

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 3 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed November 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.79 million head, down 3 percent from a year ago and 16 percent less than November 1, 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Marketings of fed cattle during October totaled 1.58 million, down 4 percent from last year and 15 percent below October 1978.

<u>Placements</u> of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during October were 2.25 million, off 6 percent from last year and 19 percent below October 1978. Net placements of 2.12 million were off 6 percent and 19 percent, respectively, from last year and 2 years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 130 thousand compared with 144 thousand in October 1979 and 153 thousand in 1978.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTURY OF CATTLE ON FEED ESTIMATED IN THIS REPORT 76 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
