Cattle on Feed Down 6 Percent in 7 Monthly States

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.77 million head, down 6 percent from a year ago and down 1 percent from December 1, 1992.

Placements in feedlots during November totaled 1.84 million, 1 percent below 1993 and fractionally below 1992. Net placements of 1.77 million for November were up 1 percent from both last year and a year ago.

Marketings during November totaled 1.50 million, up 3 percent from 1993 and up 4 percent from 1992.

Other disappearance during November was 71,000 head, 34 percent below 1993 and 22 percent below 1992.

Cattle on Feed in 1000+ Capacity Feedlots Down 4 Percent

Cattle and calves on feed December 1, 1994, for the 7 States in feedlots with 1,000 or more head capacity totaled 7.94 million head, down 4 percent from the previous year but 1 percent above 1992. The inventory in the 1,000+ capacity feedlots accounted for 90.5 percent of the total inventory.


