CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 3 PERCENT


Cattle and calves on feed September 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.05 million head, up 3 percent from last year but 10 percent fewer than September 1, 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board. September marked the first time in 18 months that numbers on feed were higher than the corresponding year earlier totals.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during August totaled 1.40 million, down 14 percent from last year and 16 percent from August 1978. This is the lowest number of August marketings from the 7 States since 1975.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during August totaled 61 thousand head compared with 82 thousand during August 1979 and 115 thousand in 1978.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 76 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
