CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 6 PERCENT


Cattle and calves on feed August 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.45 million head, down 6 percent from a year ago and off 10 percent from August 1, 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during July totaled 1.41 million, up 6 percent and down 3 percent from 1980 and 1979, respectively.

<u>PLACEMENTS</u> of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States were 1.08 million, a record low for July. This is down 28 percent less than last year's near-normal level and off 11 percent from July 1979.

NET PLACEMENTS of 1.02 million were down 29 percent from 1980 and 8 percent from July 1979.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 65 thousand compared with 79 thousand during July 1980 and 108 thousand 2 years ago.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS, THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY, DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS. IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE DN FEED ESTIMATED DN THIS REPORT 70 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
