CATTLE ON FEED UP 8 PERCENT

On October 1 there were 6,133,000 head of cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 28 major feeding States, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 8 percent more than the 5,673,000 head on feed in these States October 1, 1961, up slightly from the 6,103,000 head on feed July 1.

The number of cattle weighing less than 900 pounds more than offset decreases in heavier weight groups and accounted for all of the increase over a year earlier.

In the 26 feeding States (comparable series for recent years) there were 6,059,000 head on feed, compared with 5,597,000 on October 1 last year. The small July-September gain is in contrast to declines of 9 in 1960 and 4 percent in 1961.

NORTH CENTRAL STATES 1 PERCENT HIGHER

There were 3,634,000 head of cattle and calves on feed October 1 for slaughter market in the North Central States, up 1 percent from the 3,582,000 head on feed a year earlier. Increases in Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota, and Kansas more than offset decreases in Wisconsin, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Nebraska. Amounts of change for the three leading States in this region are: Iowa, down 1 percent; Nebraska, down 5 percent; and Illinois, up 4 percent.

WESTERN STATES UP 19 PERCENT

On October 1, a total of 1,996,000 head of cattle and calves were on feed for slaughter market in the 11 Western States--19 percent more than on October 1 last year. Numbers in the three leading States in this region were all significantly higher than a year earlier--California, 26 percent; Colorado, 11 percent; and Arizona 30 percent. Other increases ranged from 6 percent in Wyoming to 22 percent in Idaho. Compared with a year earlier Montana and Nevada had fewer cattle on feed and Utah was unchanged.

OTHER CATTLE FEEDING STATES

Cattle feeding States in other regions showed the following changes from October 1, 1961: Georgia, down 2 percent; Alabama, down 4 percent; Pennsylvania and Oklahoma, down 8 percent; but Texas was 48 percent higher.

PLACEMENTS UP 11 PERCENT

Cattle and calves placed on feed July through September this year in the 26 States having comparable data, totaled 3,588,000 head, 11 percent above the

3,239,000 placed during the same period in 1961. Shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into 8 Corn Belt States, for which data are available, during July and August this year, were up 19 percent from the same two months last year.

MARKETINGS UP 3 PERCENT

Fed cattle marketed for slaughter from the 26 States having comparable data, during July through September 1962 amounted to 3,569,000 head--3 percent more than for the same period in 1961.

Beef steers and heifers (grading prime, choice, and good) sold out of first hands for slaughter at 12 livestock markets during July, August, and September were down 10 percent from the same period a year ago. These data do not include direct sales to packing plants, mixed lots of steers and heifers, and some deliveries bought on prior contracts. Direct sales to packing plants comprise a higher proportion of the fed cattle marketings than in the past in a number of States.

WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

A breakdown of the October 1 number on feed in the 28 States by weight groups shows sharp increases over a year earlier in cattle weighing less than 900 pounds, while those above 900 pounds showed decreases. The number weighing under 500 pounds totaled 539,000 head, up 36 percent from a year earlier; the 500-699 pound group totaled 1,270,000 head, up 18 percent; and the 700-899 pound group of 2,304,000 head was up 13 percent. The number on feed weighing 900-1,099 pounds totaled 1,738,000 head, a decrease of 4 percent from last year. Cattle weighing 1,100 pounds and over, at 282,000 head, were down 21 percent from a year earlier.

KINDS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves in the 28 States, 4,328,000 head, exceeded the 4,015,000 head on October 1 last year by 8 percent. Heifer and heifer calves totaled 1,777,000 head, an increase of 9 percent over a year earlier. Cows and others on feed at 28,000 head, were down 15 percent from the same date last year.

TIME ON FEED

The number on feed less than 3 months totaled 3,507,000 head in the 28 States, up 11 percent from a year earlier. The 3-6 month group at 1,401,000 head and the 6-month and over group at 1,225,000 head were up 6 and 3 percent respectively.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Indications are that cattle feeders in 28 States intend to market 3,346,000 head of the October 1 number on feed during October, November, and December. If intentions are carried out, marketings from the October 1 inventory during the fourth quarter will be 2 percent greater than the comparable period last year. A breakdown by months of anticipated marketings during the fourth quarter shows 34 percent to be marketed in October, 31 percent in November, and 35 percent in December. Expected marketings as published are based upon the usual relationship between survey data and actual marketings.

SEPTEMBER MARKETINGS FOR 12 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 12 selected markets during September 1962 totaled 431,918 head, compared with 498,540 head in September a year ago. Of the total, steers accounted for 66 percent in September 1962, compared with 70 percent the same month in 1961. Marketings of steers, at 284,594 head, were down 18 percent from a year earlier. Heifer marketings totaled 147,324 head, a drop of 3 percent from the same period last year.

Steers and heifers grading prime, choice, and good totaled 411,409 head, down 13 percent from the 470,410 head marketed in September 1961. These three grades comprised 95 percent of the marketings for slaughter this September, compared with 94 percent a year earlier.
