## Cattle On Feed

Released July 24, 1992, by the Agricultural Statistics Board. Inventory estimates refer to July 1, 1992. Placement and marketing estimates refer to the month of June and the quarter of April through June.

#### Cattle on Feed Down 6 Percent in 13 Quarterly States

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 13 States preparing quarterly estimates totaled 8.85 million head, down 6 percent from a year ago but 1 percent above July 1, 1990. The inventory included 5.74 million steers and steer calves, 7 percent below a year ago. This group accounts for 64.9 percent of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.04 million head, 6 percent below a year ago.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 13 States during the April-June 1992 quarter totaled 5.27 million, up 5 percent from both last year and April-June 1990. Net placements of 4.83 million for April-June were up 6 percent from last year and 4 percent above 1990.

Marketings of fed cattle during the April-June 1992 quarter totaled 5.68 million, down 2 percent from last year, and 5 percent below two years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 444,000 head compared to 464,000 in April-June 1991 and 400,000 in April-June 1990.

#### Expected Marketings for July-September 1992 Down 4 Percent

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.72 million head during the July-September quarter of 1992. This would be down 4 percent from the third quarter marketings in 1991 and 1 percent below 1990.

#### Cattle on Feed in 7 Monthly States Down 7 Percent

Cattle on feed July 1, 1992, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.34 million, down 7 percent from the previous year but fractionally above two years ago.

Placements in feedlots during June totaled 1.34 million, 22 percent above 1991 and 1 percent above 1990.


Marketings during June totaled 1.71 million, up 2 percent from a year ago but 5 percent below 1990.

Other disappearance during June was 116,000 head, 2 percent above last year and 59 percent above 1990.

April-June 1992 quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.80 million, was down 4 percent from 1991 and 6 percent below 1990. Marketings for the 7 states during the April-June quarter accounted for 85 percent of the 13 state total.

Expected 7 State marketings for the July-September 1992 quarter are estimated at 4.84 million, down 4 percent from last year and 2 percent below 1990.

#### Reliability of July 1 Cattle on Feed Estimates

Terminology: Cattle on feed are animals being fed a ration of grain, silage, hay and/or protein supplement for slaughter market that are expected to produce a carcass that will grade select or better. It excludes cattle being "backgrounded only" for later sale as feeders or later placement in another feedlot.

Placements are cattle put into a feedlot, fed a ration which will produce a carcass that will grade select or better, and are intended for the slaughter market.

Marketings are cattle shipped out of feedlots to a slaughter market.

Other disappearance includes death losses, movement from feedlots to pastures, and shipments to other feedlots for further feeding.

Survey Procedures: A random sample of producers in the 13 major cattle on feed states were surveyed to provide data for these estimates. Survey procedures ensured that all cattle on feed producers, regardless of size, had a chance to be included in the survey. Large producers were sampled more heavily than small operations. Data were collected from about 16,900 operators during the first half of July by mail, telephone, and face-to-face personal interviews. Regardless of when operators responded, they were asked to report inventories as of July 1.

Estimation Procedures: These cattle on feed estimates were prepared by the Agricultural Statistics Board after reviewing recommendations and analysis submitted by each State office. Regional and State survey data were reviewed for reasonableness with each other and with estimates from the previous month and/or quarter when setting the current estimates.

Revision Policy: Revisions to previous estimates are made to improve month to month and/or quarter to quarter relationships. Estimates for the previous month are subject to revision in the 7 monthly States when each current monthly estimate is made. Estimates for the previous quarter are subject to revision in all 13 States each quarter when current quarterly estimates are made. In January, all monthly and quarterly estimates are reviewed and subject to revisions. The reviews are primarily based on slaughter data, state check-off or brand data, and any other data that may have been received after the original estimate was made. Estimates will also be reviewed after data from the Department of Commerce's five-year Census of Agriculture are available. No revisions will be made after that date and estimates become final.

Reliability: Since all cattle on feed operators are not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. Survey results are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. The effects of these errors cannot be measured directly. They are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and through a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

To assist users in evaluating the reliability of the estimates in this report, the "Root Mean Square Error" is shown for selected items in the table below. The "Root Mean Square Error" is a statistical measure based on past performance and is computed using the differences between first and latest estimates. "Root Mean Square Error" for cattle on feed July 1 inventory estimates over the past 10 years is 2.0 percent. This means that chances are 2 out of 3 that the final estimate will not be above or below the current estimate of 8.85 million head by more than 2.0 percent, or about 177,000 head. Chances are 9 out of 10 that the difference will not exceed 3.6 percent, or about 318,000 head (the 90 percent confidence level). The table below also shows a 10 year record of the range of differences between first and latest estimates for selected items. Using estimates of all cattle on feed as an example, changes between the first inventory estimate and the latest estimate during the past 10 years have averaged 123,000 head, ranging from 0 to 315,000 head. During this period, the initial inventory estimate has been below the latest estimate 8 times and has not been above the final estimate. This does not imply that the July 1 estimate is likely to understate or overstate final inventory.
