
CATTLE ON FEED UP 16 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed September 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.84 million, 16 percent more than a year ago and 22 percent more than September 1, 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Marketings of fed cattle during August were 1.65 million, 3 percent greater than last year and 4 percent more than 1976.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during August were a record 1.74 million, 15 percent more than last year and 23 percent larger than August 1976. Net Placements of 1.62 million were up 12 percent from 1977 and 20 percent greater than 2 years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 115 thousand compared with 58 thousand in August 1977 and 52 thousand in 1976.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 76 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
