CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES -- DOWN 3 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

Cattle and calves on feed December 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8,000,000 head, down 3 percent from a year ago but 21 percent more than December 1, 1974, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number on feed December 1 was above last year in 3 of the 7 States.

November placements of Cattle and Calves on Feed in the 7 States totaled 2,159,000 head a record high for the month, 10 percent more than a year ago and 63 percent above placements during November 1974. Placements were above last year in 5 of the 7 States.

Fed cattle marketed during November totaled 1,343,000, 13 percent more than 1975 but nearly the same as 2 years ago. Marketings were above November 1975 in 6 of the 7 States.

Other disappearance during November totaled 118,000, compared with 94,000 in November a year ago.

Estimates in this Cattle on Feed Report are based on data provided voluntarily by cattle feeders. The Statistical Reporting Service maintains an upto-date list of cattle feeders stratified by feedlot capacity. Data are collected by mail and by personal and telephone interviews on or about the 1st day of each survey period. Survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all feeders in the larger size strata, and feeders in the small size strata are sampled. Of the total inventory of cattle on feed for this report, 69 percent was actually reported in the survey.
