CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 11 PERCENT


Cattle and calves on feed September 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.29 million head, down 11 percent from a year ago and off 8 percent from September 1, 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the lowest September 1 number on feed in the 7 States since 1975.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during August totaled 1.53 million, up 9 percent from 1980 but down 7 percent from 1979.

<u>PLACEMENTS</u> of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States were 1.42 million, down 12 percent from last year but 5 percent more than the low level of August 1979.

NET PLACEMENTS of 1.36 million were down 12 percent from 1980 but 8 percent more than 1979.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 55 thousand compared with 61 thousand during August 1980 and 82 thousand 2 years ago.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSOMAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PRUCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO UBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED ESTIMATED ON THIS REPORT TO PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
