CATTLE ON FEED UP 12 PERCENT

The number of cattle and calves on feed for market in 13 major feeding States on April 1 at 4,896,000 head was 12 percent above a year earlier, and 2 percent less than the number on feed January 1, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The January to April decline was much less than usual and compares with a 15 percent drop during the same period of both 1957 and 1956. On January 1 the number on feed in these 13 States was 3 percent less than a year earlier. Cattle and calves on feed in Idaho totaled 110,000 head on April 1, 1958--an increase of 10 percent from 1957, while numbers in Oklahoma totaled 32,000 head. These two States are not included in the 13 State totals.

CORN BELT NUMBERS ON FEED UP 13 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed in 9 of the Corn Belt States on April 1, 1958, totaled 4,124,000 head--an increase of 13 percent from the 3,640,000 head for a year earlier. All of the Corn Belt States for which cattle on feed estimates are made show increases over April, 1957, except Ohio which was down 2 percent and Indiana down 10 percent. Iowa, the leading cattle feeding State, was up 11 percent; Illinois, 3 percent; Minnesota, 12 percent; Missouri, 21 percent; South Dakota, 35 percent; Nebraska, 27 percent; and Kansas, up 75 percent. Shipments of stocker and feeder cattle into 9 of the Corn Belt States for the January through March quarter of 1958 were up 32 percent from the same period of 1957.

FIVE WESTERN STATES SHOW 6 PERCENT INCREASE

For the 5 important Western feeding States, Texas, Idaho, Colorado, Arizona, and California, cattle numbers on feed April 1, 1958 at 882,000 head, were up 6 percent from the 835,000 head on feed April 1, 1957. This compares with a 14 percent decline from the preceding year shown by these same States on January 1, 1958. In California, the leading feeding State in the West, April 1 numbers on feed was down 9 percent, from a year earlier while the other 4 States showed increases as follows: Texas, up 43 percent; Colorado 4 percent; Arizona, 17 percent; and Idaho, up 10 percent.

PLACEMENTS UP 28 PERCENT, MARKETINGS DOWN 8 PERCENT

The number of cattle and calves placed on feed in the 13 States for which quarterly estimates are made totaled 2,213,000 head during the January-

March quarter of 1958, 28 percent above the number placed in the corresponding quarter last year. The Corn Belt showed an increase of 27 percent in placements while Western States were up nearly a third. Fed cattle marketed from the 13 States during January-March 1958, at 2,310,000 head, were 8 percent below the marketings during the first quarter of 1957. The number of short-fed cattle (cattle both placed and marketed during the quarter), at 147,000 was 35 percent above the corresponding period last year.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders reporting marketing intentions in the 13 quarterly States on April 1, 1958 indicate that 58 percent of the 4,896,000 head on feed April 1 are expected to be marketed after July 1. Of the remaining 42 percent, 13 percent are expected to be marketed in April, 14 percent in May, and 15 percent in June.

TIME ON FEED

The number on feed less than 3 months on April 1 in the 13 States was 28 percent above a year earlier, while the number on feed from 3 to 6 months was up 5 percent and the number on feed over 6 months was down 26 percent. As a percent of total cattle on feed April 1, 1958 the number on feed less than 3 months was 42 percent; 3 to 6 months was 54 percent; and on feed more than 6 months, 4 percent. This compares with last year's percentages of 37 percent on feed less than 3 months; 57 percent, 3-6 months; and 6 percent on feed more than 6 months.

KIND OF CATTLE ON FEED

Data for the 13 States show that steers represented 61 percent of the total on feed April 1, 1958 compared with 62 percent a year earlier. Heifers made up 21 percent this year and 22 percent last year, while calves at 17 percent compares with 16 percent a year earlier. Cows and other cattle comprised 1 percent of the total this year and less than one-half of one percent a year earlier.

WEIGHT OF CATTLE ON FEED

A breakdown of numbers on feed by weight groups indicates considerably more light weight cattle on April 1 than a year earlier, but a smaller number of heavy cattle. In the 13 States the number of cattle weighing under 600 pounds was up 18 percent from last year; and the number in 600-900 pound group was up 15 percent; the 900 to 1,100 pound weight group was up 5 percent while the number weighing over 1,100 pounds was down 13 percent. As a percent of total cattle on feed April 1, the number weighing less than 600 pounds was 22 percent compared with 21 percent a year earlier. The 600-900 pound cattle made up 51 percent compared with 49 percent; 900-1,100 pounds 23 percent and 24 percent; and over 1,100 pounds 4 percent this year and 6 percent last year.
