## CATTLE ON FEED — 7 STATES


## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 6 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed December 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.81 million head, a 6 percent decrease from a year ago but up 7 percent from December 1, 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during November totaled 1.46 million, a decrease of 2 percent from last year but 11 percent more than November 1981.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States were 1.71 million, down 4 percent from November 1982 but up 5 percent from two years ago. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.59 million were down 5 percent from 1982 but 4 percent above 1981.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 121 thousand compared with 119 thousand during November 1982 and 107 thousand two years ago.
