Cattle on Feed Down 6 Percent in 7 Monthly States

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.51 million head, down 6 percent from a year ago and down 1 percent from November 1, 1992.

Placements in feedlots during October totaled 2.46 million, 1 percent below 1993 and 8 percent below 1992. Net placements of 2.40 million for October were up fractionally from last year but 7 percent below 1992.

Marketings during October totaled 1.62 million, up 4 percent from 1993 and up 9 percent from 1992.

Other disappearance during October was 56,000 head, 26 percent below both 1993 and 1992.

Cattle on Feed in 1000+ Capacity Feedlots Down 4 Percent

Cattle and calves on feed November 1, 1994, for the 7 States in the feedlots with 1,000 or more head capacity totaled 7.78 million head, down 4 percent from the previous year but 2 percent above 1992. The inventory in the 1,000+ capacity feedlots accounted for 91.4 percent of the total inventory.


