
CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 10 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed March 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8,276,000 head, 10 percent more than a year ago and 2 percent higher than March 1, 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Marketings of fed cattle during February totaled 1,666,000, a record high for the month, 6 percent above last year and 9 percent greater than 1976.

<u>Placements</u> of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during February totaled 1,509,000, a record high for the month, 11 percent more than last year and 7 percent greater than February 1976. <u>Net placements</u> of 1,328,000 are 6 percent more than last year and 3 percent higher than 1976.

 $\underline{\text{Other disappearance}}$ totaled 181,000 compared with 112,000 in February 1977 and 118,000 in 1976.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 72 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
