

CATTLE ON FEED UP 1 PERCENT

On January 1, 1965 there were 9,350,000 head of cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market, in 32 major feeding States, 1 percent more than a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The 28 feeding States (with comparable weight data) also showed a 1 percent increase in number on feed. The increase in cattle and calves weighing less than 900 pounds was greater than the decrease in those weighing more than 900 pounds.

In addition to the 32 States there were 136,000 cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in 5 Atlantic States and 2 South Central States January 1, 1965 compared with 141,000 last January 1. The 32 States plus these 7 States give a 39 State total of 9,486,000 head, 1 percent higher than a year earlier.

NORTH CENTRAL REGION LITTLE CHANGED

There were 5,846,000 cattle and calves on feed January 1 in the North Central States for slaughter market compared with 5,858,000 a year earlier. Iowa, the leading State, was up 1 percent. All the East North Central States, except Wisconsin, which was unchanged, had fewer on feed this January 1 with the sharpest decreases shown for Illinois, down 8 percent and Indiana, down 12 percent from a year earlier. However, all the West North Central States, except North Dakota, had more on feed with South Dakota and Kansas up 6 and 5 percent respectively.

WESTERN STATES UP 2 PERCENT

Cattle on feed for the slaughter market in the 11 Western States totaled 2,508,000 on January 1 this year, 2 percent more than on the same date a year earlier. Increases in the number of grain fed cattle were recorded in 8 of the Western States, with increases ranging from 5 percent in Colorado and New Mexico to 17 percent in Nevada. On the other hand, a decrease of 3 percent was recorded for California, the largest feeding State in the West, and Utah was down 14 percent. The number on feed in Wyoming was unchanged.

OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES SHOW SLIGHT GAIN

In feeding States outside the North Central and Western States, the number of cattle on grain feed for the slaughter market showed a gain of 1 percent from January 1 a year ago. Moderate to substantially larger numbers in Virginia, Florida, Alabama, and Texas were nearly offset by decreases in Maryland, the Carolinas, Kentucky, Tennessee, Mississippi, Arkansas, and Oklahoma. Pennsylvania, Georgia, New York, and Louisiana were unchanged from a year earlier.

FOURTH QUARTER PLACEMENTS AND MARKETINGS BOTH UP

In 28 major feeding States the number of cattle and calves placed on feed during the October-December quarter of 1964 totaled 6,451,000 head, up 6 percent from the same period in 1963. Placements were 4 percent larger in the North Central States and 11 percent greater in the Western group. Recorded shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into the 8 Corn Belt States during October and November were up 7 percent from the same period in 1963.

Marketings of grain fed cattle for slaughter from the 28 States during the October-December quarter totaled 4,081,000 head, 5 percent more than a year earlier. In the North Central region, marketings were up 3 percent and in the Western region, up 8 percent. The number of slaughter steers and heifers grading good or better sold out of first hands at 14 principal livestock markets during the October-December quarter changed little from a year earlier. These data do not include direct sales to packing plants, mixed lots, and some deliveries bought on prior contract.

WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

A breakdown of the cattle on feed in the 28 States January 1, 1965 by weight groups indicates 5 percent more weighing less than 900 pounds, but 10 percent fewer weighing over 900 pounds. The number in each weight group and percentage comparisons with last year are as follows: under 500 pounds, 1,736,000 head, up 6 percent; 500-699 pounds, 2,343,000, up 5 percent; 700-899 pounds, 2,745,000, up 4 percent; 900-1,099 pounds, 1,937,000, down 4 percent; 1,100 pounds and over, 393,000, down 33 percent.

KINDS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves on feed in the 28 States totaled 6,539,000 head, a decrease of 1 percent from January 1, 1964. There were 2,555,000 heifers and heifer calves on feed this January 1, an increase of 3 percent from the number on feed a year earlier. There were 60,000 cows and others on feed, up 2 percent from a year earlier.

TIME ON FEED

The number on feed less than 3 months in the 28 States totaled 6,298,000 head, 6 percent above January 1, 1964. The 3-6 month group numbered 2,418,000 head, down 2 percent from last year. The over 6 months group at 438,000 head was 36 percent below January 1, 1964.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders in the 32 States indicate that they intend to market 3,960,000 head during the January-March period. This would be 4 percent less than actual marketings for the same period a year earlier. The Western States indicate a 2 percent increase in January-March marketings. Feeders in North Central States indicate they plan to decrease marketings of fed cattle during January-March 1965 by 9 percent. A breakdown of anticipated marketings of the January 1 number on feed shows 35 percent to be marketed during January, 33 percent in February, and 32 percent in March. Expected marketings as published, are based upon the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

DECEMBER MARKETINGS FOR 14 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers, marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 14 markets during December 1964, totaled 570,377 head -- 3 percent below the 589,189 a year earlier. Steers accounted for 71 percent of the total marketed during the month -- unchanged from December 1963. The average weight for steers was 1,115 pounds, 28 pounds below December 1963 and heifers averaged 937 pounds, down 26 pounds from a year earlier.

Steers and heifers grading prime, choice, and good totaled 526,104 head, 5 percent below December 1963.
