent during November, and 33 percent during December. Expected marketings are based on the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

SEPTEMBER MARKETINGS FOR 15 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 15 livestock markets during September 1966 totaled 427,351 head, 17 percent less than during September 1965. Steers accounted for 273,556 head, 17 percent less than a year earlier. Heifers totaled 153,795 head, down 18 percent.

Steers and heifers marketed in the prime, choice and good grades totaled 411,915 head, down 16 percent from September 1965.

Beginning with this report, monthly estimates in addition to the regular quarterly estimates are included for Iowa. The additional monthly estimates are financed by matching funds provided jointly by State agencies and the Consumer and Marketing Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture under provision of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946. Estimates for August 1 and September 1 are shown on page 15.
