CATTLE ON FEED UP 6 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1, 1988 for slaughter in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 9.37 million head, up 6 percent from April 1, 1987 and 5 percent above 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 6.08 million steers and steer calves, 7 percent above last year and 9 percent above 1986. This group represented 65 percent of the total April number on feed, unchanged from last year but up 2 percentage points from 1986. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.25 million, up 6 percent from a year ago and down 2 percent from 1986.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the January-March quarter totaled 5.80 million, up 2 percent from last year and 10 percent above the comparable period in 1986. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 390 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 5.41 million.

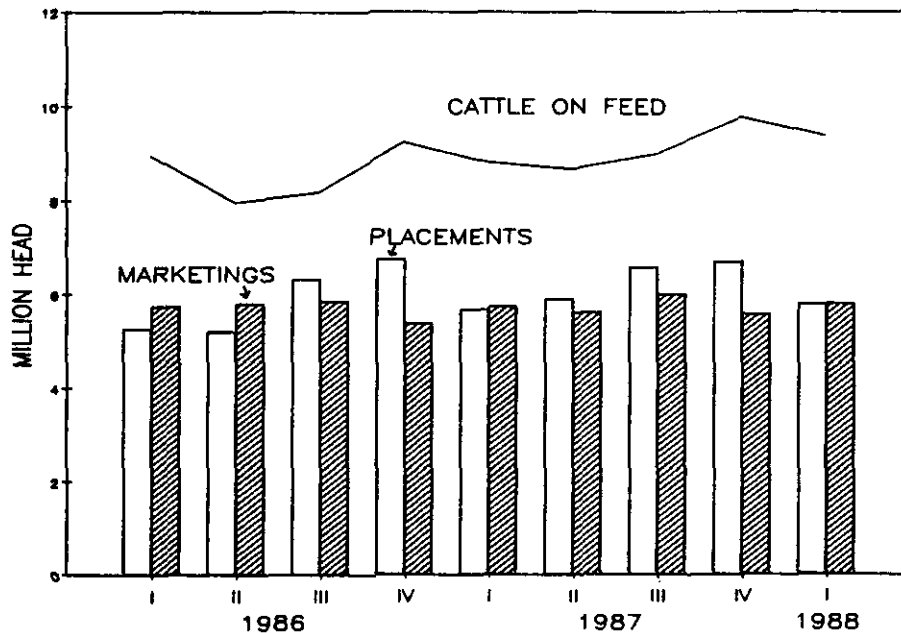
MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during January-March totaled 5.81 million, 1 percent more than both 1987 and 1986.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE UP 6 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.93 million head during the April-June quarter of 1988. This would be 6 percent more than the second quarter marketings in 1987 and 2 percent above 1986.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 7 PERCENT

Cattle on feed April 1, 1988 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.73 million, 7 percent more than the previous year and 6 percent more than two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March totaled 1.83 million, 7 percent above last year and 11 percent above 1986. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.57 million, up 1 percent from March 1987 and down 1 percent from 1986. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 106 thousand head, 19 percent above last year and 23 percent above 1986.

The JANUARY-MARCH QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.86 million were fractionally higher than 1987 and 1 percent above 1986. Marketings for the 7 States during the January-March quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the April-June 1988 quarter are estimated at 5.05 million, up 6 percent from 1987 and up 3 percent from 1986.
