Cattle on feed in 7 States up 9 percent from last year


Cattle and calves on feed June 1, 1991, for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.59 million head, up 9 percent from a year ago and 10 percent above June 1, 1989. This is the largest June number on feed since 1973.

Marketings of fed cattle during May totaled 1.70 million, down 5 percent from last year and 3 percent below two years ago.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during May totaled 1.75 million, up 8 percent from both last year and May 1989. Net placements of 1.61 million for May was up 10 percent from both last year and 1989.

Other disappearance totaled 141,000 head compared to 150,000 in May 1990 and 164,000 in May 1989.
