Cattle on Feed Down 8 Percent in 7 Monthly States

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.16 million head, down 8 percent from a year ago and 2 percent below March 1,1990.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during February totaled 1.47 million, up 1 percent from last year and 6 percent above 1990.

Net placements of 1.35 million for February were up 1 percent from last year and 5 percent above 1990.

Marketings of fed cattle during February totaled 1.40 million, down 2 percent from last year and 6 percent below two years ago. This is the lowest February marketings since 1975.

Other disappearance totaled 120,000 head compared to 113,000 in February 1991 and 95,000 in February 1990.
