

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 11 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed June 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.85 million head, down 11 percent from a year ago and 14 percent less than June 1, 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the lowest June 1 number on feed since 1975. Marketings of fed cattle during May totaled 1.37 million, down 15 percent from last year and 18 percent from May 1978. This is the lowest May marketings from the 7 States since 1975.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during May were 1.60 million, down 13 percent from last year and off 21 percent from May 2 years ago. Net placements of 1.39 million were 15 percent below a year ago and 24 percent below May 1978.

Other disappearance during May totaled 208 thousand head compared with thousand during May 1979 and 205 thousand during 1978.

ESTIMATES IN THIS CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED VOLUNTARILY BY CATTLE FEEDERS. THE STATISTICAL OFFICES MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE LIST OF CATTLE FEEDERS STRATIFIED BY FEEDLOT CAPACITY. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL AND BY PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF EACH SURVEY PERIOD. SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL FEEDERS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA, AND FEEDERS IN THE SMALL SIZE STRATA ARE SAMPLED. OF THE TOTAL INVENTORY OF CATTLE ON FEED FOR THIS REPORT 74 PERCENT WAS ACTUALLY REPORTED IN THE SURVEY.
