

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 11 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed December 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.27 million head, down 11 percent from a year ago and 3 percent less than December 1, 1977, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Marketings of fed cattle during November totaled 1.44 million, down 16 percent from last year and 3 percent less than November 1977.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during November were 1.85 million, down 2 percent from a year ago and 9 percent less than November 1977. Net placements of 1.69 million were off 2 percent from last year and 12 percent from 2 years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 158 thousand compared with 160 thousand in November 1978 and 123 thousand in 1977.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 77 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
