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CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 7 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

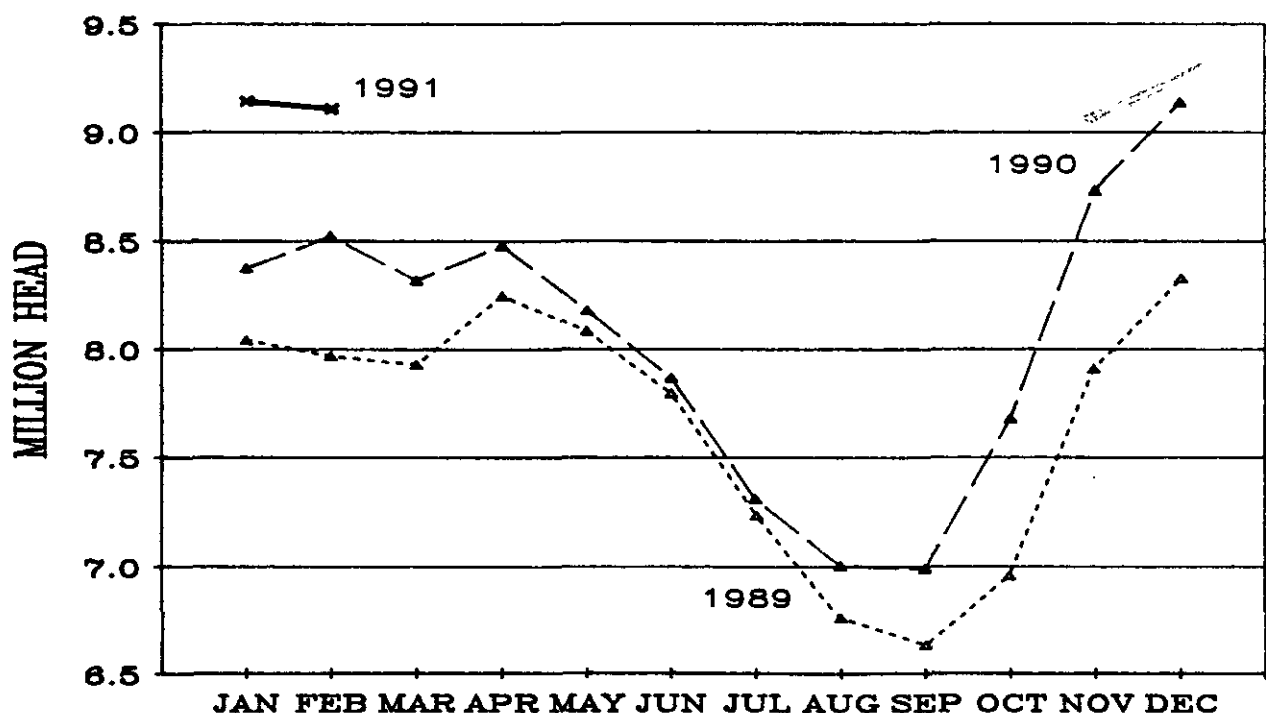
Cattle and calves on feed February 1, 1991, for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 9.10 million head, up 7 percent from a year ago and 14 percent above February 1, 1989, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is the largest February number on feed since 1974.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during January totaled 1.71 million, up 4 percent from last year and 2 percent above two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during January totaled 1.79 million, down 6 percent from last year but 5 percent above January 1989. **NET PLACEMENTS** of 1.67 million for January was down 7 percent from last year but 4 percent above 1989.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 118 thousand head compared to 114 thousand in January 1990 and 104 thousand in January 1989.
