CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 3 PERCENT


Cattle and calves on feed May 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.03 million head, a 3 percent increase from a year ago but down 8 percent from May 1, 1979; according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the first year-to-year increase in the monthly number on feed since September 1, 1980.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during April totaled 1.39 million, off 3 percent from last year and 10 percent less than April 1979.

<u>PLACEMENTS</u> of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during April were 1.72 million, the highest for April since records began in 1972. April placements were 39 percent more than the low level of last year and 17 percent above 2 years ago. The strong increase in placements on feed was influenced by a shortage of forage from grazing in several of the major feeding States.

NET PLACEMENTS of 1.58 million were up 43 percent from last year and 26 percent greater than April 1979.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 142 thousand compared with 130 thousand in April 1980 and 220 thousand 2 years ago.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED ESTIMATED ON THIS REPORT 68 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
