
CATTLE_ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 9 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed December 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 9.32 million head, 9 percent more than a year ago and 16 percent more than December 1, 1976, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Marketings of fed cattle during November were 1.72 million, 15 percent greater than last year and 29 percent more than 1976.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during November were 1.89 million, down 8 percent from last year and 12 percent below November 1976.

Net placements of 1.73 million were down 10 percent from last year and 15 percent smaller than 2 years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 160 thousand compared with 123 thousand in November 1977 and 118 thousand in 1976.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 75 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
